Subject : Details regarding suicide, resignation and working hours of Medical students

Dear Sir/Madam,

National Medical Commission has constituted an Anti- Ragging Committee with Dr. Aruna V. Vanikar, President, UGMEB as the chairperson of the committee. Anti-Ragging Committee in its first meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2022, reviewed the ragging complaints received from the Medical Students/Parent's of the Medical Students and has expressed its concerns over incidents of suicide and suicidal tendency among the Medical Students. Although all incidents of suicide and suicidal tendency are not linked to ragging but in many cases incidents of suicide have been linked to ragging. Therefore, the committee has decided that all the colleges should submit the following information for the last 5 years:

- (i) Number of students who have committed suicide during the last 5 years (department wise in respect of PG students).
  - (ii) Number of students who have left the College/ Institute during the last 5 years (department wise in respect of PG students).
  - (iii) Details regarding the working hours and weekly off given to students.
2. The above information may be submitted over mail by 7<sup>th</sup> October 2022, positively.
