

**ADMISSION NOTICE FOR POST GRADUATE COURSE (MD/MS) IN AFMS INSTITUTION  
FOR THE SESSION 2022-25**

1. Armed Forces Medical services (AFMS) conducts Advance Specialist/ Post Graduate training primarily for the doctors of Armed Forces Medical Services. The candidates eligible to apply for MD/MS/DNB seats at various AFMS PG institutions are (in order of preference):-

- (a) **Priority-I** : Eligible serving officers of the AFMS
- (b) **Priority-II** : Foreign students sponsored by Govt.
- (c) **Priority-III** : Medical officers sponsored by Para Military Forces/ other Govt. of India organizations.
- (d) **Priority-IV** : Ex-SSC AFMS officers released from service after completion of contractual service, within three years after the release from service (i.e, the date of release should not be before 01 May 2019 and after the last date of joining into the courses as notified by MCC for the session starting from 04 Oct 2022.
- (e) **Priority-V** : Civilian doctors willing to serve in the Armed Forces Medical Services (AFMS) for 05 years after completion of the course subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria. The candidate will have to execute a bond agreement to pay an amount as sanctioned by the Govt. of India at the time of admission, in case unwilling to join AFMS, when offered commission on completion of the course. Format of Surety Bond is enclosed.

2. PG Course are available in following AFMS institutions:-

- (a) Armed Forces Medical Collage, Pune
- (b) Army Hospital (Research & Referral), Delhi Cantt.
- (c) INHS Asvini, Mumbai.
- (d) Command Hospital (Air Force), Bangalore.
- (e) Command Hospital (Eastern Command), Kolkata.
- (f) Command Hospital (Western Command), Chandimandir.
- (g) Command Hospital (Central Command), Lucknow.
- (h) Institute of Aerospace Medicine, Bangalore.

3. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- (a) A candidate must be a citizen of India (except Priority II candidate).
- (b) Age criteria:-
  - (i) AFMS Officers : As per extant training rules of AFMS.
  - (ii) Sponsored candidate : As per Govt. of India rules.
  - (iii) Civilian candidates : Maximum permissible age will be 30 years on 31 Dec 2022 (DOB on or after 01 Jan 1993).  
(for Priority-V candidates).

- (c) Candidates must have MBBS Degree registered with State Medical Council or MCI. Students who have completed/ are completing internship by 31 Aug 2022 are eligible to apply alongwith provisional registration certificate.
- (d) The candidate must have appeared in NEET- PG 2022 and secured minimum qualifying score as indicated by MCC to be eligible for AFMS counseling..
- (e) There is no reservation based on caste/ religion etc. and the selection will be purely on the basis of merit.
- (f) A candidate who is already pursuing any post graduate course shall not be eligible for admission to another PG course in the academic year 2022.
- (g) The number of candidates to be admitted in any discipline will be determined by the number of PG teachers available, the student-teacher ratio and any other criteria laid down by the NMC/ affiliated universities from time-to-time. The exact number of available seats will be communicated to the counseling committee prior to counseling session.
- (h) Candidates admitted will have a service liability/bond liability binding as per Govt of India instructions on the subject.

#### 4. **COUNSELING**

As per the notification of MCI No. MCI-18(1)/2017-Med./128371 dt 31 Jul 2017, the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, shall conduct counseling for all Post Graduate Courses (MD/MS) in Medical education institutions of the Central Govt. Hence, all eligible candidates desirous of pursuing PG course at AFMS institutions for the session commencing from 04 Oct 2022 will have to register on MCC/DGHS MoHFW website for AFMS counseling. Seats will be allotted in merit in order of preference as enumerated in para 1 above by offline (physical) counseling. The schedule of AFMS counseling is as follows :-

#### 5. **Action by candidates**

- (a) Candidates desirous of admission to Post Graduate courses at AFMS institutions and fulfilling the initial eligibility criteria as mentioned above have to register for AFMS institutes on MCC website for the centralized counseling.
- (b) It is the responsibility of the candidates to ascertain whether they meet the requisite eligibility criteria, final eligibility will be ascertained at the time of admission.

(c) Civilian doctors will have to undergo medical examination by a duly constituted medical board so as to assess their fitness for commission as per laid down criteria and will be admitted only if found fit

(d) List of certificates to be produced/ submitted in original by selected candidates in the day of counseling/ admission

- (i) 06 (six) Passport size photographs.
- (ii) Copy of the NEET - PG 2022 admit card.
- (iii) Print out of registration details page from the DGHS website [www.mcc.nic.in](http://www.mcc.nic.in) for counseling.
- (iv) NEET-PG 2022 score card as published by NBE.
- (v) SSLC/ICSE certificate as valid certificate of proof of age.
- (vi) Nationality certificate/Xerox copy of valid passport and domicile certificate(where applicable)/Birth certificate endorsed with nationality as India on it.
- (vii) First of final year MBBS mark sheets of respective university.
- (viii) MBBS pass certificate/degree certificate.
- (ix) Internship completion certificate.
- (x) Permanent/provisional State Medical Council registration certificate.
- (xi) Attempt certificate.
- (xii) Transfer certificate/Migration certificate.
- (xiii) Educational Gap affidavit if any.
- (xiv) Allotment letter which will be published on the website after counseling is over.

(xv) **Priority III Candidates**

Subject specific sponsorship certificate ( as per format available on the website) issued by the respective Para Military/ other Govt of India organization is mandatory. This has to be produced at the time of counselling without which candidates shall not be allowed to attend counseling. During counseling eligible candidates will be considered eligible for only those subjects, which are mentioned in their sponsorship certificate duly signed by the competent authority delegated by the Head of the respective organization. Original copy of the sponsorship certificate will be required to be deposited at the time of admission.

(xvi) **Priority IV Candidates**

In case of Ex-AMC/SSC Officers, release order from Armed Forces Medical Services by DGAFMS/ concerned Medical Directorate and movement order from last unit for proceeding on release will be required to be shown in original at the time of counseling and admission. SSC Officers in their last year of contractual service will have to produce their original release order from the Armed Forces Medical Services at the time of counseling without which candidate will not be allowed to attend the counseling. SSC Officers in their extended contractual service must, in addition, have a copy of the permission letter from the O/o DGAFMS besides the proof of being released from services before the date of joining as notified by MCC.

(xvii) **Priority V Candidates**

Civilian doctors willing to take admission in the AFMS Institutions to pursue PG courses will have to report to AFMC, Pune for physical

counseling as mentioned above. All civilian candidate joining AFMS Institutions for PG degree (MD/MS) course from the session 2022 will have to execute a Bond of Rs. 54.5 Lakhs (Rupees Fifty Four Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) as per GSL No 17436/DGAFMS/DG- 1D/334/21/D(Medical) dt 15 Mar 2021.

**SURETY BOND FOR PRIORITY-V STUDENT SEEKING ADMISSION  
TO POST GRADUATE (PG) COURSE (2022 TO 2025 BATCH)**

conditions for admission to PG course at **AFMS Institutes** stated hereinafter and  
expenses that may have been incurred 'By occasioned to the Government be paid to  
the Government for which payment to be will and truly made we hereby bind  
ourselves, our heirs executors, administrators and representative few firmly by these  
presents as witness our hands this \_\_\_\_\_ day of

2. And whereas the PG Students has undertaken to join and continue PG  
studies in accordance with rules and regulations of the  
\_\_\_\_\_ (Institute Name &  
University Name) for obtaining MD/MS in

\_\_\_\_\_ (Name of University) and join the Armed  
Forces Medical Services as a short service commissioned Officer on successful  
completion of the course if found medically fit for the same. And whereas in  
consideration of the government having agreed to sanction the admission to the said  
PG student, the candidate along with the surety has agreed to execute the above  
Bond with such conditions as hereunder written.

(a) That in consideration of the PG students being admitted by the Govt. to  
\_\_\_\_\_ (Institute Name) for the purpose of  
obtaining PG degree the PG student and surety covenant with the  
Government that the said PG student will attend the  
\_\_\_\_\_ (Institute Name) for obtaining PG  
degree and such other training as Government may determine from time-to-  
time for the prescribed period until he/she successfully completes his/her PG  
degree course and is declared fit (as to which the decision of

Director General Armed Forces Medical Services shall be final ) to be granted Short Services Commission and that the PG student will be commissioned as a Medical Officer in the regular Indian Army or the Indian Navy or Indian Air Force as SSC Officer to serve for 05 years unless he/she, the PG student is prevented from doing so on account of ill health or some other reason over which he/she, the PG student has no control as determined by a service medical board (as to which the Government shall be the sole judge) or by being removed on the ground that the student is considered by the appropriate authority to be unfit to continue as PG student, or on any other ground, to be granted a commission.

(b) That in the event the PG student either attains the age of 35 years as on 31 December of the year of successful completion of his/her PG course or refuses to accept commission in the Armed Forces Medical Services on successful completion of his/her PG course the PG student and the Surety shall jointly be liable to pay and refund forthwith to the Government of India on demand and without demur an amount of Rs 54.5 Lakhs (Rupees Fifty Four Lakhs and Fifty thousand only) as per Govt of India letter No 17436/DGAFMS/DG-1D dated 15 Mar 2021 and No. 3569/DGAFMS/DG-1B(i)/389/21/D (Med) dt 19 Apr 2021 together with interest on the said money, calculated at the rates in force then. The interest will be calculated after 30 days from date of successful completion of PG course or from the designated date of joining the Armed Forces unit as per the posting order issued whichever is later.

(c) That the PG student shall on successful completion of his/her PG degree course will report within such period, as may be allowed by the Director General Armed Forces Medical Services as joining time to the unit or station as specified in this behalf by the Director General Armed Forces Medical Services for grant of Short Service Commission on terms and conditions set out in Army Instruction 75/78 and as amended from time-to-time.

(d) That the PG student after grant of short service commission, if applies for release from service within **Five years** of grant said commission for any reason whatsoever and provided his/ her release is sanctioned by the Govt of India, as per rules in force, he/ she shall be relieved only after he/ she has refunded Bond money at the rate of Rs. **10.9 Lakhs (Rupees Ten Lakhs and Ninety Thousand only)** per completed year or part thereof of unfulfilled liability limited to the Bond money as contained in the Bond agreement executed at the time of admission.

(e) That if the PG student leaves the institution without completing the course due to any reason after the last date of admission to the PG course as specified by NMC/affiliated University, he/ she will be required to pay a sum of **Rs. 18.16 Lakhs (Rupees Eighteen Lakhs and Sixteen Thousand only)**

per year or part thereof of the education at the institution based on extant rules subject to the conditions laid down in the subsequent paras.

(f) That the PG student made Non service Liability (NSL) on medical grounds will be required to pay Bond money at 50% of amount laid down, for further period of study from the date declared NSL, before he/ she is allowed to continue his/her studies. He/ She will be liable to pay the remaining 50% of the Bond money on completion of the course. However, in case of student becoming medically unfit for commission due to any disease or disability contracted in the circumstances over which he/ she has no control (on which the decision of the DGAFMS shall be final) and for which he/ she has not refused treatment, he/ she will not be required to pay any Bond money but will have to pay the cost of training as applicable for further period of study from the date declared NSL.

(g) That if the PG **(MD/MS)** student leaves the training institute voluntarily without completing the course due to any reason (other than medical grounds) after the permissible withdrawal period as governed by the prospectus, if any, will be liable to pay the amount of the Bond Money at a rate proportionate to the amount of time they have trained in the institute, limited to the total Bond money as contained in the Bond executed at the time of admission.

(h) That if the PG **(MD/MS)** student rendered as Non Service Liability (NSL) due to reasons other than medical grounds (viz. indiscipline, failure to adhere to the stipulated code of conduct, violation of medical ethics etc.) will be removed from the College Rolls and will be liable to pay the Bond Money as applicable to student and will not be allowed to continue further studies.

(j) That if the PG **(MD/MS)** student found to be medically unfit in the pre-commission medical exam due to pregnancy, will be reviewed by a medical board within six months of delivery and if found fit, will be offered SSC. The candidate will report to her parent teaching institution for such medical examination within six months of delivery. If the candidate fails to report to her parent teaching institution for the medical examination within the stipulated time or fails to join on being declared fit and offered SSC, she will be liable to pay the full Bond Money. If after review, she is found medically unfit for commission, she will be treated as NSL case and would be liable to pay Bond Money as contained in the Bond executed at the time of admission.

(k) That if the PG **(MD/MS)** Student who on completion of the course wants to be released from service liability before completion of the Liability period, provided the same is accepted by the Government, will be liable to pay the amount of the Bond Money at a rate proportionate to each complete year or part thereof of unfulfilled liability, limited to the total Bond Money as contained in the Bond or the total amount as contained in the undertaking executed at the time of admission.

(l) That if the PG (MD/MS) student leaves the institution and refuses to fulfill any of the Bond conditions, his/her original documents will not be handed

over until he/she pays the surety Bond money as applicable and anyother dues decided by the Commandant of the AFMS PG **(MD/MS)** institution.

3. The Terms and conditions mentioned in the agreement may get revised/amended as per the directions of Govt of India as far as related to payment of Bond money in default of honoring this agreement. The SURETY will be liable to agree to the same. In case of dispute, the decision of Govt of India will be final and binding on the Sureties or either.

4. In the event of non compliance of the aforesaid clauses or failure on the part of Sureties to comply with the Bond, the sum due hereunder will be liable to be recovered as an arrear of Land Revenue.

5. Under no circumstances does the clauses mentioned under section 133 & 135 of the Indian Contract Act, 1872 or any other rule of law or equity as applicable on that behalf, any indulgence of forbearances shown by the Govt of India to the candidates whether with or without consent of the sureties or either shall not operate as discharge of the sureties obligations under the said Bond.

6. NOW THE CONDITION OF THE OBLIGATION is such that the PG student after grant of **Short Service Commission** serves for a period of **five years** or cause to be paid to the Government the amount due to his/ her in contravention of the Bond agreement then this Bond shall be void, otherwise the same shall be and remain in full force.
