नीट यूजी प्रवेश वर्ष 2026 की राज्य स्तरीय काउंसिलिंग हेतु श्री रावतपुरा सरकार इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंसेज़ एंड रिसर्च, नवा रायपुर की एम.बी.बी.एस. सीटों में वृद्धि के संबंध में।

नीट यूजी प्रवेश वर्ष 2026 की राज्य स्तरीय काउंसिलिंग में भाग लेने वाले समस्त अभ्यर्थियों को सूचित किया जाता है कि राष्ट्रीय आयुर्विज्ञान आयोग (NMC) के अंतर्गत अंडर ग्रेजुएट मेडिकल एजुकेशन बोर्ड (UGMEB) द्वारा जारी Letter of Renewal, राष्ट्रीय आयुर्विज्ञान आयोग के आदेश, श्री रावतपुरा सरकार इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंसेज़ एंड रिसर्च, नवा रायपुर द्वारा प्रस्तुत पत्र तथा पं. दीनदयाल उपाध्याय स्मृति स्वास्थ्य विज्ञान एवं आयुष विश्वविद्यालय, छत्तीसगढ़, रायपुर द्वारा जारी Consent of Affiliation के आधार पर श्री रावतपुरा सरकार इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंसेज़ एंड रिसर्च, नवा रायपुर की एम.बी.बी.एस. पाठ्यक्रम की प्रवेश क्षमता शैक्षणिक सत्र 2026-27 हेतु 100 सीटों से बढ़ाकर 150 सीटें किए जाने के फलस्वरूप छत्तीसगढ़ राज्य नीट यूजी प्रवेश वर्ष 2026 की काउंसिलिंग हेतु उक्त महाविद्यालय की संशोधित सीट मैट्रिक्स में 150 सीटें सम्मिलित की जाती हैं।

ORDER

Subject: First Appeal filed by Shri Rawatpura Sarkar Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Raipur, Chhattisgarh, challenging the Letter of Disapproval dated 20.07.2026.

The Appellant Medical College has preferred the present First Appeal dated **25.07.2026** under Section 28(5) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 challenging the Letter of Disapproval dated **20.07.2026** issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB). The Appellant had submitted an online application bearing Application No. **NMC/UGI/2026-2027/0253** seeking permission for increase in intake of seats in the name of Shri Rawatpura Sarkar Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Raipur, Chhattisgarh, with an annual intake of **50 MBBS Seats (100 to 150)** for the Academic Year **2026-2027**. The proposal was examined by MARB in accordance with the provisions of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, the Establishment of Medical Institutions, Assessment and Rating Regulations, 2023 and the applicable statutory and regulatory framework.

2. During scrutiny of the application, MARB observed certain deficiencies/non-compliances and, accordingly, issued a Show Cause Notice dated **06.06.2026** calling upon the Appellant to remove the deficiencies and submit the requisite documents/information within the prescribed period. The relevant deficiencies/observations communicated by MARB are reproduced below:

S. No.	Parameter	Deficiency / Additional documents to be submitted
1	During renewal of seat in AY: 2025- 26, the number of seats have been reduced by UGMEB from 150 to 100.	Compliance on the deficiency issue pointed out during renewal of seats in AY:2025-26 is to be furnished.

3. In response thereto, the Appellant submitted its compliance report(s), claiming that the deficiencies had been rectified and/or furnishing explanations and documents in support of its application. Upon scrutiny of the compliance report, the physical inspection report dated 15.06.2026 and the material placed on record, MARB observed that the following material deficiencies/non-compliances persisted:

S. No.	Deficiency / Issue	Observation / Reason recorded by MARB
1	Faculty	i. As per AEBAS records for the period from 18.02.2026 to the date of review of the assessors' reports (SAF). The total registered faculty strength is 213 against the prescribed requirement of 114 faculty members. Of these, 134 faculty members have recorded AEBAS attendance of at least 75% ii. The department-wise deficiency of eligible faculty (having AEBAS attendance of at least 75%) is as follows: Anatomy (02 Associate Professors); Community Medicine (01 Assistant Professor); Forensic Medicine & Toxicology (FMT) (01 Assistant Professor); Microbiology (01 Assistant Professor); Obstetrics & Gynaecology (OBG) (01 Associate Professor); Ophthalmology (01 Professor); ENT (01 Professor); Paediatrics (01 Professor); Physiology (01 Associate Professor); and Psychiatry (01 Professor and 01 Associate Professor), resulting in an overall deficiency of 12 eligible faculty members. iii. According to the assessors' report, the teaching faculty deficiency is 18%, while the deficiency of Tutors/Demonstrators/Senior Residents is 20%. iv. The available eligible faculty is inadequate to satisfy the prescribed faculty requirements under the applicable statutory and regulatory provisions for the proposed increase in the annual intake of MBBS seats. Accordingly, the proposed increase in annual intake cannot be considered.
2	Clinical load	i. MRI investigations-zero.

In view of the above, MARB concluded that the proposal failed to fulfil the applicable statutory/regulatory requirements and issued the Letter of Disapproval dated **20.07.2026**. Aggrieved thereby, the Medical College has preferred the present First Appeal.



4. In this regard, the instant 1st Appeal has been admitted, and the Appeal Committee, constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. Abhijat Chandrakant Sheth, Chairman, NMC and two Members, met on **29.07.2026** to consider the said Appeal filed by the Medical College. The following Appeal Committee members were present during the meeting:

- a. Dr. Abhijat Chandrakant Sheth, Chairman, NMC - Chairman
- b. Dr. D. K. Sharma, Medical Superintendent, Dr. Rajendra Prasad Centre for Ophthalmic Sciences, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi - Member
- c. Prof. (Dr.) Gangadhar Taduri, Department of Nephrology, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences (NIMS), Hyderabad, Telangana - Member

5. The Appeal Committee has given a virtual hearing to the Medical College on **29.07.2026**, represented by the Dean/Principal/Vice-Principal/HoD. The Medical College presented its submissions and the Committee duly considered the submissions made by the Appellant and examined the records placed before it.

6. It is noted that the Undergraduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) had already issued **Letter of Renewal No. U-15029/09/2026(1)-UGMEB** dated **09.07.2026**, granting **Conditional Renewal of 150 MBBS seats** to the Appellant for the Academic Year 2026-27. The Conditional Renewal is subject to subsequent Physical / Virtual / Hybrid Assessment by MARB. The institution was directed to clear all existing infrastructure, faculty and clinical deficiencies within 45 days, failing which MARB would be at liberty to take action under Section 26(a), (c) & (f) of the NMC Act, 2019.

7. Further, the Seat Matrix for Undergraduate (MBBS) Courses for the Academic Year 2026-27, issued by MARB vide Public Notice dated **14.07.2026**, inter alia reflected the allocation of 150 MBBS seats to the Appellant institution. The said Seat Matrix was communicated to the Medical Counselling Committee, DGHS and other stakeholders.

8. The Appeal Committee has carefully examined the Letter of Disapproval dated 20.07.2026, the appeal memorandum, the documents on record, the Letter of Renewal dated 09.07.2026 issued by UGMEB, and the Seat Matrix Public Notice dated 14.07.2026. The substantive relief sought in the present appeal - namely, permission for increase/renewal of MBBS intake to 150 seats for AY 2026-27 - already stands granted by UGMEB vide the Conditional Letter of Renewal dated 09.07.2026 and is reflected in the Seat Matrix dated 14.07.2026 of MARB. The said grant was made prior to the issuance of the Letter of Disapproval and prior to the

filing of the present appeal. Consequently, the grievance against the Letter of Disapproval no longer survives.

9. In these circumstances, the Appeal Committee finds that the present appeal has become **infructuous**. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the findings recorded in the Letter of Disapproval dated 20.07.2026, the **First Appeal is disposed of as infructuous. No further orders are required.**

10. It is clarified that the renewal of 150 MBBS seats granted by UGMEB is a Conditional Renewal. MARB retains the right to conduct assessment/inspection at any point of time and to take appropriate regulatory action under the NMC Act, 2019 and the applicable regulations, including Section 26 thereof, if any deficiencies are found to persist or arise.

12. Accordingly, the 1st appeal filed by the Medical College stands disposed of.
