3. The present writ petition has been preferred by an association of institutionally qualified doctors of the Indian System of Medicine with a grievance that the SARTHI Software used by the transport department of respondent no.1 is not recognizing/admitting medical fitness certificates being issued by the practitioners of the Indian System of Medicine (Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha and Sowa-Rigpa).
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said software was

created by respondent no.3, under instructions of respondent no. 2/Union of India, and was being used across the country, even though such certificates are being accepted when an application is being made offline.

5. Mr. Chetan Sharma, learned ASG, who appears on behalf of respondent no. 1, prays for time to obtain instructions regarding this discrepancy, as also whether such a software has been created by respondent no.3 under the instructions of respondent no.2, as contended by the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for respondent no. 2 will also inform respondent no.3 about today's order.

7. Learned counsel for the respondent no. 1 also prays for, and is granted, time to obtain instructions in this regard before the next date.
