## PROVISIONAL INFORMATION BROCHURE FOR 1<sup>st</sup> AND 2<sup>nd</sup> ROUND OF ONLINE SEAT ALLOCATION (INSTITUTE AND SUBJECT/SPECIALITY)/ PROCESS FOR [MD/MS/DM(6YEARS)/MCH(6YEARS)/MDS] JANUARY 2025 SESSION

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Eligibility criteria as per INI-CET Prospectus Part-A & Part-B including any notices published has been applied considering the information provided by the candidates in online registration form.

All the candidates who have been listed in the **Result Notification No.155/2024 dated 16.11.2024** will be eligible to participate in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of the Online Seat Allocation <u>except rank of</u> <u>OBC/EWS candidates lower than the cut off rank of UR who failed to produce valid category</u> <u>certificate</u>. This shall be subjected to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria as mentioned in the prospectus/notices published on website <u>www.aiimsexams.ac.in</u>.

## PROCEDURE:

- The eligible candidates will have to Register themselves on PG Online Seat Allocation portal [PAAS/PG MedDen January 2025 of INI-CET]. The link for the portal will be activated only for eligible candidates in the MyPage. Candidate can login in using the credential that have been used for filling application form and completing other processes related to INI-CET PG Entrance Examination for January 2025 session.
- 2. The PG Online Seat Allocation portal will allow candidates to make choices of seats (a combination of **Institute** and subject/speciality) as per his/her eligibility. The candidate can arrange the choices in desired order preference. There is no limitation on number of choices (Institute & Subject/Speciality) that can be made by the candidates. The choices can be edited and reordered within the date and time specified in the **Important Dates link** in the Portal.
- 3. Kindly note that the choices cannot be edited and reordered after closing date of exercising of Choice of 1<sup>st</sup> Round of seat allocation. The allocation of 2<sup>nd</sup> Round will be done as per choices made by the candidates during exercising of Choice of 1<sup>st</sup> Round of seat allocation.
- 4. The Portal will remain open on dates specified in the Important Dates link in the Portal. The choices made by the candidate will be locked either by the candidate OR will be automatically locked on the last Date and Time as specified in the Important Dates link in the Portal.
- 5. A Mock Seat Allocation will be done prior to 1st Round of Seat Allocation (not a final allocation). The mock seat allocation represents the likely seat, that a candidate may be allocated as per choices made by the candidate. The result of mock round seat allocation will be announced as per date specified in the Important Dates link. The candidate can register/edit/reorder their choices before the closing dates of choices for the 1st Round as per Important Dates link in the Portal.

- 6. Those who will not login during exercising of choices (Institute and subject/speciality) for First Round their order of choice will be considered as per choices made during Mock Round.
- 7. INSTITUTE PREFERENCE:
  - a) AIIMS New Delhi & other AIIMS- The allocation of Institute preferences will be done as per Roster Point Allocation for Counselling (Dynamic) which will be announced separately.
  - **b)** JIPMER, Puducherry: Allocation of Institute preference for JIPMER Puducherry candidates, seats shall be done as per Roster Point (Dynamic)
  - c) NIMHANS, Bengaluru: No seat available for Institute Preference.
  - d) PGIMER, Chandigarh: No seat available for Institute Preference.
  - e) SCTIMST, Trivandrum: No seat available for Institute Preference.
- 8. The mock seat allocation and seat allocation for 1st Round shall be done as per schedule specified in the Important Dates link.
- 9. All the candidates who have been allocated seats in the 1st Round are required to login to the PG Online Seat Allocation portal and actively choose one of the following options within date and time specified in the Important Dates link:
  - **Option 1. ACCEPT** allotted seat and **DO NOT WISH TO PARTICIPATE** in further rounds of Seat Allocation.
  - Option 2. ACCEPT allotted seat and WANT TO PARTICIPATE in 2<sup>nd</sup> ROUND of Seat Allocation
    - [if You choose option-2 and participate in 2<sup>nd</sup> round and you are allocated another seat as per your choice in 2<sup>nd</sup> round, then you will have to join the seat allocated during 2<sup>nd</sup> round. The seat allocated in first round shall be considered vacated and the same shall be automatically allocated to other candidates in order of merit.

Failure to join seat allotted in  $1^{st}$  round or upgraded seat shall lead to impositions of penalty of Rs. 3.00 Lakh.

Options to **REFUSE** the allocated seat is **NOT available**. Therefore, the candidates are requested to fill the choices carefully and responsibly. Candidate himself/herself shall be responsible for their choices.

**Failure to login** and **selecting an option** after seat allocation within date and time specified in the **Important Dates link** will lead to forfeiture of the allocated seat and <u>render the candidate</u> <u>ineligible for further rounds</u> except open round of Seat Allocation (if any).

- 10. All the candidates who are allocated seats are mandatorily required (irrespective of whether they choose in Option 1 and 2 as mentioned in point no. 9) to report in-person (for reporting and/or joining), to allocated Institute within the date and times specified in the Important Dates link. The candidates are required to submit original certificates OR deposit Rs. 3.00 Lakh as specified in result notification of the seat allocation of the 1<sup>st</sup> Round at the time of reporting.
- 11. Candidates availing constitutional reservation must show valid proof of their claim for reserved seat at the reporting INIs when they are depositing original certificates. In case they do not possess a valid certificate then their claim for the allocated reserved seat will be nullified, and they will be eligible to appear in the further round as UR candidate subject to cut off in UR merit list.

The OBC/EWS certificate must be **valid for admission in Central Govt. Institution**. The validity of OBC/EWS certified shall be as follows: -

- a. The OBC(-NCL) certificates issued in the respective financial year i.e. issued from 01.04.2024 to 10.11.2024 (on or before date of Exam) both dates inclusive, will be considered valid.
- b. The EWS certificate must be valid for financial year 2024-2025 and issued between 01.04.2024 to 10.11.2024 (on or before date of Exam), both dates inclusive based on income of year 2023-2024
- 12. Candidates availing PWBD horizontal reservation must show valid proof of their claim for allocated reserved seat at the reporting INIs when they are depositing original certificates. Confirmation of admission shall be subject to verification of Disability by Medical Board of AIIMS, New Delhi as per schedule mentioned in the result of respective round of seat allocation. In case they do not possess a valid certificate then their claim for the reserved seat allocated will be nullified, and they will be eligible to appear further in their respective category (UR/OBC/SC/ ST/EWS) candidate as applicable without PWBD reservation subject to cut off in respective category.
- 13. The allocation of the PWBD candidates will be done as per Roster Point Allocation for counselling (Dynamic) of final seat position as published for admission to PG courses of respective INIs as applicable for January 2025 session.
- 14. FOREIGN NATIONAL CANDIDATES:

The seat allocation will be done in order of merit and according to choices made by the candidates as described in point no 2.

- a) The candidates will be eligible to exercise of choice only as per Subject/ Institute those are filled in the online registration form.
- b) All allocation of Foreign National candidates will be done on the basis of as per Subject/Institute filled in the online registration for January 2025 session.
- c) Only one best Subject/Speciality and Institute available at that rank will be allocated during online seat allocation.
- d) The process of admission will be done as per procedure available for other candidates.
- 15. SPONSORED CANDIDATES:
  - i. The seat allocation will be done in order of merit and according to choices made by the candidates as described in point no 2.
  - ii. In case any discrepancy found in online data with Sponsorship certificate valid information as in Sponsorship certificate will be accepted as per eligibility criteria.
  - iii. The candidates are eligible to exercise of choice only as per Subject/ Institute those are available in the Sponsorship Certificate.
  - iv. In case, the NOC has been received in place of Sponsorship certificate, the seat allocation will be done as per subject/Institute available in the online registration.
  - v. If the subject is not mentioned against the candidate name in the Sponsorship certificate, no allocation will be done for that institute.
  - vi. If the subject is not mentioned against the candidate name in the Sponsorship certificate, but subject is available in the online registration, the candidate can make exercising of choices as per subject available in the online registration.
  - vii. All allocation of Sponsored candidates will be done on the basis of Subject/Institute available in the Sponsorship Certificate/online registration for January 2025 session.
  - viii. Only one best Subject/Speciality and Institute available at that rank will be allocated during online seat allocation.
  - ix. The process of admission will be done as per procedure available for other candidates.

Note: -

- Those who have not been allocated any seat in the first round of seat allocation, the allocation will be done in the second round of seat allocation as per their choice filled during exercising of choice of 1<sup>st</sup> Round in order of merit.
- The seat allocation of the subject available in Sponsored Category for PGIMER will be done by PGIMER Chandigarh separately.
- 16. Upper Age Limit
  - a) **NIMHANS, Bengaluru (As on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025):** The age validation for Courses of NIMHANS under INI-CET for January 2025 session:

For MD Psychiatry Course:

- General/Unreserved Category'- 32 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.01.1993 are eligible)
- 'OBC Category'- 35 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.01.1990 are eligible)
- 'SC/ST/PWBD Category'-37 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.01.1988 are eligible)
- **'Sponsored Category'** 45 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.01.1980 are eligible)

DM (Neurology), M.Ch. Neurosurgery (Post MBBS category) Course & MD Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation -

- 32 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.01.1993 are eligible)
- **b) SCTIMST Trivandrum (As on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025):** The age validation for Courses of SCTIMST under INI-CET for January 2025 session:
- General/Unreserved/ EWS/Foreign National category- 40 Years (candidates Born on or after 01.01.1985 are eligible)
- SC/ST/ Ex-service personnel 45 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.01.1980 are eligible)
- **OBC 43 Years** (Candidates Born on or after 01.01.1982 are eligible)
- **Sponsored– 50 Years** (Candidates Born on or after 01.01.1975 are eligible)
- 17. All disputes pertaining to the conduct of the INI-CET by AIIMS, New Delhi and Online Seat Allocation / Counselling will be subject to the jurisdiction of High Court of Delhi only.
- 18. The 2nd round will be initiated after completion of 1st round.
