I am directed to refer to the MD/PG Scheme Guidelines on Central Government Nomination to M.D courses for the Session 2022-23 issued by this Ministry vide letter No.Y-11030/14/2021-EP-III dated 18.10.2022 (copy enclosed). In terms of the said Scheme provisions, the Competent Authority has nominated the below mentioned 04(Four) eligible Govt. A Seniority-wise list of Central Government Nominees to MD (Ayurveda) courses, according to their opted institutions and subjects, are mentioned above. These Nominated candidates may be given admission only after obtaining certificate from them to the effect that they are permanent Government Servants and not on contract basis.

3. The above nominations have been made on the basis of the Deficiency Status available in the records of the Ministry as well as deficiency submitted by State/UTs.

4. All the above 3 institutions are requested to admit nominated Central Government Nominees (CGN) as per provisions of the CGN guidelines, 2022-23 quoted above in this regard. They may also ensure that no nominee/candidate is provided the subject which is available in their respective State/UT. Further, it is to inform you that the vacant seats in Central Pool under the Central Government Nomination Scheme for MD (Ayurveda) for academic session 2022-23 shall be filled by AACCC of Ministry of Ayush as per the provision of the Scheme. Therefore, you are requested to inform the data of vacant seat to AACCC, Ministry of Ayush (aaccc-admn-ayush@gov.in) so that the vacant seat can be filled in time.
