
Subject: Alert against fake letter issued to Medical College/Institution.

By issuing these Regulations,the EMRB,NMC, and the State Medical Councils are in no way precluded from considering and dealing with any form of professional misconduct by registered medical practitioners which do not fall under any of gther categories mentioned in the regulations or guidelines or codes appended RMPs bound by these Regulations will not engage in any activities which violate these regulations and should not enter any employment or other contract that engages in activities in violation of any of these regulations. Conviction of RMP in cases of a cognizable offence involving moral turpitude may result in the suspension of license to practice from 3 months to permanently.

Also, it has been brought to our attention that many ghost faculties are actively assisting the institution to make fake finger prints for Adhaar enabled biometric attendance system, which makes a person accomplice to the crime.
