Important Points to Be Noted by Candidates

- Please read the brochure carefully. Take time to read all the important parts mentioned in the “Table of Contents”.
- This brochure is an information booklet alone. The guidelines contained are subject to modifications as per instructions received from time to time from the Government or Statutory Bodies.
- The entire counselling process from submitting application until admission shall be made exclusively through the online mode, except for the stray counselling which shall be made through the offline mode.
- Submission of application shall be only through the CENTAC website – www.centacpuducherry.in. Please read paras-1.5 and 1.6 to know more about the mode of submitting your application online.
- Please note that an exclusive mobile number and an email id of either the candidate or the parents of the candidate is an absolute necessity.
- Access to the candidate’s login dashboard can only be made through OTP validation that is sent to the registered mobile number.
- The documents that you need to keep ready in digital format to be uploaded along with the application is given in para-1.7.
- Please refer to the entitlement of Reservation of Seats for various categories at paras-1.21, 1.24 and 1.25.
- Once you are conversant with the above basic details, note that you will have to submit the course preferences when submitting your online application. Please read para-1.9.
- The details of courses available can be viewed from the seat matrix that will be uploaded separately on the website.
- Always choose multiple course preferences. Failure to mention course preferences will reduce your chance of admissions to an alternate course and not doing so will be at your own risk. Course preferences once submitted for a round will be final. Under no circumstances will any request be entertained to change course preferences.
- After reading all the above essential facts, go in for submitting your application online.
- Please note that till the last date permitted for submission of online application, you will be able to edit the entries made by you including your personal details and course preferences. After the last date, your application will be frozen with no further edit possible.
- The publication of merit list, mode of counselling, allotment of seats, mode of admission, payment of fee etc. are detailed from paras 1.10 to 1.16. Please read them carefully.
- Future communication with registered candidates will only be through SMS / emails, and candidates should regularly read the press releases that will be uploaded on the website for updates.

1.1 INTRODUCTION

The counselling for allotment of candidates to M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.V.Sc.&A.H. (National-Self-Supporting and NRI) courses for the year 2024-25 will be done by the State Counselling Authority, CENTAC.

All admissions to M.B.B.S., B.D.S., B.A.M.S., B.S.M.S., B.U.M.S., and B.H.M.S. courses will be done as per the relevant norms / guidelines / regulations notified by the concerned Regulatory Bodies under NCISM Act 2020 and NCH Act, 2020.

As per regulations framed under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the Dentists Act-1948, admissions to 100% seats in M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.V.Sc. &A.H. (National- Self-Supporting and NRI) will be done based on NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CUM ENTRANCE TEST - NEET in all Medical / Dental Colleges run with the approval of the Medical Council of India / Dental Council of India /AYUSH /Veterinary Council of India. The NEET (UG) - 2024 – ALL INDIA RANK for COUNSELLING will be taken for admissions by the CENTAC for the Academic Year 2024-25.

The seats allotted under different categories are as below:

- Government Quota Seats in Government Colleges.
- Self-Supporting Seats in Government Colleges.
- Government Quota Seats in Private Colleges.
- Management Quota Seats in Private Colleges.
- Minority (Management – Christian / Telugu) Quota Seats in Private (Minority) Colleges.
- NRI Quota Seats in Government / Private Colleges.

The Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) in the Directorate General of Health Services, MoHFS, GoI does the Counselling for admission to the M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. seats under the following quotas:

- All India Quota Seats (Filled by DGHS):15% seats surrendered by Government Medical / Dental Colleges run as per the approval of MCI / DCI are filled through the counselling conducted by DGHS and are known as All India Quota seats.
- Central Institutions / Universities (Filled by DGHS)
- Seats in Deemed Universities (Filled by DGHS)

Admission to the “Government Quota Seats” in Private and the Minority Colleges will be as per the laws / regulations / orders of the Government of India, or of the Government of Puducherry.

Candidates need to apply **ONLINE** only.

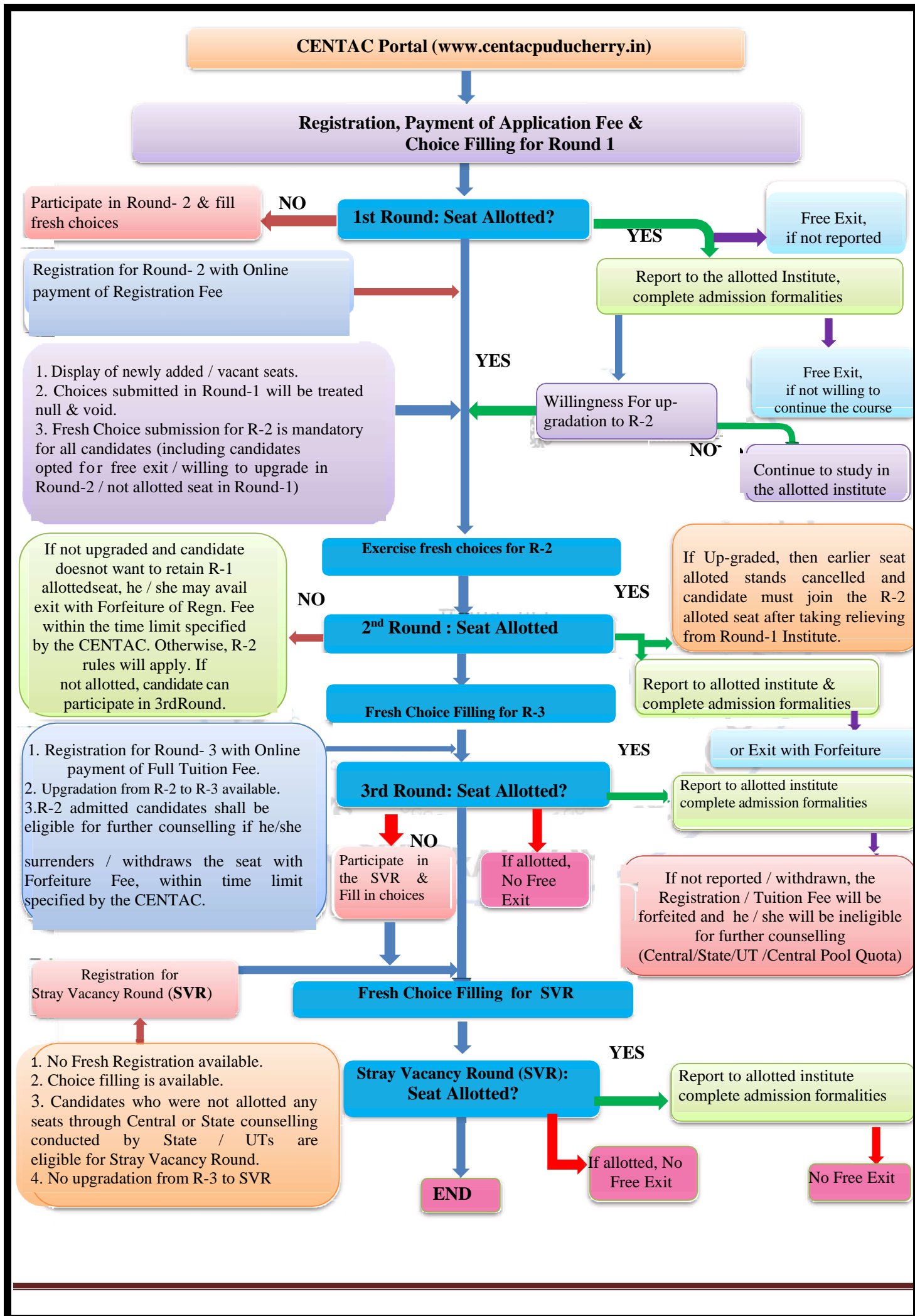
Note: NRI / OCI / Other State / Puducherry candidates willing to join B.V.Sc.&A.H. (Veterinary) under National – Self-Supporting or NRI quota should apply only through CENTAC NEET application.

1.4 OVERVIEW OF COUNSELLING PROCESS

The candidate seeking admission must apply online through the CENTAC website as per the schedule notified. Fresh registration after the due date will not be entertained. The candidate shall comply with all the instructions while filling in the application form.

1.5 MODE OF APPLICATION - ONLINE ONLY

Application must be submitted online **ONLY** through the website www.centacpuducherry.in.

Mere registration does not entitle a candidate for allotment of seat. He / She must fulfill the conditions of eligibility prescribed for the concerned courses.

Before filling the application, read the UG NEET Information Brochure for the year 2024-25 available on the CENTAC website, carefully.

Candidate should ensure that all information entered during the online registration process is correct. Information provided by candidates like name of candidate, contact address, category, educational qualification, marks, date of birth, etc., in the online application will be treated as correct. The CENTAC will not entertain any request for change after the Last Date for submitting Applications.

CENTAC does not edit / modify / alter any information entered by the candidates. However, the CENTAC reserves the right to update inadvertent errors in marks etc., entered by the candidates based on the records made available to CENTAC.

Refer CENTAC website for the opening and closing date of ONLINE application for admission to various courses. CENTAC may reopen the ONLINE application, depending upon necessity.

1.6 STEPS FOR FILLING UP THE APPLICATION

1. All the candidates seeking admission to UG NEET-based courses are required to apply online through the website www.centacpuducherry.in.
2. As a first time user, the candidate shall create his / her login details as per the following steps:-
 - On the “New Registration” page, the candidate has to enter a valid Mobile Number and email. The candidate should take utmost care in providing the Mobile Number and email ID. Any change/modifications will not be allowed.
 - Candidate shall then create a new password (of maximum six characters) for online registration purpose.
 - **Important:** An OTP (One Time Password) will be sent to the candidate's registered mobile number each time the candidate logs in to his / her dashboard.
3. After successful registration, the applicant shall login using his / her “Registered email-id” and “Password” to fill the details in the online application form.
4. Candidate shall **upload the scanned copies of recently renewed and self-attested documents** obtained from the respective competent authorities (wherever necessary). **Original certificates** must be produced only at the time of **admission in the respective colleges**.
5. Applicant can change the details in the application form and uploaded files using the “Back Button” before making payment.
6. The candidate can then proceed with “Make Payment” and complete his / her application submission.
7. After payment is made, corrections, additions, deletions, etc., in any manner will NOT be allowed. The candidates are, therefore, advised to fill their applications carefully.
8. Choices once exercised with regard to community / rural / urban / special categories are final and cannot be changed once the Final Merit List is published.
9. The candidate shall comply with all the instructions while filling in the application form. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.
10. The CENTAC disclaims any liability that may arise to a candidate(s) due to incorrect information provided by him/her in his/her online Application Form.

1.7.1 List of documents (Self-attested copies) to be uploaded by ALL candidates

- Passport size photograph of the applicant (20 to 50 KB)
- Scanned signature of the applicant (20 to 50 KB)
- Birth Certificate / High School / Higher Secondary School Certificate for verification of date of birth (100 to 500 KB).
- Mark sheets of the qualifying examination (100 to 500 KB).
- UG NEET - 2024 Score Card (100 to 500 KB).
- Transfer Certificate from the school last studied in (100 to 500 KB).

1.7.2 Additional Documents for U.T. of Puducherry Candidates, as Applicable (Refer Annexure - I)

- Residence / Community / EWS, if applicable (100 to 500 KB).
- Regional Claim for UG Professional Courses (100 to 500 KB).
- Freedom Fighter / Ex-Servicemen / Person with Disabilities / Sports Certificates, if applicable (100 to 500 KB)
- Transfer Certificate / Study Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution of the school last studied for Government School 10% Quota.
- Affidavit as per Annexure I-A should be uploaded in Rs.20, e-Stamp paper duly attested by the Notary for claiming Puducherry Residence.

Note: Candidates who have studied in Lycée Français and opt for UG NEET courses should produce an eligibility certificate issued from the Pondicherry University subject to the fulfillment of other eligibility conditions.

1.7.3 Additional Documents for Other State Candidates, as Applicable (Refer Annexure - I)

- Residence / Community, if applicable (100 to 500 KB).

1.7.4 Additional Documents for NRI / NRI Sponsored / OCI / FN (Refer Annexure - I)

- Passport / VISA / Resident VISA / Green Card / Citizenship Card / OCI Card (obtained before 04/03/2021) of the Parent or Sponsor.
- Embassy Certificate of the Parent / Sponsor (Certificate from the Consulate).
- Affidavit from the NRI / NRI sponsor that he/ she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate duly notarized by the concerned country.
- Relationship certificate in the form of an Affidavit from the parent, if the parent is not the sponsor.

Note: For the purpose of verification the e-document may be considered, but subject to submitting the original at the time of admission.

1.8 PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEE

In addition to the Application Fee for M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.V.Sc. &A.H. (National SS & NRI) counselling, candidates need to pay the **Registration Fee** to participate in counselling from Round 2.

The candidate should transfer the Registration Fee / Tuition Fee as per instructions for each round, into the CENTAC account through NET BANKING or by generating NEFT / RTGS challan using the payment option available in the dashboard login credentials. Read the HELP Instructions in the dashboard carefully

before proceeding for payment. Only those candidates who pay the Registration Fee / Tuition Fee will be considered for respective rounds of counselling.

Special Note to Candidates who have been allotted seats in JIPMER

It is observed that some of the candidates who have got seats allotted in M.B.B.S. in JIPMER do not opt out and unnecessarily block the seats allotted in CENTAC, thereby, causing unwarranted sliding. CENTAC will obtain the list of candidates who have been allotted seats in JIPMER and these candidates will not be allotted any seats despite their eligibility. If any candidate who has been selected in JIPMER wants his/her name to be considered, then the candidate has to deposit Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) as Cautionary Deposit. This Cautionary Deposit will be forfeited if the candidate is allotted a seat by CENTAC and fails to join within the prescribed date.

1.8.3 FORFEITURE OF REGISTRATION FEE / TUITION FEE

- (i) In **Round 2**, if a candidate does not join the allotted/upgraded seat or surrenders the joined seat in Round 1 or Round 2, then the Registration Fee as mentioned in 1.81. will be **forfeited**.
- (ii) In **Round 3**, seats will be allotted only after the candidate pays the Registration Fee (including **SC / ST** candidates). If the student fails to join the allotted seat then, the Registration Fee of Rs. 1,00,000/- (General / OBC / EBC / MBC / BCM / BT) / Rs. 25,000 /- (SC/ST/PwD) for Government Quota or Rs.2,00,000/- for MQ / NRI, will be forfeited. Candidate once joined the allotted seat, cannot vacate the seat.
- (iii) In the **Stray Round**, seats will be allotted only after the payment of the entire Tuition Fee. **SC / ST candidates registering for Government Quota should pay 25% of the Tuition Fees**. If the student fails to join the allotted seat then,
- If the college is able to fill the seat afterwards, an amount of Rs. 1,00,000/-(General / OBC / EBC / MBC / BCM / BT) / Rs. 25,000 /- (SC/ST/PwD) for Government Quota or Rs.200000/- for Management Quota, will be forfeited and the remaining amount will be refunded after **6 months** so that this acts as a deterrent for blocking of seat.
 - **In case, the college is not able to fill the seat after Stray Counselling, then the entire Tuition Fee will be forfeited.**

Therefore, it is advised that the candidate makes a thoughtful decision before choice filling and taking the seat in any round of counselling. **CENTAC reserves the right to modify these guidelines relating to counselling, depending upon necessity.**

1.8.4 REFUND OF REGISTRATION FEE / TUITION FEE

- (i) Refund will be initiated only after completion of entire admissions process.
- (ii) In case the candidate is not allotted a seat or allotted and has NOT joined the seat after the payment of Registration Fee / Tuition Fee in any round, the fee paid will be refunded (after forfeiture, if any) to the same account of the candidate from which payment had been made.
- (iii) The candidates should keep their bank accounts active until the refund process is completed. The candidates are advised NOT to use unrelated bank accounts for remitting Registration Fee/ Tuition fee amount.

Note: CENTAC will not entertain requests to transfer funds to accounts other than the one submitted at the time of payment of Registration Fee / Tuition Fee.

1.9 CHOICE FILLING / SUBMISSION OF COURSE PREFERENCES

While submitting the ONLINE application, after payment of Application Fee, the candidate will be allowed to enter course preferences (Choice Filling). Candidates are advised to give as many choices of courses for which he/she is eligible. If choices are not made, it will be deemed that he/she is not interested in those particular courses / colleges.

The candidate should give his / her prioritization of course preferences in each round and the last date for submission will be published on the CENTAC website. The candidate will not be able to edit his/her course preference after the last date.

Once course preferences are given, they are final. However, CENTAC reserves the right to permit all the candidates to alter their preferences, if required. The decision taken will be duly intimated to candidates from time to time.

Without course preferences, the candidate will not be considered for allotment. The allotment of seats will be made based on the order of course preferences submitted by the candidate and subject to the availability of seats, as per merit and reservation. Candidates are advised to refer to the seat matrix for details about the various courses, number of seats, reservations, etc.

Entry of New Preferences for Subsequent Rounds of Counselling:

Candidates willing to participate in subsequent rounds of counselling are required to enter new course preferences for each round.

Important Note: From Round II onwards, once the candidate is allotted his / her preferred choice, the earlier admitted seat will be forfeited automatically. Under no circumstance he / she will be permitted to retain the earlier admitted seat.

1.10 MERIT LIST

The Merit List of the CENTAC applied candidates will be prepared based on the UG NEET 2024 - ALL INDIA RANK for COUNSELLING. In case of UG NEET– 2024 score, Cut-Off marks for the different categories fixed by the MCC / MoHFW will be considered.

On verification of the candidate's credentials, the Draft Merit List will be published. Adequate time will be given to raise objections and submit documents, if any, and subsequently, the Final Merit List will be published.

Claim exercised with regard to Residence/ Community/ Special Category are subject to verification of the submitted documents and cannot be changed once the **FINAL Merit List is published**. However, CENTAC reserves the right to update the merit list in case of genuine claims supported by documentary evidence.

Separate Merit List will be prepared for Government Quota Seats & Management Quota Seats. The candidates should refer to the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in for the merit lists of all the courses.

In case, the ONLINE application is reopened for any course, then the Merit List will be updated with all the new applications received for the concerned course. This may alter the existing Merit List as well.

LOWERING OF CUT-OFF

In case, the cut-off marks for UG NEET - 2024 is lowered by the MCC / MoHFW, then fresh application will be invited and a fresh merit list will be drawn.

1.11 REGISTRATION AND COUNSELLING PROCESS

After publishing the FINAL Merit List, counselling will be done as per the guidelines received from the MCC. Admission to the UG M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.V.Sc. &A.H. (National SS & NRI) courses is based on the UG-NEET - 2024 All India Rank for Counselling. **Allotment will be done through online (computer-based) counseling** except for NRI seats. There will be no mock allotment unless notified separately.

For NRI seats blended mode of Counseling will be done and the candidate may participate either directly report at the counseling centre (offline or physical mode) or participate through online mode (link will be sent to the candidate's e-mail ID before counseling). Detail guidelines will be published in CENTAC website before counseling.

Counselling will be done in Round 1 / Round 2 / Round 3 / Stray Counselling, based on the candidate's order of course preferences, category of seats, reservation and NEET ALL INDIA RANK for COUNSELLING. For allotment of Government Quota seats, vertical reservation will be implemented first, and later horizontal reservation, if any, to the extent needed.

Counselling Process for Each Round:

Step 1: Choice filling / Submission of Course preferences.

Step 2: Submit willingness and Payment of Registration Fee / Tuition Fee, if any from Round 2 onwards.

Step 3: Publication of Seat allotment list in CENTAC website.

Step 4: Downloading of Allotment Order.

Step 5: Downloading the Fee payment challan from the dashboard and payment of Fee to CENTAC Account.

Step 6: Physical Reporting to the allotted college for certificate verification.

Step 7: Collecting Admission Slip.

ROUND-1

Eligibility for Participation:

a) All NEET (UG)-2024 qualified candidates who have applied through CENTAC.

ROUND-2

Eligibility for Participation:

a) Candidates who were not allotted a seat in Round 1.

b) Candidates who joined the allotted seat in Round 1 and want sliding in Round 2.

c) Candidates who have opted for free exit in Round 1.

ROUND-3

Eligibility for Participation:

a) Candidates who were not allotted any seat in Round 1 and Round 2.

b) Candidates who joined in Round 1 or Round 2 and submitted willingness for sliding in Round 3.

c) Candidates who did not join Round 1 or Round 2 allotted seat and who submitted willingness for Round 3.

d) Candidates who joined in Round 1 allotted seat and who submitted willingness for sliding in Round 3 but did not participate in Round 2 of Counselling.

e) Candidates who surrender the admitted seat in Round 1 or Round 2, with forfeiture of Registration Fee if any, within the stipulated time prescribed by the CENTAC before the commencement of Round 3 **to avoid disqualification from further counselling. If the candidate fails to do so, he/she shall be ineligible for further counselling (Central / State / UT / Central Pool Quota).**

STRAY VACANCY ROUND

The seats that remain vacant after Round 3 will continue to be filled through the online Stray Vacancy Round.

Eligibility for Participation:

All CENTAC applied candidates **except:**

a. Candidates who already joined the allotted seat in Round 1 / Round 2 / Round 3 of UG-NEET Counselling of CENTAC or All India counselling or Counselling conducted by State/UTs.

b. Candidates allotted a seat in Round 3.

Note:

- a) Candidates must submit their willingness in the CENTAC portal to participate in the Stray Vacancy Round with an undertaking that they are not holding any M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. seats allotted through CENTAC or All India Counselling or Counselling conducted by State/UTs. (Annexure I.14)
- b) No sliding is allowed from any of the three rounds to the Stray Vacancy Round.
- c) If a candidate does not join after acquiring seat in the Ultimate round of the counselling, the candidate may be debarred from participating in the CENTAC counselling for one year.

SLIDING

Sliding will be allowed in Round 2 and Round 3. Each candidate will be allotted only one seat in each round.

If a new seat is allotted for those opting for sliding, the earlier admitted seat will be forfeited / cancelled automatically. Under no circumstances will he / she be permitted to retain the earlier admitted seat.

In Round 3, it is mandatory for all candidates to take admission on their upgraded seats by sliding from the Round 1 or Round 2 admitted seats.

Stray Vacancy Counselling – No sliding will be allowed. Detailed Guidelines will be published on the CENTAC website before the counselling as per instructions received from the competent authority of the Government of Puducherry.

WITHDRAWAL OF THE ALLOTTED SEAT

Candidates admitted in Round 1 and Round 2, can ‘Exit’ within the time specified by the CENTAC with forfeiture, if any. Thereafter, the candidate will not be allowed to vacate the seat during Round 3 or Stray Counselling. But, he / she can opt for sliding in Round 3.

A candidate who does not hold a seat in Round 1 or Round 2, is allotted a seat in Round 3 or Stray Counselling and if he / she fails to join the allotted seat, then the entire Registration Fee / Tuition Fee will be forfeited. Further, he / she will be ineligible for further Counselling (Central / State / UT/ Central Pool Quota). A list of such candidates will be published in CENTAC website.

1.12 MODE OF RESERVATION AND ALLOTMENT OF SEATS

(Applicable for Government Quota Seats in Govt. Colleges and Govt. Quota Seats in Private Colleges in the U.T. of Puducherry)

The Mode of Reservation while allotting the seats will be as follows:

- All the candidates should be Indian Nationals and Residents of Puducherry.
- Vertical Reservation First - General, EWS, OBC, EBC, MBC, BCM, SC, ST, BT
- Regional Reservation (Compartmentalized Horizontal Reservation) for Karaikal, Maheand Yanam.
- Horizontal Reservation (Govt. School 10% / FF/ ESM / PwD / MSP) will be done if adequate seats are not filled after fixing vertical and regional reservation, i.e., if the requisite seats are not filled while doing vertical reservation, the last candidates in the respective categories will be replaced as per merit.

An Example of the Method Used for Filling Horizontal Reservation:

If 5 seats need to be filled under the Persons with Disabilities (PwD) quota, and if 4 PwD

candidates are already accommodated in the Vertical Reservation as per merit, then only 1 PwD candidate will be accommodated into the list by replacing the last candidate as per reservation. If the 5th PwD candidate belongs to the BCM category, then the last candidate in the BCM category will be replaced by this candidate.

De-RESERVATION

The seats will be de-reserved as per the Seats Conversion Algorithm in **Annexure-II**. In case any seat in any RESERVED category remains vacant, the same will be converted into UNRESERVED category and offered for counselling in the Round 3. In case of Regional Reservation (Karaikal, Mahe or Yanam), the seats will be first converted into the respective category of U.T. of Puducherry and even after that if the same are not filled, then they will be converted to UNRESERVED category, e.g., if a B.A.M.S. seat reserved for the SC category in Mahe Region is unfilled then it will be converted into SC category seat with eligibility across the U.T. of Puducherry and even after that if the seat remains vacant, the same will be UNRESERVED to the Mahe General category.

1.13 PROVISIONAL ALLOTMENT

Once allotment is done, the Provisional Allotment list will be published on the CENTAC website. However, allotments of seats are provisional. The CENTAC reserves the right to withdraw any allotment made at any point of time which does not fulfill the eligibility criteria / regulations fixed by the competent authority from time to time.

Eligibility / admissions / allotments made to and by the colleges shall be subject to the approval of the regulatory bodies like MCI / DCI / AYUSH / VCI / Pondicherry University / Apex Bodies, etc.

The CENTAC and the Government of Puducherry reserve the right to make any verification as deemed essential at any point of time into the originality and authenticity of any of the certificates produced by any candidate to fulfill and stake his/her claim to any of the qualifying and eligibility criteria.

If, on such verification, it is found that the candidate has produced fake, fraudulent certificates or has obtained certificates by suppressing facts, he/she will be liable for criminal prosecution, immediate loss of allotted seat without any notice whatsoever, forfeiture of fees paid and levy of penalty as prescribed by the competent authority and will be liable to be debarred from all exams / counselling in future; the authorities may also recommend blacklisting of the candidate to the MCI / DCI / AYUSH / VCI / Pondicherry University / Apex Bodies and also cancellation of license.

1.14 OPTIONS FOR CANDIDATES AFTER ALLOTMENT OF SEATS

Once the candidate has been allotted a particular seat, he/she can take any one of the following decisions:

OPTION 1 – Candidate Allotted a Seat

- Download Allotment Order
- Physical Reporting to the allotted college.
- Submit Original Certificates & Pay Fee
- Confirm Admission and Get Admission Slip
- Not Participate in the Next Round

OPTION 2 - Candidate Allotted a Seat

- Download Allotment Order
- Physical Reporting to the allotted college.
- Submit Original Certificates & Pay Fee
- Confirm Admission and Get Admission Slip
- Participate in the Next Round

OPTION 3 - Candidate Allotted a Seat

- Decline Allotment
- Don't Report to College
- Participate in the Next Round

OPTION 4 - Candidate NOT Allotted a Seat

- Participate in the Next Round

OPTION 5 – Candidate either Allotted or NOT Allotted a Seat and Not Willing to Join any course through CENTAC

- Not participate in further rounds

1.15 JOINING THE COLLEGE

Once the Provisional allotment is done, the candidate must download the **Provisional Allotment Order** and report to the allotted college within the specified time. If the candidate does not report within the given time, provisional allotment will be automatically cancelled. Similar procedure will be followed for the subsequent rounds of counselling.

The candidate is required to submit a Printout of the Application Form, Provisional Allotment Letter and Original Certificates along with self-attested photocopies of all the required documents at the time of Admission with the prescribed fee for payment.

Important Note to Candidates:

- If CENTAC / College or other Authorities find that admission has been offered based on NOT fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements / false or incorrect information / documents and suppression of relevant fact, education qualification or quota, the allotment / admission offered will be summarily cancelled, irrespective of the stage of study of that course and the fees paid shall not be refunded in any case. Further, legal proceedings will also be initiated against such candidates for such actions. Hence, candidates are warned against indulging in such practices, in their own interest.
- The original documents (except Transfer Certificate) submitted by the candidates to be admitted in the respective colleges shall be returned only after obtaining recognition from the respective affiliating bodies, and hence, the candidates are advised to take enough numbers of photo copies of the documents before submitting the originals for verification.
- The final authority to settle disputes, if any, in any matter will be the Chairman, CENTAC.

1.16 FEE STRUCTURE (TUITION FEE)

The fee structure as prescribed by the “Fee Committee” for the year 2024-25 will be published in the CENTAC website, after receiving the same from the concerned department of the Government of Puducherry.

Candidates are advised to go through the details of Tuition Fee notified by the Health Department published on the CENTAC website. Candidates are also advised to verify from the concerned institution the components not covered in the Tuition Fee (e.g., Hostel fee, etc.).

For UG M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.V.Sc.&A.H. courses, candidates should pay the TUITION FEES to the CENTAC account using the payment link in their login dashboard OR use the account details published on the CENTAC website.

1.17 MODE OF COMMUNICATION

The candidate will be informed of all the proceedings of CENTAC through SMS and the same will also be published on the CENTAC website. After the online application is opened, the candidate should refer to the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in regularly.

Candidate must ensure that mobile numbers, e-mail address entered in the online application form are his/her own as the CENTAC will send information / communication by SMS to registered mobile numbers only. It is advised that the candidate also registers an alternate mobile number to which he/she has got access.

No individual communication will be sent to any of the candidates apart from SMS. **CENTAC will not be held responsible for non-receipt of information due to wrong mobile number filled in the Online Application Form** or non-diligent follow up of notifications or press releases published on the CENTAC website or not checking the SMS sent to the candidate.

1.18 SEAT MATRIX FOR SEAT ALLOCATION

The number of seats in the colleges may vary depending on the approval of the concerned competent authorities of the Government of Puducherry. The seat matrix will be published in the CENTAC website after receiving the same from the concerned department of the Government of Puducherry.

The approximate number of seats for UG NEET-based courses is given in the table below:

1.19.1 Minority Quota Seats in Private Medical / Dental Colleges

(i) For **Minority Quota seats in Minority Medical / Dental Colleges** candidates who are **residents of the U.T. of Puducherry and belonging to respective minorities are only eligible**, i.e., for the minority quota seats in PIMS, candidates who are residents of U.T. of Puducherry and belonging to **Christian Religious Minority** alone are eligible. For the minority quota seats in SVMCH&RI, candidates who are resident of the U.T. of Puducherry and belonging to **Telugu Linguistic Minority** alone are eligible. The details of these seats and the fee structure will be notified by the Health Department, Government of Puducherry. Candidates are advised to check the CENTAC website for updates on these.

(ii) U.T. of Puducherry candidates claiming seats under **Christian Minority Quota** should produce valid proof like Transfer Certificate or Community Certificate to prove his / her religion is **CHRISTIANITY**. If CHRISTIANITY is not mentioned in the Transfer Certificate (TC) or Community Certificate, attach certificate as per **Annexure – I.8**.

(iii) U.T. of Puducherry candidates claiming seats under Telugu Minority Quota should produce valid proof like Transfer Certificate or Certificate/letter from the school last studied stating that his/her mother tongue is **TELUGU as per the school admission records**. If Mother Tongue TELUGU is not mentioned in the TC, attach certificate as per **Annexure - I.9**.

1.19.2 Conversion of Minority Quota seats into General Management Quota Seats

In case these minority quota seats are not filled in Round 3 of Counselling, then these unfilled seats will be converted to General Management Quota Seats and filled on All India basis during Round 3 itself.

After exhausting the entire Minority merit list of candidates, the unfilled Minority seats will be converted into All India Management seats and operated in Round 3.

The course preferences for UG NEET M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. Management quota seats in Minority institutions will be enabled in Round 3 and will be operated after converting unfilled seats in Minority quota seats in Round 3 itself.

Note: In Round 1& Round 2, M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. Management Quota Seats for Minority Institutions will not be enabled for PIMS, Pondicherry (Christian Minority) & SVMCH&RI, Pondicherry (TELUGU Minority).

1.19.3 Conversion of Seats in B.A.M.S. /B.D.S.

B.A.M.S. /B.D.S. - Any vacancy in Govt. Quota/NRI Quota after Stray Round of counselling, will be filled with candidates on All India basis under Self-Supporting mode.

1.20 ADMISSION UNDER NRI / OCI / FN CATEGORY

Candidates must be Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) / wards of Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) / NRI Sponsored/ OCI /Foreign National, as applicable.

NRI (Non-Resident Indian) / NRI Sponsored

Non-Resident Indian (NRI) is an Indian citizen staying outside India for more than 182 days in a year. Candidates applying under NRI / Wards of NRI / NRI Sponsored category should submit recent NRI status certificate of the Candidate / Parent /Sponsor issued by the Indian Embassy of the Country concerned with their seal as applicable.

(Ref.: OI-11011/01/2017-OIA-II dated 19.05.2017 of the Director, OIA-II division, Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, Chankyapuri, New Delhi).

Relation of NRI to the candidate should comply with the following conditions:

- a) He / She should be the nearest relation
- b) Definition of the nearest relation (the following relatives having blood relations)
 - Real brother and sister of father i.e., real paternal uncle and real paternal aunt.
 - Real brother and sister of mother i.e., real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.
 - Father and mother of father i.e., paternal grandfather and paternal grandmother.
 - Father and mother of mother i.e., maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.
 - First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.
 - Such person should be an NRI.
- c) Such persons should ordinarily be residing abroad.
- d) Such persons should have looked after the candidate as the guardian and evidence to that effect must be produced before the committee by such a person.

OCI (Overseas Citizen of India)

An Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Cardholder who holds a Foreign Passport / Indian Passport will be considered as NRI only, in the field of education. Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Cardholder will not be considered under Foreign National category for educational purposes vide Ref.: OI-11011/01/2017-OIA-II dated 19.05.2017 of the Director, OIA-II Division, Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, Chankyapuri, New Delhi.

The OCI cardholders will now be eligible to be treated on par with Indian citizens and will be eligible for All India unreserved (General) category seats as well as NRI seats, provided their OCI card was granted before 04.03.2021. Those who had obtained OCI cards after 04.03.2021 will be treated as NRI's and eligible for NRI seats only.

FN (Foreign National)

Applicant must be a Foreign National possessing Foreign Passport and must not be of Indian origin. Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholder even though they hold a Foreign Passport will not be considered as a Foreign National.

1.21 RESERVATION OF SEATS UNDER GOVERNMENT QUOTA

Reservation in admission to various courses for the candidates of the U.T. of Puducherry and Other States belonging to different categories is as given below:

Note 1: Out of 50% Open General seats, 10% EWS seats reservation will be applicable only in such Institutions that have met the criteria of increase of seats.

Note 2:

1. In Govt. Professional colleges, the reservation for All India and Other State Quota is subject to the approval of the concerned authority.
2. Residence/Regional /Special allocation once claimed in the application will not be changed under any circumstances.
3. All the claims for the Residence/Regional/Special allocation should be made in the proper format and should be signed by the competent authorities specified.
4. The reservation under All India Category and Self-supporting Scheme, will be subject to regulations/ guidelines prescribed by respective authority of the College / Institution.

1.21.2 SPECIAL REGIONAL Allocation for Resident of Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam candidates

This is a Compartmentalized Reservation, applicable for admission to courses offered by Govt. / Govt. Aided Society Professional Colleges, for candidates who are Residents of Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam regions and shall respectively be 18%, 4% and 3% of seats earmarked to the candidates of Pondicherry Union Territory, vide G.O.Ms. No. 99 dated 10.08.2006 of the Chief Secretariat (Education).

The candidates claiming admission under specific Regional allocation of seats for Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam shall satisfy the following:

1. Candidates should be ordinarily residents of the respective region for a continuous period of 5 years preceding the date of application.
2. Candidates should have studied in the recognized schools located in the respective regions continuously for 3 years immediately preceding the qualifying examination (including the year of the qualifying examination)

This certificate should be obtained from the Head of the Institution in which they studied in the prescribed format (Annexure-I), and countersigned by the respective Chief Educational Officers of Karaikal and Mahe Regions, and the Regional Administrator of Yanam Region. They should also enclose a Residence Certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar of the respective regions, clearly indicating the address of residence.

1.22 NATIONALITY CRITERIA

A candidate seeking admission for Government Quota, Other State Quota and Self-supporting Quota through CENTAC should be an Indian National. However, French Nationals residing in the U.T. of Puducherry and covered by the terms of the Treaty of Cession shall be treated on par with Indian Nationals, for the purpose of admission to all the courses.

1.23 RESIDENCE CRITERIA

An applicant is considered to be a Puducherry resident if he/she is an Indian National and satisfies at least one of the following criteria:

1. The candidate or whose Parent (either Mother or Father or Both) or Guardian (in case of children who have lost both parents) has been residing continuously in the U.T. of Puducherry for at least five years preceding the date of application.

2. Those who have passed the SSLC / HSC or any other public examination and for that purpose had undergone academic studies continuously **for 5 successive classes immediately preceding the qualifying examination** (including the year of qualifying examination) in a recognized educational institution located in the U.T. of Puducherry and having their residence in the U.T. Puducherry for 5 years continuously during that period. **Mere stay in places such as residential hostel would not amount to residence.**

3. Children of natives of the U.T. of Puducherry who have declared any place in the U.T. of Puducherry as their home town and so certified by their respective Heads of Office. Nativity Certificate in the prescribed format has to be closed. (G.O. Ms. No. 64 dated 25th May 2006).

4. a) Children whose parents are Central/ State Government Servants/ Defence Personnel/ Central Paramilitary Forces/ Employees of Public Sector Undertakings wholly or substantially owned either by the Central Government or by the Puducherry Administration posted and serving in U.T. of Puducherry for at least a minimum continuous period of **three** years immediately prior to the last date of submission of application.

b) Children of the above said employees should have studied HSC of two years in any of the schools in the U.T. of Puducherry and should have passed the qualifying examinations (HSC) from the same school. (G.O. Ms. No. 04, Puducherry dated 09.02.2016 of the Chief Secretariat (Hr. & Tech. Edn.), Puducherry.

5. Children of Defence Personnel who were killed or disabled in action and children of Central Government Servants / U.T. of Puducherry Government Servants / Defence Personnel/ Employees of Public Sector Undertakings wholly or substantially run either by the Central Government or by the Puducherry U.T. Administration who died while in service in the Puducherry U.T.

6. French Nationals residing in the Puducherry U.T. and covered by the terms of the “Treaty of Cession” shall be treated on par with the candidates who produce the prescribed Puducherry U.T. Residence Certificate. Such French Nationals will not be required to produce Residence Certificate; instead, they should produce a “Certificate of Registration” issued for this purpose by the French Consulate at Puducherry. Children of these French Nationals shall not be considered for admission under the Non-Resident quota.

All the above certificates will be scrutinized first by a committee appointed by the Secretary (Revenue), before the final merit list is prepared. Tahsildars of various Taluks and Revenue Officers will be the Members of this Committee.

Note:

1. Candidates seeking admission under the U.T. of Puducherry Resident Quota must furnish the Residence Certificate from the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Puducherry, and renewed from time to time.

2. Children of French Nationals under Clause 6 above, shall not be considered for admission under the Non-Resident Quota.

1.24 U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY - VERTICAL RESERVATION

1. Open Merit - Unreserved (UR)

The seats under OPEN MERIT - UNRESERVED (UR) are open to candidates irrespective of their caste or category status. Further, all SC / ST / BT / EBC / MBC / BCM / OBC candidates are also eligible for selection under the Open Merit category in addition to the reservations made to them.

2. Economically Weaker Section (EWS)

Economically Weaker Section is a subcategory of people belonging to the Economy-based Un-Reserved category having an annual family income less than Rs. 8 Lakhs and who do not belong to any category such as SC/ST/OBC across India.

Candidates claiming admission under this category should enclose the recent EWS certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

Note: Not applicable for ALL courses. Refer Seat Matrix in CENTAC website.

3. Other Backward Classes (OBC), Most Backward Classes (MBC), Extreme Backward Classes (EBC), Backward Classes Muslims (BCM) and Backward Tribes (BT)

Candidates claiming admission under these categories should enclose the recent OBC / MBC / EBC / BCM/ BT certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

4. Backward Tribes (BT)

Candidates claiming admission under these categories should enclose the recent OBC / MBC / EBC / BCM / BT certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

5. Scheduled Castes (SC)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as Scheduled Caste under **“The Constitution (Pondicherry) Scheduled Castes Order 1964”** dated 05.03.1964, read with “The Constitution (Scheduled Caste) orders (Second Amendment) Act 2002 (Central Act 61 of 2002) and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

6. Scheduled Tribes (ST)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as Scheduled Tribe under **“The Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Tribes Order, 2016”** dated 22.12.2016 and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

1.25. U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY - HORIZONTAL RESERVATION

1. Government School 10% Reservation (Govt. 10%)

The 10% Compartmentalised Horizontal Reservation on preferential basis of total intake of seats earmarked for Government Quota to the students, who have studied in Government Schools of Government of Puducherry from 1st standard to 12th standard in Union Territory of Puducherry and have passed in the NEET as qualifying exam, for admission to M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. / B.A.M.S. courses under Government Quota seats in the Government/ Private Self Financing Medical Colleges in the Union Territory of Puducherry from the Academic Year 2023-24 (G.O. Ms. No. 52 Dated 05/09/2023).

2. Freedom Fighter (FF)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should be Children / Grand Children of Freedom Fighters and they should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Officer-in-charge, Freedom Fighters Cell, Government of Puducherry.

3. Wards of Ex-servicemen (ESM)

Those who are registered as Ex-servicemen in the Department of Sainik Welfare (DSW), Government of Puducherry and have got an Ex-servicemen / Widow of Ex-servicemen identity card from the DSW should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Director, DSW, Puducherry.

4. Persons with Disabilities (PwD)

The candidates seeking admission under this category should produce a full size photograph exhibiting the deformity. Candidates with at least 40% impairment irrespective of the type of disability i.e., locomotor, visual or SEVERE dyslexia shall be eligible for the benefits of the PwD category. Leprosy-cured candidates who are otherwise fit to pursue the courses are also included in this category.

For eligibility under the Persons with Disability Quota, locomotor disorder of lower limbs should be between 40% to 80%. For more details, candidates are requested to refer to the BOARD OF GOVERNORS IN SUPERSESSION OF MEDICAL COUNCIL OF INDIA AMENDMENT NOTIFICATION No. MCI-34(41)/2018-Med./170045, dt. 04-02-2019.

Candidates seeking admission to M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.V.Sc.&A.H. (National SS & NRI) courses under this category will be required to undergo a second Medical examination by a Medical Board constituted for the purpose by the Director of Health and Family Welfare Service, Puducherry, to ascertain and confirm the nature and extent of physical disability.

Candidates with any other DISABILITY other than the locomotor disability of the lower limb will not be considered for admission into M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.V.Sc.&A.H. (National SS & NRI) courses under this special category. Such applications will be summarily rejected without any intimation to the candidates.

The certificates must be obtained within **three months** prior to submitting the application for seeking admission under the category. In case the certificate was obtained earlier, the application will be rejected. The medical certificate issued by the District Medical Board of the area concerned for this purpose is subject to the confirmation by the Director of Health and Family Welfare Service.

The decision of the Director of Health and Family Welfare Service, Puducherry, in this regard will be final.

As per regulations framed under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the Dentists Act-1948, admissions to 100% seats in M.B.B.S./B.D.S./B.A.M.S./B.V.Sc.&A.H. will be done based on NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CUM ENTRANCE TEST - NEET with the approval of the Medical Council of India.

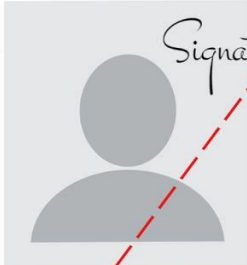
