(a) to (c): Setting up of 22 new AIIMS has been approved under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), 6 of which at Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur, Patna, Raipur and Rishikesh are already functional. Details of the remaining 16 AIIMS are at Annexure.
