Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to Council's Circular dt. 30.7.2015 & 7.9.2015. In this connection, it is informed that -

- a) Student who has passed from open School education system of the Central Government/State Government institutions be made eligible for admission to D.Pharm B.Pharm and Pharm.D courses as per the concerned Education Regulations.
- b) The students of such open school who have already passed or are undergoing pharmacy courses shall be treated as eligible for registration as a pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act 1948 subject to fulfilment of the other prescribed condition as per Pharmacy Act, 1948.

This is for necessary action.
