

FLOW CHART FOR INTAKE OF STUDENTS TO BSc(N) COURSE

Introduction: BSc Nursing Course is conducted at six Colleges of Nursing of Armed Forces Medical Services namely College of Nursing AFMC Pune, INHS Asvini Mumbai AH(R&R) New Delhi, CH (EC) Kolkata CH (CC) Lucknow and CHAF Bangalore. The candidates will be selected for training at Colleges of Nursing under AFMS according to the total intake of students sanctioned by the Govt of India Ministry of Defence annually and based on the final merit cum option prepared using NEET (UG) score, Computer Based Test of General Intelligence and General English (ToGIGE), Psychological Assessment (PA) and Interview, subject to medical fitness and vacancies at each College.

On successful completion of their training, the eligible students will be commissioned into Military Nursing Service.

Eligibility Conditions: Eligibility conditions are:-

- (i) Female candidates who are unmarried / divorced / legally separated / widow without encumbrances.
- (ii) Nationality - Citizen of India
- (iii) Date of Birth - the candidate must not be less than 17 years or more than 25 years of age in which year the course is due to commence.
- (iv) Educational Qualification - Candidate must have passed in the FIRST ATTEMPT, Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) or equivalent (12 Years schooling) with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) and English with not less than 50°/aggregate marks as a regular student from a Statutory/Recognized Board/University/Examining Body. Candidates who will be appearing for final year of qualifying examination during the current academic session may also apply provisionally. The candidates finally selected for the course will have to submit proof of passing the qualifying examination with requisite subjects and marks before joining the course.

STEPS FOR SELECTION TO BSc(N) IN COLLEGES OF NURSING UNDER AFMS

Register for NEET(UG) of that particular year www.nta.ac.in



Qualify NEET (UG) conducted by NTA.



Advertisement in Employment News, Web notification in Join Indian Army and ADG Strat Communication

Register and apply for BSc(N) at the Join Indian Army website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in, Payment of application fees of Rs 200/- (except SC/ST) to be done through SBI E challan.



Application for registration for BSc(N) will be hosted on JIA website (within 24-48 hrs of declaration of NEET(UG) result.

List of shortlisted candidates by use of NEET(UG) score will be published on JIA website along with the date wise schedule for screening.



A ticker notifying that the admit cards have been released is placed on the JIA website. Email and SMS intimation to the shortlisted candidates.

Appear for the screening process (Document verification, ToGIGE, Interview, Psychological Assessment, Medical Examination) at Base Hospital, Delhi Cantt on the given date if called to attend the same.



ToGIGE (Test of General Intelligence and General English) will be in the form of Computer Based Test (CBT) consisting of 40 MCQs of two marks each for maximum marks of 80. There will be negative marks of 0.5 for every incorrect answer. These 40 questions will be required to be answered in 30 mins.

Medical fitness of the candidate is decided as per the medical fitness standards and criteria prescribed for grant of Commission in the Armed Forces.



Final selection will be based on combined merit of NEET (UG) scores + ToGIGE scores + Psychological Assessment and Interview subject to medical fitness.



Merit List will be prepared and colleges will be allocated to the selected candidates based on merit cum choice, subject to seats available at each college.
