Sub: Uploading the details of students to be admitted in BDS Course at Dental Colleges for the academic session 2020-2021, on DCI Website.

(ii) DCI letter No.DE-BDS(Gen)Admission-Act-2020/5687 dated 27.01.2020

Sir,

I am directed to say that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, vide Order dated 8th February, 2021 in Writ Petition (C) No.54 of 2021 and Writ Petition (C) No.95 of 2021 – Harshit Agarwal & Ors Vs. Union of India & Ors. has directed that the vacant seats in first year BDS course for the year 2020-2021 shall be filled up from the candidates who have participated in the NEET (UG) courses for the year 2020-2021 after lowering the percentile mark by 10 percentile. The candidates belonging to the general category who have secured 40 percentile shall be eligible to be considered for admission in the first year BDS course for the year 2020-2021. Likewise, students belonging to the SC/ST/OBC categories shall be qualified if they have secured 30 percentile. In so far as General candidates with bench mark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, they would be eligible if they have secured 35 percentile. The admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with merit and the admission process shall be completed by 18.02.2021. Any other student who has qualified in NEET (UG) - 2020 even without lowering the minimum marks and is willing to participate in the admission process shall also be considered for admission to BDS course.


2. In this connection, the college authorities of all dental colleges are hereby directed to upload the details of students, admitted in BDS Course at their dental institution for the academic session 2020-2021, on DCI Website, using their already allotted login credentials, on or before the last date of admission i.e. 18th February, 2021 (12.00 midnight), positively. However, if any college faces any technical problem in uploading such details on DCI Website, they may send such details in attached DCI prescribed format, through e-mail / speed post, positively by 18.02.2021, failing which it shall be presumed that the college authorities have not admitted any student in BDS Course at their college for the academic session 2020-21. If the college authorities claim any admission after the cut-off date, the provisions of Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 and Section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948, shall be attracted.
