### Subject: - Schedule for 2<sup>nd</sup> round of online counseling for admission to MDS courses of Punjab State under NEET MDS-2024

<b>1</b>	Date for fresh online registration/application and deposition of application and security deposit for fresh applications alongwith fee of Rs. 5900 (Rs. 2950 for SC candidates) including 18% GST through university payment portal. (fresh registered candidates will have to submit willingness alongwith security deposit for 2 <sup>nd</sup> online counseling . Failing which their candidature will not be considered.	<b>27-07-2024 to 29.07.2024 upto 5.00 PM</b>
<b>2</b>	The dates for submitting willingness alongwith security deposit for 2 <sup>nd</sup> round of counseling by all the candidates and fresh applicants). The amount of security to be deposited for submitting willingness will be as under: <b><u>For Government colleges- Rs. 25000/- (Rs. 10000/-for SC/BC)</u></b> <b><u>For both Govt. &amp; Private Colleges – Rs. 2,00000/-</u></b> <b><u>For Private Colleges- Rs. 2,00000/-</u></b>	
<b>3</b>	Display of tentative vacancy position of seats for 2 <sup>nd</sup> round of MDS Counseling  <b>Note:</b> The candidates can submit choices/preferences of college/seat as per their choices even if vacant seat is not shown in the vacancy position as the candidates can surrender the seat of 1st round upto stipulated period and vacancy position will be updated accordingly	<b>27.07.2024</b>
<b>4</b>	Last date of correction/editing in online filled application form. Therefore application will be locked automatically. Once information filled and locked will not be allowed to change in any round of counseling. <b>Note:</b> Since, fresh applications are invited for 2 <sup>nd</sup> round of online counseling under NEET MDS 2024 from <b><u>29-07-2024</u></b> , hence already registered candidates of 1 <sup>st</sup> round counseling (if any ) who intends to edit any Category/Minority Quota/other particulars will give request/application personally in the Admission Branch, BFUHS upto <b><u>29-07-2024</u></b> alongwith relevant proof for consideration in 2 <sup>nd</sup> round of online counseling as last chance. No request shall be entertained through email. Thereafter no request will be entertained.	<b>29-07-2024 upto 5.00 PM</b>
<b>5</b>	Last date for submission of hard copy of admission application form at University office for <b>NRI quota seats</b> . Candidates seeking admission under NRI quota are required to obtain Eligibility Certificate from the University prior to apply. (Application form for obtaining Eligibility certificate and admission application form are separately available on University website.)	<b>29.07.2024</b>
<b>6</b>	The candidates who will apply under Sikh Minority/Christian Minority Quota will report to the respective minority institution (SGRD Institute of Dental Sciences, Amritsar/ Christian Dental College, Ludhiana) for verification of minority status. The candidates who have already/got verified their minority status at the time of 1 <sup>st</sup> counseling, need not report to the respective institute for verify again. The candidates, who have already registered under Minority Quota during 1 <sup>st</sup> counseling and did not get their minority status verified, can report to the respective institute for verification of their minority status for 2 <sup>nd</sup> round of counseling.	<b>30.07.2024</b>
<b>7</b>	Display of Provisional Merit List of candidates who will submit willingness to participate in 2 <sup>nd</sup> round of online counseling	<b>31.07.2024</b>
<b>8</b>	The candidates who have joined the allotted seats of <b>Round-I</b> in the State of Punjab are allowed to surrender the seat upto <b>01-08-2024</b> with free exit. The interested candidate will have to submit application of surrendering the seat to the Principal of concerned college to enable him to surrender the seat on the online portal so that vacancy for <b>Round-2</b> will get updated automatically, otherwise the candidate will be considered as joined. <b>Note:</b> The vacancy position will be updated automatically in the online portal; hence candidates are advised to fill/review preferences/choices as per automatically revised vacancy.	<b>01-08-2024</b>
<b>9</b>	The candidates who will submit willingness for 2 <sup>nd</sup> round including NRI candidates will fill/submit the online choices/preferences of specialty /college	<b>01-08-2024 to 03-08-2024</b>
<b>10</b>	Processing of seat allotment	<b>04-08-2024 to 05-08-2024</b>
<b>11</b>	Display of provisional allotment/Result	<b>06-08-2024</b>
<b>12</b>	Last date/time for submission of objections to provisional allotment (if any) by the NEET MDS aspirants. <b>Note:</b> Objections can be submitted only by personal appearance/visit alongwith relevant documents in admission branch, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.	<b>07.08.2024</b>
<b>13</b>	Display of revised provisional allotment/result after any change in provisional allotment due to objections (if any).	<b>08.08.2024</b>
<b>14</b>	The provisionally selected candidates will pay the balance amount of fee (Six month fee after deducting amount of security deposit ) through university payment gateway available on University website and will report to the respective college for joining in the respective allotted college	<b>09-08-2024 to 12.08.2024</b>

**The following categories of Candidates are eligible for seat allotment in 2<sup>nd</sup> round:**

**Category-I:** Registered candidates who did not get any seat allotted in the 1<sup>st</sup> round.

**Category-II:** Registered candidates, whose 1st round of allotted seat got Cancelled during the documents verification on reporting for admission, who have secured seat under reserved quota, due to change of category from reserved to Unreserved or PWD status from yes to No, but are still eligible in the next round of seat allotment, with changed Category, subject to fulfillment of eligible conditions.

**Category –III:** Candidates who have reported/joined at allotted institute during the joining period of round-1 of allotment and submitted willingness for participating in second round up-gradation as 'yes'.

**Category-IV:** Candidates who exited during Round-1 availing Free Exit can log in again with their earlier registered details.

**Category-V:** Candidates who did not register in Round-1 can do fresh registered and participate directly in Round-2

**The following candidates are not eligible for 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of allotment:**

- a) Candidate who has become non- eligible due to having inadequate document as per Eligible Criteria as per Punjab Govt. notification/MCC/Prospectus/DCI
- b) Who have not registered in Round-1 or Round-2

**Frequently asked questions (FAQs):**

<b>Question-1</b>	After allotment of seat in 2 <sup>nd</sup> Round of online counseling does the candidate need to join the allotted seat?
<b>Answer</b>	No, it is not mandatory to join the allotted seat, however, in case the candidate does not join, the <b>refundable security deposit will be forfeited.</b>
<b>Question-2</b>	After joining Second Round of Counseling, whether one can leave/ resign the allotted seat?
<b>Answer</b>	Once the applicants join the 2 <sup>nd</sup> round seat, he/she will be allowed to leave/resign the seat within stipulated period of time. However, in case the candidate leaves/resign/surrender the seat allocated in round two or already allotted seat in round one, <b>refundable security deposit will be forfeited.</b>
<b>Question-3</b>	If a candidate does not report at the allotted college during Round 2 whether he has to register again for Round- 3?
<b>Answer</b>	Yes, <b>Candidate security amount will be forfeited</b> and he can participate in Round 3 only <b>with Fresh registration and security deposit.</b>
<b>Question .4</b>	Whether the candidate can upgrade the Round 2 allotted seat during Round -3?
<b>Answer</b>	Yes, the candidate can upgrade the Round 2 allotted seat during Round 3. In case, the candidate will join the upgraded/allotted seat in Round 3, <b>he/she will not be allowed to resign/leave the seat.</b>
<b>Question.5</b>	If the candidate does not join the allotted/upgraded seat during Round 3, whether the security deposit will be forfeited?
<b>Answer</b>	Yes, <b>the security amount will be forfeited</b> and the candidate will not be eligible to participate in further rounds of counseling.
<b>Question.6</b>	When will conversion of seats to open merit be carried out?
<b>Answer</b>	The conversion of seats of NRI and any reserve category after exhausting all candidates in relevant category will be carried out during the Round 3. The said conversion will be done only when the eligible Candidates belonging to the said Conversion Category have exhausted.
<b>Question.7</b>	What are the circumstances wherein the refundable security deposit will be forfeited?
<b>Answer</b>	Under the following circumstances the refundable security deposit will be forfeited: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Where a Candidate has been allotted a seat in Round -2 or subsequent rounds and does not report at the allotted college to complete the admission process.</li> <li>ii. The Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled after allotment due to any reason. E.g., in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission.</li> </ol>
