	Candidate should be a citizen of India.
2	AGE LIMIT (For details kindly refer clause 16.1.1.C. of NEET UG – 2023 Bulletin) :
	No candidate shall be admitted to BSMS / BAMS / BUMS / BHMS Degree Course unless one has
	attained the age of Seventeen Years on or before the 31 st December, 2023 for admission in the first
	year of the course and there is no upper age limit.
3	EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:
	(i) Admissions to all State Quota seats of Undergraduate Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and
	Homoeopathy Courses will be done through NEET (UG) - 2023 as per the provisions of the
	National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate
	Ayurveda Education), Regulations 2022, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine
	(Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Siddha Education), Regulations 2022 and National
	Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani
	Education), Regulations 2022, and National Commission for Homoeopathy (Homoeopathy
	Graduate Degree Course – BHMS) Regulations 2022 (NCISM & NCH are Regulatory Bodies
	of the above-mentioned Courses under the Ministry of AYUSH).
	(ii) In order to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses for this academic
	year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50 th Percentile in
	NEETUG-2023. However in respect of candidates belonging to OBC / SC / ST, the minimum
	marks shall be at 40th Percentile in NEETUG-2023. In respect of candidates with Persons
	with Benchmark disabilities alone the minimum marks shall be at 45 th Percentile for General
	Category candidates and 40 th Percentile for OBC / SC / ST candidates in NEET UG-2023.
	Note:
	Provided further that where sufficient number of candidates in the respective category fail to secure
	minimum marks in the National Eligibility – cum – Entrance Test held for any academic year for
	admission to undergraduate programme, the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine &
	National Commission for Homoeopathy, in consultation with the Central Government may at its

discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to undergraduate programme for candidates belonging to respective category and marks so lowered by the Central Government shall be applicable for that academic year only.

(iii) Further, to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses, Candidates must have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (Academic) conducted by Any State Board or any other equivalent Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology and English individually and must have obtained minimum of fifty percent of marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and forty percent mark in the case of OBC / SC / ST category. In respect of Persons with Benchmark disabilities candidates the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology shall be forty five percent in the case of general category and forty percent in the case of general category and Forty percent in the case of OBC / SC / ST.

NOTE:- Candidates who have passed any other equivalent examinations other than the Tamil Nadu State Board Examination, CBSE and ICS with same subjects as mentioned above in clause **3** (iii) should produce the eligibility certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University before the counselling date or before attending the counselling.

- (iv) Candidates qualified in the NEET (UG) 2023 and who have passed the qualifying examinations from *National Institute of Open Schooling* or *State Open Schools* or *as private candidates* from recognized State Boards; or with Biology/Biotechnology as an additional subject shall be allowed but subject to the outcome of Special Leave Petitions/ Appeals filed by the Medical Council of India. (As per NEET (UG) 2023 Guidelines)
- Note: * "The proviso in italics has been a subject matter of challenge before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, and Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Jabalpur. The provisions of the regulations disqualifying recognized Open School Board candidates and the candidates who have studied Biology/Biotechnology as an Additional Subject has been struck down."




