ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES IN **AYURVEDA, KERALA 2025**

CANDIDATES CAN SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION AND **REGISTER OPTIONS**

I. Applications are invited for admission to: Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda Vachaspathi MD (Ay.)/Ayurveda Dhanwanthari MS (Ay.) in the Government, Aided and Self Financing Ayurveda Colleges of the State.

II. The titles of the PG Ayurveda Degree Courses are detailed in Annexure III and Annexure III (a) of the PG Ayurveda Degree Prospectus 2025.

III. Participating Institutes

Post Graduate Degree courses are offered at Government Ayurveda Colleges in Thiruvananthapuram, Trippunithura and Kannur as well as Aided Ayurveda Colleges in Ollur and Kottakkal and other Self Financing Colleges.

IV. Eligibility for admission:

Nativity: The applicant should be an Indian citizen of Kerala origin. Non Keralite candidates are also eligible to apply for admission to PG Ayurveda Degree All India Quota seats and management seats available in the Self Financing colleges.

Age: No upper age limit is specified for admission to the course. In the case of Service Quota candidates, the age limit for Teachers Quota candidates should be 50 as on 31.07.2025 and that of Medical Officer Quota candidates should be 45 as on 31.07.2025. But the upper age limit of Medical Officers Quota (ISM) candidates coming under National Pension Scheme will be 45 as on 31.07.2025.

Qualifying Criteria: All candidates seeking PG (Ay) courses including Service quota in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2025-26 must have qualified for the National Eligibility – Cum Entrance Test for PG (Ay) Courses (AYUSH PGET) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on behalf of the Ministry of AYUSH and should figure in the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The selection of candidates for the seats reserved for the Medical Officer of the Department of I.S.M, the Teachers Quota and the candidate sponsored by the Lakshadweep Administration will be made on the basis of the rank obtained in the Entrance Examination conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on behalf of the Ministry of AYUSH subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions. The minimum eligibility mark in the entrance test (AIAPGET 2025) shall be the 50th percentile in the case of General/EWS category and that of SC/ST/SEBC category shall be the 40th percentile. In respect of Differently Abled Candidates category, the minimum mark shall be at the 45th percentile for the General/ EWS Category and the 40th percentile for the SC/ST/SEBC category.

Academic Qualifications:

Candidates should have passed BAM /Ayurvedacharya /BAMS from the colleges having NCISM recognition and the BAMS Degree of the Universities of Kerala or its equivalent degree recognized by the University of Kerala with 50% of marks for theory and practical separately in each subject. But exemption for minimum marks prescribed for admission for MD (Ay)/MS (Ay) is granted to the students who have passed the BAMS/BAM examination before 1995 from the Universities of Kerala without 50% of marks for theory and practical. The cutoff date for completion of an internship towards determination of eligibility for appearing in **AIAPGET 2025 shall be 31.08.2025**. The dates indicated by the candidates in regards to 12 months Compulsory Rotating

Internship i.e., starting date, completion date shall be treated as final and candidates will be required to submit the original Compulsory Rotating Internship completion certificate at the time of counseling. Admission will be given only on the production of Internship Certificate and Registration Certificate from the Medical Council constituted in this regard.

V. Mode of selection:

The Selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala, on the basis of the AIAPGET 2025 rank list, subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as mentioned in the prospectus.

VI. Submission of Applications and Application Fee

All candidates, including Service Candidates, seeking admission to the Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda can apply online till **19.09.2025, 4.00 PM** through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, by submitting the required details for registration. After completing the registration process, candidates should first enter the details of **AIAPGET 2025**, followed by other required particulars. The prescribed application fee shall be remitted through online payment. After payment of the application fee, candidates must upload their photograph, signature, and all necessary certificates/documents to complete the application process.

***Note:** Already registered candidates can login using their application number and password.*

Application fee once remitted will not be refunded.

Service Candidates, including teachers quota, should submit their

applications to the Director, Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, MG Road, Thiruvananthapuram, before 4.00PM on 19.09.2025 by taking a printout of the online application and submitting it along with NOC (No Objection Certificate) and all necessary certificates. Medical Officers (ISM) should submit their applications through their Controlling Officer (The Director, ISM Department) to the Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogya bhavan, MG Road, Thiruvananthapuram, before 4.00 PM on 19.09.2025. Service candidates need not send their documents to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

VIII. Last date of Application:

All candidates seeking admission to the courses should submit the online application along with uploaded Certificates/Documents mentioned in the prospectus before 19.09.2025, 4.00 PM. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application. No need to send the printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED FOR FIRST PHASE ALLOTMENT

For the 1st Phase allotment to be published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, candidates should register online options along with the submission of online application through the tab '**Option Registration**' available in the Application Page. Candidate who have submitted the application on or before **19.09.2025, 4.00 PM** can register/re-arrange the options by clicking the tab '**Option Registration**' available in the Application Page. Candidates can register options up to **25.09.2025, 2.00PM**.

A registration fee of Rs.2,000/- will have to be paid at the time of Option Registration. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category eligible for benefits as per G.O(Ms)No.25/2005/ SCSTDD dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O (Ms) No.10/20104/BCDD dated:23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sreechitra Home

will have to remit Rs.1,000/- as option registration fee. Registration fees can be remitted by way of online payment. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. If a candidate gets allotment and does not join within the stipulated time, the option registration fee will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Option registration fee of the candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. The registration fee of those candidates who do not join, vacate or lapse the seats allotted after the date to be notified by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be considered as penalty. Refund of option registration fee for the eligible candidates will be made only after the completion of allotment process and it will be notified.

Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations from the available options.

Candidate allotted to course, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidate who fails to take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting to the college

will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

Note:

1. Candidates of Kerala origin can submit online options to be considered for allotment to Post Graduate Ayurveda Degree Seats. However Keralite and Non Keralite candidates can register options to be considered for admission to PG Ayurveda All India Quota seats and management quota seats available in the Self Financing Colleges.
2. Service Quota candidates shall register options to those seats which are reserved for their quota. Service candidates seeking admission in general quota shall register online options in general category also to be considered for allotment in the quota.
3. PwD Candidates shall register options and shall be considered for admission to PG Ayurveda Degree courses according to the eligibility/suitability of the candidate for pursuing courses/specialty.
4. SC /ST/OEC/ Children Fishermen, inmates of Sree Chitra Home, NirbhayaHome, Juvenile Home candidates are exempted from payment of tuition fee.

Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting/joining to the college will be granted under any circumstances.
