It is advised to check the website of NMC to verify the genuineness of notices, circulars and letters. In case of any doubt same be please be clarified from UGMEB of NMC.
4. All concerned are alerted to reply upon genuine letters, circulars, and notices available on NMC website only. National Medical Commission shall initiate action under the relevant law against such fake messages in social media.

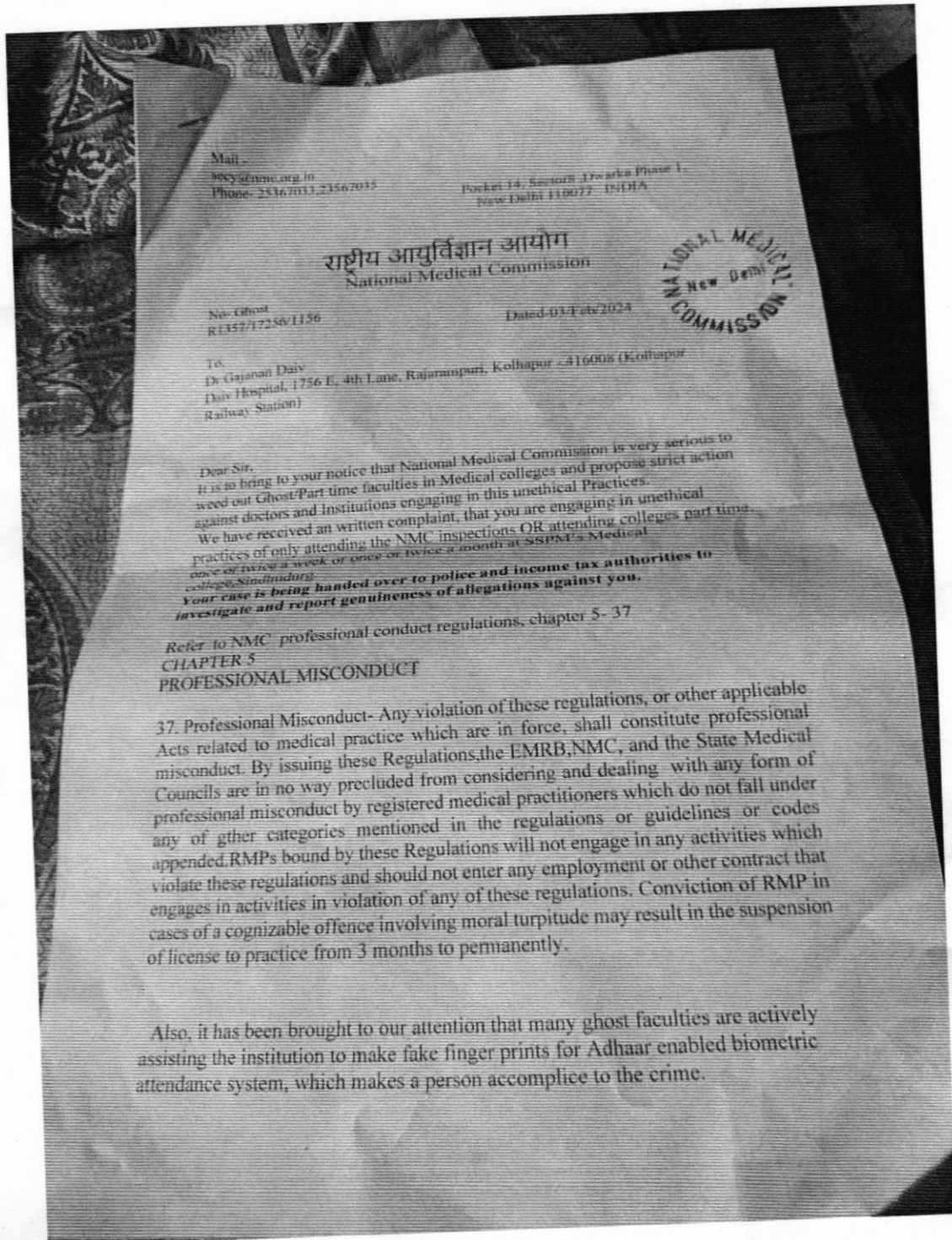
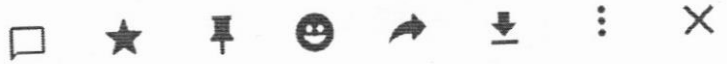

THE AADHAAR (TARGETED DELIVERY OF FINANCIAL AND OTHER SUBSIDIES, BENEFITS AND SERVICES) ACT, 2016

4. Properties of Aadhaar number.
34. Penalty for impersonation — Whoever impersonates or attempts to impersonate another person, whether dead or alive, real or imaginary, by providing any false demographic information or biometric information, shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years or with a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both.

42. General penalty — Whoever commits an offence under this Act or any rules or regulations made thereunder for which no specific penalty is provided elsewhere than this section, shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 4 [four year] or with a fine which may extend to twenty-five thousand rupees or, in the case of a company, with a fine which may extend to one lakh rupees, or with both.

This is last time warning to you to dissociated from medical colleges, if you are ghost, irregular /part time faculty and with active cooperation in creating fake fingerprints for AEBAS. Continuing being fake/ghost/Part time faculty will invite penalty as per NMC professional conduct rules causing suspension of registration and Jail term (Upto 4 years) under UIDAI act, as an accomplice to impersonation.

Your name has been forwarded to concerned authorities to take action, if you appear for any NMC inspections at ANY MEDICAL COLLEGES IN FUTURE for further action as outlined above.
