- ❖ No Processing Fee, security deposit and Tuition Fee for 7.5% Spl. Reservation for Tamil Nadu Govt. School Students

- ❖ Vacancy Position for the Course will be available on the official websites.
- ❖ Selection committee does not take responsibility for any Connectivity error.
- ❖ Once the candidate locks his/her choice during the online counselling, it cannot be changed later.
- ❖ Request for change of College, from one to another is not permitted after an option has been exercised.
- ❖ Registered and choice locked candidates in Mop- Up round are only eligible to participate in Stray vacancy round. The Choices exercised by the candidates during Mop-Up round will be considered as their choices for Mop- Up as well as Stray Vacancy round. Hence candidates who wish to participate in stray vacancy round are advised to register and lock their choices in mop-up round.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR MOP-UP:

- ❖ As per the prospectus clause 14 IV-(b), a candidate not holding any MBBS/BDS seats under All India Quota and State Quota will be allowed to participate in State Quota Mop-up counselling.

NOT ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR MOP-UP:

- ❖ As per DGHS notification Ref. U- 12021/ 01/ 2022 -MEC dated 12.07.2022, a candidate joined under All India Quota or State Quota in the previous rounds will not be allowed to State Quota Mop-up counselling.
- ❖ As per the prospectus clause 14 III- (g), if the candidate discontinues / Not-joined the course after completion of Round-II of online counselling will not be eligible to attend the Mop-up round of online counselling.
- ❖ As per the prospectus clause 14 II- (b), a candidate who has not registered in the first round of online counseling will not be permitted to attend the MOP-UP online counselling.
- ❖ Candidates whose names are in the allotted list provided by MCC at the end of Mop-up Round.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOWNLOADING ALLOTMENT ORDER:

- ❖ The allotted candidates should download their provisional allotment order and join the course in the concerned Medical College/Institution on or before the stipulated date and time as mentioned in the Provisional Allotment Order.
