**Sub: Implementation of AEBAS as per Gazette Notification issued by the Government of India for Applications received from Pharmacy Institutions seeking Approval for the Academic Session 2026–2027.**

Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to the appeals submitted by the institutions against the latest decision communicated by the Council for the Academic Session 2026-2027 on the basis of SIF, IR and Appeals.

It is hereby informed that the Council has observed that, despite multiple circulars and reminders regarding the proper implementation of AEBAS across all institutions, including regular attendance marking by all faculty members in accordance with PCI norms, the institutions have failed to ensure effective implementation and compliance of the same.

It has further been observed that in several cases, institutions have only completed partial registration under the AEBAS system without ensuring full operational compliance. Instances have been noted where institutions have registered on the portal but have not installed or mapped the biometric devices, while in some cases faculty members have not been properly onboarded into the system. Additionally, there are cases where faculty members have been registered on AEBAS but are not marking attendance as mandated under PCI norms and guidelines.

Such non-compliance reflects inadequate implementation of the system despite repeated directions and sufficient opportunity provided by the Council for adherence to the prescribed requirements.

Therefore, Institutions are advised to ensure complete and proper implementation of AEBAS in all respects, including device integration, faculty onboarding, and regular attendance marking by all faculty members strictly as per PCI norms.

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Failure to comply with the requirements of AEBAS shall lead to non-consideration of the institution's appeal application for the Academic Session 2026–27. Since sufficient opportunities, circulars, and reminders have already been issued by the Council for compliance, and thus, in case of non-compliance institution shall not claim before any court of law that adequate opportunity was not provided or that the appeal was not considered by the Council.

Further, continued non-compliance and failure to fulfil the prescribed AEBAS requirements may result in rejection of the application or putting the institution under the “Not to Make Admissions” category for the Academic Session 2026–27.
