- 3. The present writ petition has been preferred by an association of institutionally qualified doctors of the Indian System of Medicine with a grievance that the SARTHI Software used by the transport department of respondent no.1 is not recognizing/admitting medical fitness certificates being issued by the practitioners of the Indian System of Medicine (Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha and Sowa-Rigpa).
- 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said software was

created by respondent no.3, under instructions of respondent no. 2/Union of India, and was being used across the country, even though such certificates are being accepted when an application is being made offline.

- 5. Mr. Chetan Sharma, learned ASG, who appears on behalf of respondent no. 1, prays for time to obtain instructions regarding this discrepancy, as also whether such a software has been created by respondent no.3 under the instructions of respondent no.2, as contended by the petitioner.
- 6. Learned counsel for respondent no. 2 will also inform respondent no.3 about today's order.
- 7. Learned counsel for the respondent no. 1 also prays for, and is granted, time to obtain instructions in this regard before the next date.
