AIIMS-MBBS Admission (NEET-UG 2025)

This information is only for the candidates who are allotted **AIIMS-New Delhi** as per the result of 1st Round of MBBS-seat allocation by the Medical Counseling Committee for NEET-UG 2025. The results of the first round of counseling for NEET-UG 2025 is to be announced by Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) on **03-04 August 2025***.

Please read the instructions provided by MCC regarding the process of reporting and taking admission. As per the schedule of the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), the candidates who are allotted AIIMS-New Delhi, are required to report at AIIMS, New Delhi, to complete the process of Admission **from 04 August 2025 to 08 August 2025**.

Venue for Reporting

Following activities are required to be completed by candidates:

Activity	Dates	Time
1. Reporting Verification & submission of original documents.	From 04 August 2025 to 08 August 2025	9.30 AM to 4.00 PM (for verification and submission of original documents). For GH & Holidays: The timings shall be from 10:00 AM To 2:00 PM.
2. Medical Examination and submission of Academic Fees.	07 & 08 August 2025	Reporting at 8:45 AM The medical shall be conducted on 07 & 08 August 2025 in Conference Hall and on declaration of Medical Fitness, Candidates are required to pay the requisite Academic Fee as provided in the Prospectus.
3. Hostel Accommodation and submission of Hostel Fees.	08 August 2025 and if required the same will continue on 09 August, 2025	<u>After 9:30 AM at the Conference Hall.</u> On declaration of Medical Fitness, candidate has to deposit the requisite fee for hostel accommodation. Hostel accommodation will be done immediately after submission of fees.
4. General Orientation Programme.	11 August 2025	A General Orientation Programme with Director AIIMS and Dean Academics along with other Faculty members will be arranged for 2025-Batch MBBS students in conference hall.
5. Orientation Programme CREST.	From 12 August 2025 to 17 August 2025	An orientation programme has been arranged for 2025-Batch MBBS students for their welfare at Conference Hall, which is compulsory to attend for all. The regular classes will start from 18 August 2025.

Note:- Candidates should be prepared for an additional day of stay as joining and medical examination may spill over to next day.

Subject: **Revised** Instruction for Reporting for Admission for AIIMS-New Delhi (NEET-UG 2025)

Dear **Student**,

On behalf of AIIMS, I congratulate you and your family on your success.

As per the result of first round of Counseling conducted by Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) for NEET-UG 2025 admissions, you have been allotted admission at **AIIMS, New Delhi**. Please read the instructions provided by MCC regarding the process of reporting and taking admission from the website of MCC. As per the schedule of the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), **you are now required to report at Academic Section, Undergraduate Cell, AIIMS, New Delhi**, to complete the process of Admission from **04 August 2025 to 08 August 2025**.

• **List of Documents to be brought on day of reporting**

A. Exam and Counselling related

1. Provisional Seat Allotment Letter from MCC.
2. NEET/NTA Scorecard – original print.
3. NTA Admit card – original print.
4. Five Passport size Photographs.
5. Identity Proof (Aadhar Card/ Election Card/Passport or any photo identity proof issued by Government of India).
6. One set of Photocopy of each of the document mentioned above.

B. Eligibility and category related

1. Certificate of having passed the 10+2 or equivalent Examinations, showing the subject offered by him/her in the Examination.
2. Certificate from the Board from which he/she passed the High School/Higher Secondary Examination, showing his/her date of birth.
3. Certificate/Mark sheet from the Board from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent Examination showing that he/she has secured 60% or more marks (50% in case of SC/ST Candidates & 45% for persons with Benchmark Disability) in aggregate in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
4. Migration Certificate from the University/Board last attended by him/her.

Applicable only to candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Tribe/OBC/EWS/ OPH Category:


- a. SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority. Community should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
- b. OBC Certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the **central list** of OBC. OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy layer. OBC certificate must be in the prescribed format. (The OBC certificates issued from 01 April 2024 (inclusive) to the start of reporting of Round-1 of MBBS counselling as notified by (MCC) will be considered valid for admission for NEET (UG) 2025.
- c. EWS Certificate issued by the competent authority. The EWS certificates issued from 01 April 2024 (inclusive) to the start of reporting of Round-1 of MBBS counselling as notified by (MCC) will be considered valid for admission for NEET (UG) 2025.
- d. Certificate from prescribed authority showing that he/she belongs to Persons with Benchmark Disability Category, if applicable.

NOTE: The candidates must bring two set of copies of the above mentioned documents while reporting for the submission of documents.

Those candidates who join MBBS course at AIIMS, New Delhi, his/her Original certificates will be retained and the same will not be returned to the candidate before completion of the course.
