Sub: Application for Renewal of permission in Under Graduate/Post Graduate - Regarding

Sir,

I am directed to say that as per provision of the Dental Council of India (Establishment of New Dental Colleges. Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity in Dental Colleges) Regulations, 2006, the Institutions whose renewal for UG / PG Course are due, needs to apply for renewal of UG Course six months prior to the expiry of the current academic session and six months before the beginning of the next academic session in case of MDS renewal.

Accordingly, all the dental colleges are hereby directed to apply to DCI under intimation to GOI without any delay, for the purposes, alongwith all the requisite documents and fees etc. so as to enable this Council to process the renewal in time as per DCI Regulation, 2006, failing which, the DCI shall neither inspect any college for renewal of BDS / MDS Courses in case of non-receipt of application from the concerned dental college in this regard nor the DCI will be responsible for such delay and consequences thereof.
