Counselling for admission to MDS Courses in all Government/ Government Aided/ Private Unaided Dental Institutes including those under Private Universities - SGT University, Budhera, Gurugram, PDM University Bahadurgarh, Jhajjar in the State of Haryana for the Academic Session 2021-22.

It is for the information of all the general public that the State Government has decided that notification no. 1833-SW(1)-95 dated 28.09.1995 and 1170-SW(1)-95 dated 07.06.1995 shall be applicable for deciding the eligibility of backward classes for the purpose of admissions. Subject :— Exclusion of socially advanced persons/sections (Creamy Layer) from Backward Classes.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to the subject mentioned above and to State that following the supreme Court Judgement in the Indira Sawhney and others versus Union of India case, the Haryana Government vide notification dated 12.10.1993 had set up the Haryana second Backward Classes Commission. The terms of reference of this Commission were to entertain examine and recommend upon requests for inclusion and complaints of over-inclusion and under-inclusion in the list of Backward Classes. Vide notification dated 26.5.1994, the Commission was also assigned the function of specifying the basis applying the relevant the requisite socio-economic criteria to exclude socially advanced persons/sections (Creamy Layer) from Backward Classes.

In its report submitted on 16.5.1995, the Haryana Second Backward Classes Commission has recommended the criteria for excluding socially advanced persons/sections (Creamy Layer) from Backward Classes. After considering these recommenddation, the Government has decided that the benefit of reservation shall not apply to persons/sections mentianed in Annexure 'A' which is enclosed.

All the departments are requested to bring the above instructions to the notice of all the Head of Departments and appointing authorities under their control for necessary compliance.

Subject : — **Clarification regarding issuance of the Backward Class Certificate.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government letter No. 22/36/2000-3GSIII, dated 9.8.2000 on the subject noted above wherein it was clarified that the income from salary will not be taken into account for the purpose of income/wealth test in respect of service category and while calculating income or wealth test of the Government employee of Backward Classes and to say that the matter had been under consideration of the State Government, whether to determine the creamy layer status of a BC candidate, the income of the applicant or income of his/her parent will be taken into account. Now, in consultation with the Government of India, it has been decided by the Government of Haryana that creamy layer status of a BC candidate is to be determined with reference to the income/status of the parents of the candidate and not his/her own income/status. The above decision may be kept in view while issuing BC certificate.

2. All the departments are requested to bring the above instructions to the notice of all concerned under their control for strict compliance.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revision of income criteria to exclude socially advanced persons/sections (Creamy Layer) from the purview of reservation for Other Backward Classes (OBCs)-reg.

The undersigned is directed to invite attention to this Department's office memorandum No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 8th September, 1993 which, *inter-alia*, provided that sons and daughters of persons having gross annual income of Rs. 1 lakh or above for a period of three consecutive years would fall within the creamy layer and would not be entitled to get the benefit of reservation available to the Other Backward Classes. The aforesaid limit of income for determining the creamy layer status was subsequently raised to Rs. 2.5 lakh and Rs. 4.5 lakh and accordingly the expression "Rs. 1 lakh" under Category-VI of Schedule to OM dated 8th September, 1993 was revised to "Rs. 2.5 lakh" and to "Rs. 4.5 lakh" vide this Department's OMs No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res.) dated 09.03.2004 and dated 14.10.2008 respectively.

2. It has now been decided to raise the income limit from Rs. 4.5 lakh to Rs. 6 lakh per annum for determining the creamy layer amongst the Other Backward Classes. Accordingly, the expression "**Rs. 4.5 lakh**" under Category VI in the Schedule to this Department's aforesaid O.M. of 8th September, 1993 would be substituted by Rs. "**Rs. 6 lakh**".
3. The provisions of this office memorandum have effect from 16th May, 2013.

Attention is invited to O.M.No.36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 8th September, 1993 of DoPT which, *inter-alia*, provided that sons and daughters of persons having gross annual income of Rs.1 lakh or above for a period of three consecutive years would fall within the creamy layer and would not be entitled to get the benefit of reservation available to the Other Backward Classes. The aforesaid limit of income for determining the creamy layer status was subsequently raised to Rs.2.5 lakh and Rs.4.5 lakh and accordingly the expression "Rs 1 lakh" under Category-VI of Schedule to OM dated 8th September, 1993 was revised to "Rs.2.5 lakh" and to "Rs.4.5 lakh" vide DoPT's O.M. No.36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res.) dated 09.03.2004 and dated 14.10.2008 respectively. Vide O.M.No. 1-1/2008-U1A dt. 13/10/2008 of Ministry of Human Resource Development, the Central Government specified that as per the above-mentioned DoPT O.M dated 14.10.2008, the income limit for determining the "creamy layer" among OBCs shall be Rs 4 5 lakhs for reservation in admissions to Central Educational Institutions.

2. The DoPT, vide OM No. 36033/1/2013-Estt (Res) dt. 27th May, 2013 has now notified that the limit of income for determining 'creamy layer' status amongst the OBCs is raised from Rs. 4.5 lakhs to Rs 6 lakhs per annum with effect from 16th May, 2013 and that the expression "Rs 4 5 lakh" under Category VI in the Schedule to OM No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) of 8th September, 1993 of Ministry of Personnel

Public Grievances and Pensions (Department of Personnel and Training) is substituted by "Rs. 6 lakh".

3. Accordingly, with the approval of the competent authority, the revised expression of "Rs. 6 lakh" under Category VI in the Schedule to the OM dt. 8/9/1993 of DoPT shall be the limit of income, with effect from 16th May, 2013, for determining 'creamy layer' status amongst the OBCs for reservation in admissions to Central Educational Institutions.

4. The provisions of this OM are in supersession of this Department's OM No. 1-1/2008-U1(A) dt. 13/10/2008.
