

**SUPERSPECIALITY COURSES AT AFMS INSTITUTIONS
THROUGH COMMON COUNSELING BY DGHS, MoHFW FOR THE YEAR 2025**

1. Armed Forces Medical Services (AFMS) conducts Post-doctoral/Super Specialty training at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune and Army Hospital (R&R), Delhi primarily to cater for the requirement of Super Specialists in the Armed Forces. Subsequent to the introduction of Common Counseling as per direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, all DM/MCh seats at AFMC Pune and DrNB seats at AH (R&R), Delhi Cantt are a part of the common counseling at national level under Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), DGHS, MoHFW and all candidates are eligible for the same.

2. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:** - The eligibility criteria for admission to Super Specialty courses in AFMS institutions are as follows: -

2.1. **Serving officers of the AFMS:** - AFMS officers who have been granted study leave.

2.2 **Medical Officers sponsored by Para Military Forces / other Government of India organizations:** - A Sponsorship Certificate as per **Appx 'A'** issued by the sponsoring authority to the candidate, specific to the subject allotted, is a mandatory requirement for admission. Any candidate leaving the seat after taking admission to the AFMS Institute will have to submit an application duly signed by competent authority delegated by the sponsoring organization. These candidates will not have a post course service liability and will not be paid a stipend as they are drawing pay/allowances through their parent org.

2.3 **Ex-SSC AFMS officers:** -

2.3.1 Officers released from service after completion of contractual service, within three years after the release from service are eligible for admission with no service/bond liability. The date of release should not be before 31 Dec 2022 for the 2025 session.

2.4 Officers who have resigned the commission/dismissed/removed from service/not completed the contractual service are **NOT ELIGIBLE** under this category.

2.5 **Civilian doctors:** -

2.5.1 **Maximum permissible age shall be less than 30 completed years as on 31 December 2025 (i.e. date of birth is on or after 01 Jan 1996) to fulfill the service liability mentioned here under.**

2.5.2 The candidate should be willing to serve the Armed Forces Medical Services (AFMS) for 05 years subject to fulfilling other eligibility criteria. **Candidate will have to execute a bond agreement as per Appx 'B' at the time of admission, to pay a sum of Rs. Sixty-Two Lakhs Only (Rs. 62,00,000/-) to Govt. of India, for the session 2025-28 in case unwilling to join AFMS when offered commission on completion of the course.**

2.5.3 Civilian doctors will have to undergo medical examination by duly constituted medial board at the time of admission, so as to assess their fitness for commissioning as per laid down criteria and will be admitted only if found MEDICALLY FIT.

Note: - Candidates will undergo Annual Medical Examination (AME) by duly constituted medical board during the course and will be declared NSL if found medically unfit post which conditions as stipulated in the surety bond shall be applicable (**Appx B**).

2.6. **Qualifications:** Candidates must have MBBS & MD/MS/DNB Degrees registered with State Medical Council or NMC. Students who have completed/are completing Post-Graduation as per dates promulgated by NBEMS/NMC are eligible for admission along with Provisional Registration Certificate.

2.7. **The candidate must be a citizen of India.**

2.8. A candidate who is already pursuing any super specialty course is not eligible for admission to another super specialty course in the Academic Year 2025. Any candidate holding a recognized super specialty qualification is not eligible for admission to AFMS institutions.

3. **SEATS & RECOGNITION STATUS: -**

3.1. AFMC Pune is recognized by the National Medical Commission (NMC) (erstwhile MCI) and is affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik for the following courses: –

4. **COUNSELING:** - The common counseling for all seats of NEET-SS at National level will be conducted by Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), MoHFW. Hence, all eligible candidates desirous of admission to super specialty courses (DM/MCh/DrNB) in AFMS institutions for the 2025 session will have to register mandatorily on the portal for Super Specialty counselling on the MCC website: www.mcc.nic.in.

5. **PROCESS OF ADMISSION AND MEDICAL EXAMINATION:** -

5.1. Following procedure will be carried out at the respective AFMS institution in the sequence mentioned below for the candidates allotted DM/MCh/DrNB seats during Super Specialty Counselling-2025 by MCC:

5.1.1. Document verification by Board of Officers on the day of reporting.



5.1.2. Medical examination of the candidates by a separate Board of Officers over 2-3 days.



5.1.3. Declaration of medical examination results by Presiding Officer of medical examination.



5.1.4. Candidates found **MEDICALLY FIT** will submit the Surety Bond agreement and deposit his / her original documents.

(Note: The candidates should arrange for their boarding and lodging for approximately 04-05 days. Candidates are advised to report to allotted institute at the earliest after declaration of the result of online counseling as specified and candidate have to report on empty stomach for the medical examination)

5.2. Candidates while reporting for admission will have to bring the following documents: -

5.2.1. 06 (Six) passport size latest photographs.

5.2.2. Copy of the NEET-SS 2025 Admit card.

5.2.3. NEET-SS 2025 Score Card.

5.2.4. Copy of Class X/SSLC/ICSE certificate as valid certificate of proof of age.

5.2.5. Copy of University Mark Sheet of first to final MBBS examinations and Post-Graduation course.

5.2.6. Copy of Internship Completion Certificate.

5.2.7. Copy of Permanent/Provisional state Medical Council Registration Certificate of MBBS & Post graduation course

5.2.8. Copy of MBBS & Post-Graduation degrees (Passing Certificate if degree has not been received.)

5.2.9. Copy of Nationality Certificate/Xerox copy of valid Passport/Domicile Certificate/Birth Certificate.

5.2.10. Copy of Attempt Certificate (MBBS & MD/MS/DNB as applicable).

5.2.11. Copy of Transfer Certificate for non-AFMC candidates.

5.2.12. Copy of Migration certificate for non-MUHS candidates.

5.2.13. Copy of Aadhaar Card.

5.2.14. Sponsorship Certificate in case of Medical Officers sponsored by Para-Military Forces/Govt. of India organization. Sponsorship Certificate issued by the sponsoring authority should be specific to the subject allotted and is a mandatory requirement for the candidate to be considered for admission as a sponsored candidate.

5.2.15. In case of Ex AMC SSC Officers, release order from Armed Forces Medical Services issued by DGAFMS/concerned Medical Directorate.

5.2.16. Civilian candidates, if selected, will be required to execute a bond agreement at the time of admission, to pay a sum of **Rs. Sixty-Two Lakhs Only (Rs. 62,00,000/-)** to Govt. of India, for the session 2025-28 in case unwilling to join AFMS when offered commission on completion of the course as per **Gol letter No: 17436/DGAFMS/DG-1D/334/21/D(Med) dated 15 March 2021**. The bond is to be executed on a Rs 500/- non judicial stamp paper registered/notarized with the office of sub-registrar and has to be submitted at the time of admission. Expenses in connection with registration of Bond Agreement are to be borne by the respective candidate.

Note: Admission to DM/MCh and DrNB courses at AFMS institutions is provisional, subject to confirmation/ ratification by the O/o DGAFMS, MUHS Nashik, NMC/NBE. Candidates are free to seek any clarification before accepting a seat during the counseling.

SURETY BOND FOR CIVILIAN DOCTORS SEEKING ADMISSION TO POST DOCTORAL COURSE (2025 TO 2028 BATCH) IN AFMS INSTITUTIONS

I, _____ (Name of Student) Son/Daughter/Ward of _____ (Name of father) Resident of _____ (full address) hereinafter called the '**Post-doctoral student**' (which expression shall include his/her heirs, executors, administrators and representatives) _____ (Name of Surety) Son/Daughter/Ward of _____ (Name of father) Resident of _____ (Full Address) at _____ (Full Address) at presently employed at _____ (particulars of employment) in the _____ (address of the employer) herein after called the 'Surety' (Which expression shall include his heir, executors, administrators and representatives) are jointly held and firmly bound into the President of India (hereinafter called the 'Government' in the terms and conditions for admission to Post-doctoral course at **AFMS Institutes** stated hereinafter and expenses that may have been incurred 'By occasioned to the Government be paid to the Government for which payment to be will and truly made we hereby bind ourselves, our heirs executors, administrators and representative few firmly by these presents as witness our hands this _____ day of _____ (Month & Year).

2. And whereas the Post-doctoral Student has undertaken to join and continue SS studies in accordance with rules and regulations of the _____ (Institute Name & University Name) for obtaining DM/MCh & DrNB in _____ (Subject) of the _____ (Name of University) and join the Armed Forces Medical Services as a short service commissioned Officer on successful completion of the course if found medically fit for the same. And whereas in consideration of the government having agreed to sanction the admission to the said SS student, the candidate along with the surety has agreed to execute the above Bond with such conditions as hereunder written.

2.1 That in consideration of the Post-doctoral Student being admitted by the Govt. to _____ (Institute Name) for the purpose of obtaining SS degree the Post-doctoral Student and surety covenant with the Government that the said Post-doctoral Student will attend the _____ (Institute Name) for obtaining Post-doctoral Students and such other training as Government may determine from time-to-time for the prescribed period until he/she successfully completes his/her SS degree course and is declared medically fit (as to which the decision of Director General Armed Forces Medical Services shall be final) to be granted Short Service Commission and that the Post-doctoral Student will be commissioned as a Medical Officer in the regular Indian Army or the Indian Navy or Indian Air Force as SSC Officer to serve for 05 years unless he/she, the Post-doctoral Student is prevented from doing so on account of ill health or some

other reason over which he/she, the Post-doctoral Student has no control as determined by a service medical board (as to which the Government shall be the sole judge) or by being removed on the ground that the student is considered by the appropriate authority to be unfit to continue as Post-doctoral Student, or on any other ground, to be granted a commission.

2.2 That in the event the Post-doctoral Student either attains the age of 35 years as on 31 December of the year of successful completion of his/her Post-doctoral course or refuses to accept commission in the Armed Forces Medical Services on successful completion of his/her Post-doctoral course, the Post-doctoral Student and the Surety shall jointly be liable to pay and refund forthwith to the Government of India on demand and without demur an amount of **Rs 62 Lakhs (Rupees Sixty Two Lakhs only)** as per Govt of India letter No 17436/DGAFMS/DG-1D dated 15 Mar 2021 and No. 3569/DGAFMS/DG-1B(i)/389/21/D (Med) dt 19 Apr 2021 together with interest on the said money, calculated at the rates in force then. The interest will be calculated after 30 days from date of successful completion of PG course or from the designated date of joining the Armed Forces unit as per the posting order issued whichever is later.

2.3 That the Post-doctoral Student shall on successful completion of his/her Post-doctoral degree course will report within such period, as may be allowed by the Director General Armed Forces Medical Services as joining time to the unit or station as specified in this behalf by the Director General Armed Forces Medical Services for grant of Short Service Commission on terms and conditions set out in Army Instruction 75/78 and as amended from time-to-time.

2.4 That the Post-doctoral Student after grant of short service commission, if applies for release from service within **Five years** of grant said commission for any reason whatsoever and provided his/ her release is sanctioned by the Govt of India, as per rules in force, he/ she shall be relieved only after he/ she has refunded Bond money at the rate of Rs. **12.4 Lakhs (Rupees Twelve Lakhs and Forty Thousand only)** per completed year or part thereof of unfulfilled liability limited to the Bond money as contained in the Bond agreement executed at the time of admission.

2.5 That if the Post-doctoral Student leaves the institution without completing the course due to any reason after the last date of admission to the Post-doctoral course as specified by NMC/affiliated University, he/ she will be required to pay a sum of **Rs. 20.66 Lakhs (Rupees twenty Lakhs and Sixty Six Thousand only)** per year or part thereof of the education at the institution based on extant rules subject to the conditions laid down in the subsequent paras.

2.6 The Post-doctoral Student will be declared to have become Non-Service Liability (NSL) on being rendered medically unfit for commission by a Medical Board due to any disease/disability detected at any stage during the training or prior to commissioning as under: -

2.6.1 The Medical Board will express their opinion on the circumstances under which the candidate acquired the diseases/disability and whether or not he/she had any control over those circumstances. The three categories of

Post-doctoral Student declared Non-Service Liability on medical grounds are as follows: -

2.6.1.1 **Category-I** - Declared medically unfit due to disease/circumstances within their control like drug abuse, accidents, and injury in brawl/fights. Such candidate will be liable to pay Bond Money as applicable to him/her before being allowed to continue further studies and will have to pay the cost of training as applicable for further period of study from the date declared NSL.

2.6.1.2 **Category-II** - Declared medically unfit due to disease/circumstances beyond their control, but are not related to service or training course he/she is undergoing. Such candidate will not be liable to pay Bond Money but will have to pay 50% of cost of training as applicable for further period of study from the date declared NSL.

2.6.1.3 **Category-III** - Declared medically unfit due to disease/circumstances beyond their control and are related to service or training course he/she is undergoing. In such cases Bond money and cost of training to be waived off. However, college/university fee and boarding and messing charges and hospital stoppage where applicable shall be levied.

2.6.2 Based on the above factors the Bond Money to be recovered is computed as under: -

2.6.2.1 No Bond Money will be recovered from the Post-doctoral Student who are declared unfit for Commissioning/NSL on following medical grounds: -

2.6.2.1.1 Declared medically unfit due to disease/circumstances beyond their control and are related to service or training course they are undergoing (**Category III**).

2.6.2.1.2 Declared medically unfit due to disease/circumstances beyond their control, but are not related to service or training course they are undergoing (**Category-II**).

2.6.2.1.3 Due to disease/ circumstances beyond their control and who do not refuse treatment but necessitating withdrawal from the College.

2.6.2.1.4 Due to death.

2.6.3 However, the Post-doctoral Student mentioned at Para 2.6.1.2 and 2.6.2.1.2 above (Category-II) may be permitted to continue their medical education on approval of Director General of Armed Forces Medical Services. They have to pay 50% of cost of training as applicable for further period of study from the day they are declared NSL. In addition, they will also be levied tuition fee and other charges including college fees, university fees,

boarding and messing charges and hospital stoppage where applicable from the day they are declared NSL.

2.6.4 The current cost of training is **Rs 37,617/- per week** and it may be revised in future based on training cost approved by the Govt of India. The cost of training is to be paid half yearly. Delay in payment beyond 30 days will invite interest and penal charges. Post-doctoral Student who cannot pay the further cost of training and other charges as specified by the Government or who do not wish to continue their education, consequent to being declared unfit for commissioning/ Non-Service Liability (NSL) on medical grounds or other circumstances, will be allowed to withdraw from the course.

2.6.5 Post-doctoral Student who are declared unfit for Commissioning/ NSL on Medical grounds/ circumstances other than those mentioned at Para 2.6.2.1 are liable to pay the Bond money as applicable to them before being allowed to continue further studies. These Post-doctoral Student may be allowed to continue their further medical education on approval of Director General of Armed Forces Medical Services (DGAFMS) and will have to pay the cost of training as applicable for further period of study from the date declared NSL. They will also be levied tuition fees and other charges including college fees, university fees boarding and messing charges and hospital stoppage whereas applicable from the day they are declared NSL.

2.7 That if the **Post-doctoral DM/MCh/DrNB** student leaves the training institute voluntarily without completing the course due to any reason (other than medical grounds) after the permissible withdrawal period as governed by the prospectus, if any, will be liable to pay the amount of the Bond Money at a rate proportionate to the amount of time they have trained in the institute, limited to the total Bond money as contained in the Bond executed at the time of admission.

2.8 That if the **Post-doctoral DM/MCh/DrNB** student rendered as NSL due to reasons other than medical grounds (viz. indiscipline, failure to adhere to the stipulated code of conduct, violation of medical ethics etc.) will be removed from the College Rolls and will be liable to pay the Bond Money as applicable to student and will not be allowed to continue further studies.

2.9 That if the **Post-doctoral DM/MCh/DrNB** student is found to be medically unfit in the pre-commission medical examination due to any disease/disability/pregnancy, will be reviewed by a medical board within six months of initial medical examination or within six months of delivery (in case of pregnancy) and if found fit, will be offered SSC. The candidate will report to his/ her parent teaching institute for such medical examination within six months of initial medical examination or within six months of delivery. If the candidate fails to report to his/her parent teaching institute for medical examination within the stipulated time or fails to join on being declared fit and offered SSC, he/she will be liable to pay the full Bond money. If after review he/she is found medically unfit for commission due to disease/ circumstances within their control like drug abuse, accidents and injury in brawl/fights he/she would be liable to pay full Bond money as contained in bond executed at the time of admission, whereas, if after review he/she is found medically unfit for

commission due to disease/ circumstances beyond their control, but are not related to service/ training course he/she is undergoing, he/she would be liable to pay 50 % Bond money as contained in the bond executed at the time of admission. However, if the candidate is medically unfit due to disease/ circumstances beyond their control which are related to the service or training course, on which the decision of the DGAFMS would be final, in such cases the entire bond money may be waived off.

2.10 That if the **Post-doctoral DM/MCh/DrNB** student who on completion of the course wants to be released from service liability before completion of the Liability period, provided the same is accepted by the Government, will be liable to pay the amount of the Bond Money at a rate proportionate to each complete year or part thereof of unfulfilled liability, limited to the total Bond Money as contained in the Bond or the total amount as contained in the undertaking executed at the time of admission.

2.11 That if the **Post-doctoral DM/MCh/DrNB** student leaves the institution and refuses to fulfill any of the Bond conditions, his/her original documents will not be handed over until he/she pays the surety Bond money as applicable and any other dues decided by the Commandant of the AFMS **Post-doctoral DM/MCh/DrNB** institution.

3. The terms and conditions mentioned in the agreement may get revised/amended as per the directions of Govt of India as far as related to payment of Bond money in default of honoring this agreement. The SURETY will be liable to agree to the same. In case of dispute, the decision of Govt of India will be final and binding on the Sureties or either.

4. In the event of non compliance of the aforesaid clauses or failure on the part of Sureties to comply with the Bond, the sum due hereunder will be liable to be recovered as an arrear of Land Revenue.

5. Under no circumstances does the clauses mentioned under section 133 & 135 of the Indian Contract Act, 1872 or any other rule of law or equity as applicable on that behalf, any indulgence of forbearances shown by the Govt of India to the candidates whether with or without consent of the sureties or either shall not operate as discharge of the sureties obligations under the said Bond.

6. NOW THE CONDITION OF THE OBLIGATION is such that the **Post-doctoral DM/MCh/DrNB** student after grant of **Short Service Commission** serves for a period of **five years** or cause to be paid to the Government the amount due to his/ her in contravention of the Bond agreement then this Bond shall be void, otherwise the same shall be and remain in full force.
