| 4. | Last date of correction/editing in online filled application form. Thereafter application will be locked automatically. Once information filled and locked, will not be allowed to change in any round of counselling. Note : Since, fresh applications are invited for 2nd round of online counselling under NEET PG-2023 from 18.08.23 to 23.08.23, hence already registered candidates of 1st round counselling (if any) who intends to edit any Category/Minority Quota/other particulars will give request/application personally in the Admission Branch, BFUHS upto 23.08.2023 alongwith relevant proof for consideration in 2nd round of online counselling as last chance. No request shall be entertained through email. Thereafter no request will be entertained. | 23.08.23 |
| 5. | Last date for submitting admission application form for NRI quota (Application form for getting Eligibility certificate and admission application form for NRI candidates is separately available on University website.) | 23.08.23 |
| 6. | The candidates who will apply under Sikh Minority/Christian Minority Quota will report to the respective minority institution (SGRD Institute of Medical Sciences, Amritsar / Christian Minority College, Ludhiana) for verification of minority status. The candidates who have already got verified their minority status at the time of 1 st counseling, need not report to the respective institute for verify again. The candidates who have already registered under Minority Quota during 1 st counseling and did not get their minority status verified, can report to the respective institute for verification of their minority status for 2 nd round of counseling. | 24.08.23 |
| 7. | Display of Provisional Merit List of candidates who will submit willingness to participate in 2nd round of online counseling. | 25.08.23 |
| 8. | Candidates who will submit willingness for 2nd round including NRI candidates will fill/submit the online choices/ preferences of speciality/college | 26.08.23 to 29.08.23 |
| 9. | Processing of seat allotment | 30.08.23 & 31.08.23 |
| 10. | Display of provisional allotment / Result | 02.09.23 |
| 11. | The last date/time of submission of objections to provisional allotment (if any) by the NEET PG aspirants Note: Objections can be submitted only by personal appearance/visit alongwith relevant documents/record in Admission Branch, BFUHS, Faridkot. | 04.09.23 |
| 12. | Display of revised provisional allotment / result after any change in provisional allotment due to objections (if any). | 05.09.23 |
| 13. | The provisionally selected candidates will pay the balance amount of fee (Six month fee after deducting amount of security deposit) through university payment gateway available on university website and will report to the respective college for joining in the respective allotted college. | From 06.09.23 to 12.09.23 |

The following categories of Candidates are eligible for seat allotment in 2nd round:

Category-I: Registered candidates who did not get any seat allotted in the 1st round.

Category-II: Registered candidates, whose 1st round of allotted seat got Cancelled during the document verification on reporting for admission, who have secured seat under reserved quota, due to change of Category from reserved to Unreserved or PwD status from Yes to No, but are still eligible in the next round of seat allotment, with changed Category, subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions.

Category-III: Candidates who have reported/joined at allotted institute during the joining period of round-1 of allotment and submitted willingness for participating in second round up- gradation as 'Yes'.

Category-IV: Candidates who exited during Round-1 availing Free Exit can log in again with their earlier Registered details.

Category-V: Candidates who did not register in Round-1 can do fresh registration and participate directly in Round-2.

The following candidates are not eligible for 2nd Round of allotment :

(a) Candidate who has become non-eligible due to having inadequate documents as per Eligibility Criteria as per Punjab Govt. notification/MCC- UG

(b) Who have not registered in Round 1 or Round 2.

Note :

1. Candidate will submit willingness and security deposit as per the rules & regulations of Government of India posted on www.mcc.nic.in. Only those candidates will be considered for 2nd round who will submit willingness by depositing requisite security amount for participation. The candidates to whom seats are allotted in the 1st round of counseling will also submit the willingness to participate in the 2nd round of online counselling, however, the fee deposited by them will be adjusted and they will have to pay the remaining amount of security deposit. Those who have already paid tuition fee more than Rs. 25000 (half of SC/BC) for Govt. colleges and Rs. 200,000/- for Private colleges, need not to pay security deposit again. The consent/willingness is mandatory to participate in 2nd round.
2. Candidate to whom seat will be allotted in 2nd round but they do not report/join at the college may exit with forfeiture (i.e. The security deposit will not be refunded in such case).
3. Candidates who will not join the allotted seat in Round 2 will be eligible for further rounds of counselling but the security amount deposited for 2nd Round will be forfeited and applicant will have to register fresh and will have to deposit the fresh security deposit for 3rd round. The provisions with regard to security deposit and eligibility for participation will be as per revised information bulletin posted on MCC website.
4. The security deposit will be refunded only in case no seat will be allotted in 2nd round of counselling.
5. Candidate will have to submit fresh choices/preferences for Round-2 online counselling. Choices submitted during Round I, will be treated as null and void.

Note : Only inservice doctors who have rendered minimum one year regular service upto 31.03.2023 are eligible for **admission to DNB Courses** i.e. doctors who are working as PCMS, Rural Medical Officers in department of Rural Development, doctors in Municipal Corporations under the Department of Local Bodies and doctors working in various Boards and Corporations of Punjab Govt.

Frequently asked questions (FAQs) :

Q1. After allotment of seat in 2nd Round of online counselling does the candidate need to join the allotted seat ?

Ans : No, it is not mandatory to join the allotted seat, however, in case the candidate does not join, the refundable security deposit will be forfeited.

Q2: After joining Second Round of Counseling, whether one can leave/ resign the allotted seat?

Ans: Once the applicant join the 2nd round seat, he/she will be allowed to leave/resign the seat within stipulated period of time. However, in case the candidate leaves/resign/surrender the seat allocated in round two or already allotted seat in round one, refundable security deposit will be forfeited.

Q3: If a candidate does not report at the allotted college during Round 2 whether he has to register again for Round 3?

Ans: Yes, Candidate security amount will be forfeited and he can participate in Round 3 only with Fresh registration and security deposit.

Q4: Whether the candidate can upgrade the Round 2 allotted seat during Round 3?

Ans: Yes, the candidate can upgrade the Round 2 allotted seat during Round 3. In case, the candidate will join the upgraded/allotted seat in Round 3, he/she will not be allowed to resign/leave the seat.

Q5: If the candidate does not join the allotted/ upgraded seat during Round 3, whether the security deposit will be forfeited?

Ans: Yes, the security amount will be forfeited and the candidate will not be eligible to participate in further rounds of counselling.

Q6: When will conversion of seats to open merit be carried out?

Ans: The conversion of seats of NRI and any reserve category after exhausting all candidates in relevant category will be carried out during the Round 3. The said conversion will be done only when the eligible Candidates belonging to the said Conversion Category have exhausted.

Q.7: What are the circumstances wherein the refundable security deposit will be forfeited?

Ans. Under the following circumstances the refundable security deposit will be forfeited:

- i. Where the candidate has been allotted a seat in Round I and is not upgraded in 2nd rounds of counselling, leaves/surrender/resign from the seat during 2nd round.
- ii. Where a Candidate has been allotted a seat in Round 2 or subsequent rounds (round3, stray vacancy/further rounds) and does not report/joins at the allotted college to complete the admission process.
- iii. The Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled after allotment due to any reason. E.g., in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission.
