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The schedule for conduct of B.Sc., (Nursing) NS & Post Basic B.Sc., (N) courses Regular Theory Examinations of April/May, 2023 is furnished hereunder. The dates of commencement Practical Examinations will be notified separately.

THE FOLLOWING ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPEAR FOR EXAMINATIONS AT THE CENTERS DESIGNATED.

I. B.Sc. (Nursing) - NEW SCHEME - 4YDC

- 1st Year:- A) All the 1st year students who were admitted during the academic year 2021-22.
 - B) All the 1st year failed students appeared during examinations held in Sept., 2022.

 The candidates admitted during the academic year 2014-15 and before are not eligible.

II. Post Basic Nursing Course (PBNC) - 2YDC

- 1st Year:- A) All the 1st year students who were admitted during the academic year 2021-22.
 - B) All the 1st year failed candidates appeared during examinations held in Sept., 2022.

 The candidates admitted during the academic year 2018-19 and before are not eligible.

III: <u>FULFILLMENT OF ATTENDANCE AND OTHER REGULATIONS OF B.Sc., (N)</u> DEGREE COURSE:

The candidates should have requisite attendance of 80% in-each subject in Theory & Practical separately.

Only the candidates who fulfilled all the clauses of regulations of B.Sc. (N) Degree course are eligible to appear at the examinations.

Therefore, the candidates are advised to check their eligibility before paying the fees.

IV. Minimum qualifying marks required to appear at the University External Examinations of Theory & Practical:

- A. The candidate should secure minimum 50% marks in Internal Assessment of Theory and Internal Assessment of Practical in each subject to appear for B.Sc. (N) exams in 1st year under New Scheme.
- B. The Principals are directed to verify the eligibility before freeze the data in Medhas Portal i.e., that the candidate has appeared and passed at the Internal Assessment Theory / Practical examinations separately.
- C. No Institutions shall submit average internal marks of the test students more than 75% i.e., if 40 students are admitted in a course, the average score of the 40 students shall not exceed 75% of total internal marks. (Example of 5 students: A=2, B=20, C=22, D=21, E=24 average score=89.6%. This will not be accepted by the State Nursing Council.

V. THE PRINCIPALS OF THE COLLEGES HAVE TO FORWARD EXAM FEE, OTHER EXAMINATION MATERIAL (i.e., ATTENDANCE, INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS TO THE UNIVERSITY BEFORE THE DUE DATE.



VI. GUIDELINES FOR SCANNING AND UPLOADING OF PHOTOGRAPH, SIGNATURE

PHOTOGRAPH IMAGE:

Please find below the guidelines for submitting a photograph of the student.

- > Photograph must be a recent passport size color picture.
- > The photograph of the student should be taken in uniform.
- > In full color and of high quality to avoid any visible pixels.
- > A recent photo, taken within the last 6 months.
- > Candidate's name, last name, and date on which photo was taken to be mentioned on the picture.
- > Head positioned directly facing the camera, centered, should compose 80% of the image.
- > The photo should capture the candidate from slightly above the top of the hair to the middle of the chest.
- > Eyes open and looking at the camera. Glasses must not be tinted unless worn daily for medical purposes.
- A natural expression smile allowed.
- > Subject (candidate) is in clear focus and distinguishable from the background. Solid color backgrounds are best.
- > Full face must be visible.
- > Scan the photograph and save it as a jpg file.
- ➤ Allowed Photo Size 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm (Width: 275pixels, Height: 354pixels)



Size of file should be between 10 KB-20 KB

SIGNATURE IMAGE:

- > The applicant has to sign on white paper with Black or Blue Ink/Gel pen.
- > The signature must be signed only by the applicant and not by any other person.
- > The signature will be used to put on the Hall Ticket, attendance sheet and wherever necessary.
- > The Applicant's signature on the answer script, at the time of the examination should match the signature on the Hall Ticket.
- Dimensions 3.5 cm x 1.5cm (preferred) (Width: 275 pixels, Height: 118 pixels)
- > Size of file should be between (5 KB to 10KB)
- Ensure that the size of the scanned image is not more than 10KB.

VII: PAYMENT OF FEES AND SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATIONS:

 - 4. The Receipt obtained after completion of the online payment should submit to the University along with the material without fail.
 - 5. The payments paid after the due date shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

FRESH INTERNAL ASSESSMENT IS MANDATORY FOR REFERRED AND DETAINED STUDENTS. THE PREVIOUS INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

The marks once submitted to the University through the MEdHAS Portal will not be altered under any circumstances. No request for change of marks once entered will be entertained.

X: EXAMINATION CENTERS:

The candidates have to appear for the examinations (both Theory and Practical) at the centers specified by the University. The candidates have to make their own arrangements to reach the examination centers well in advance at their own cost. The name of the examination center will be given in the e-Hall Tickets (in respect of theory examinations) issued by the University.

The name of the practical examination center will be informed through Principals of respective colleges of Nursing.

XI: EXAMINATION DATES:

XIII: SINGLE ANSWER BOOKLETS:

Digital Valuation System is introduced for B.Sc., (N), Post Basic B.Sc., (N) and B.Sc., (MLT) courses from June/July, 2019 Examinations. Hence, all the students will be given answer booklets with 48 writable pages only henceforth for all examinations. No additional booklets will be given. All the Principals are directed to inform the same to all the students without fail duly displaying prominently in all the notice boards.

NOTE: The Principals of all affiliated Nursing Colleges are requested to submit Temporary advance adjustment Bills along with unspent amount, if any, college fails to submit the adjustment bills, the advance amounts will be kept pending until submission of adjustment bills.
