Sub:- Scheme of Examination for Ph.D Entrance Examination-July 2024 session scheduled to be held on 13^{th} August, 2024 for AIIMS, New Delhi.

In reference to Clause C: General Eligibility, where a candidate can apply for up to three different specialties/departments as per eligibility, and Clause E: Method of Selection and Scheme of Examination for Stage I & II, the following details pertain to the structure of the question paper and the duration of the exam:-

The total duration and number of questions for Stage I & II will be as published in the prospectus. However, to accommodate candidates appearing in more than one subject, the following will apply to all:

- Stage I will consist of 30 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) as per the published scheme, with a duration of 40 minutes.
- Stage II (subject-related theory) will consist of 40 MCQs as per the published scheme, with a duration of 50 minutes.
- The total examination time for both stages will be 90 minutes, comprising 70 MCQs.

Candidates must follow following steps:

- 1. The admit card will be issued for each applied subject separately which will include, in addition to the roll number, a login ID for each stage. The password for the examination will be announced in the examination hall
- 2. First, all candidates has to attempt Stage I using respective Login Id, which consists of 30 MCQs with a duration of 40 minutes, and then submit their answers.
- 3. After submitting Stage I, candidates are mandatorily required to log in again with Stage II login Id and attempt Stage II, which consists of 40 MCQs with a duration of 50 minutes.
- 4. Candidates who have applied for more than one specialty/department must bring admit card of all applied subjects, failing which will be not be allowed to appear in respective subject for which admit card not brought at examination center.
- 5. Candidates who have applied for more than one specialty/department need to attempt Stage I only once using admit card of any subject where Login Id for Stage I will be common for every subject. However, they must attempt Stage II for each subject separately one after other as per login Id mentioned in admit card of respective subject.
- 6. Candidates who have applied for more than one specialty/department are mandatorily required to bring in notice in advance before day of examination if have been issued admit cards containing different login Id for Stage I **OR** allocated different examination center for different subject, failing which will not be considered for subject in which will not be able to appear.
- 7. The result for each subject will be calculated independently by combining the scores from Stage I and Stage II as per scheme of examination published in the prospectus.

8. For PWBD candidates compensatory time will be as follows (if applicable): -

Compensatory time for Stage -I	15 minutes in addition to 40 minutes i.e. 55 minutes
Compensatory time for Subject related theory	20 minutes in addition to 50 minutes i.e. 70 minutes

All other contents of Prospectus remains same.

<u>Important</u>: All applicants are required to visit the website regularly since all subsequent Corrigendum/Addendum/Updates will be uploaded in the website only.
