INFORMATION BROCHURE FOR 2nd ROUND OF SEAT ALLOCATION (INSTITUTE AND SUBJECT/SPECIALITY)/ PROCESS FOR [MD/MS/DM(6YEARS)/MCH(6YEARS)/MDS] JULY 2022 SESSION

Please note: - that the procedure of seat allocation for **July 2022** session is different from procedure followed in past.

IMPORTANT

Candidates who have been allocated any Institute in 1st round, opted option-2 and completed all formalities till 20.08.2022(upto 05.00 pm), or who had participated in 01st round of seat allocation but didn't allot any institute of his/her choices is eligible for 2nd round of seat allocation.

Eligibility criteria as per INI-CET Prospectus Part-A & Part-B including any notices published shall be applied based on the information provided by the candidates in online registration form.

ELIGIBILITY

ELIGIBILE

The following candidates will be considered in 2nd Round of online seat allocation:

- 1. The candidates who have opted Option-2 (ACCEPT allotted seat and WANT TO PARTICIPATE in 2nd ROUND of Seat Allocation) in 1st Round of online Seat allocation and completed the due procedure of reporting as applicable in 1st Round.
- 2. All the candidates who were eligible to participate but were not allocated seat in 1st round of online seat allocation as per their filled choices.

Note: - The seat allocation for 2nd round will be done on the choices filled during 01st round of counseling if seat available.

NOT ELIGIBLE

- 1. All those candidates who did not participate in 1stRound.
- 2. All those candidates who were allotted seat in the 1st Round but **did not** choose any option online by 20th August, 2022 by 5:00 pm.
- 3. All those candidates who were allotted seats in Round 1 and have chosen Option 1 and completed necessary formalities towards joining the respective institutions by 20th August, 2022 by 5:00 pm.
- 4. All those candidates who were allotted seats and chose option 1 or 2 but did not complete necessary formalities by **20**th **August, 2022 by 5:00 pm**

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Candidates not allowed to add/delete/alter the seat filled during 1st round of exercise of choices. The allocation will be done as per choices filled in 01st round of counseling if seat available.
- 2. Candidates who opted for Option 2 in the 1st round of seat allotment and no better choice (institution and subject/specialty) is available during the 2nd Round of seat allocation, then the seat (institution and subject/specialty) allotted in the 1st Round will be retained in the second round of seat allocation.
- 3. All the candidates who shall be allocated seats in the 2nd Round are required to login to the PG online seat allocation portal and actively choose the following option within date and time specified in the Important Dates link:

OPTION A: ACCEPT allotted seat

[Candidates choosing Option-A must have to join the seat allotted by upgradation/allotment in this round. Candidates who have met upgradation cannot retain earlier allotted seat (if any). Failure to join the seat shall lead to impositions of penalty of Rs. 3.00 Lakh]

(Those who shall be allotted a seat in the 2nd Round of seat allotment but DO NOT actively choose "OPTION A" to Accept the offer and complete necessary formalities by **5.00 PM on 31.08.2022 (Wednesday)** shall be deemed to have not interested for join the allocated seat/Institute and allocated seat will be forfeited. The seat shall be declared as vacant for next round if any).

Those who have been allotted a seat in 1st round and participated in 2nd Round and no upgradation meet are also required to choose actively Option "A" by **5.00 PM on 31.08.2022 (Wednesday)** & complete the necessary formalities by **5.00 PM on 31.08.2022 (Wednesday)**

Those who chose Option A: Accept allotted seat are required to report to Allotted Institute by 5.00 PM on 31.08.2022 (Wednesday) (Failure to do so will lead to forfeiture of the allotted seat).

- Failure to login and selecting an option within date and time specified in the Important Dates link will also lead to forfeiture of the allotted seat)
- 4. All the candidates who are allocated seats are mandatorily required to report in-person (for reporting and/or joining) to allocated Institute within the date and times specified in the Important Dates link. The candidates are required to deposit original certificates alongwith one set of photocopies of all certificate OR photo copies of certificates with a Demand Draft (DD) of Rs. 3 Lakhs only (Rupees Three Lakhs only) in the name of the "Director AlIMS, New Delhi" payable at SBI Ansari Nagar, New Delhi at allotted INIs. Candidates are required to report & join by date as required by the respective INIs. In case of Demand Draft, original documents must be deposited within 5 days of reporting.
- 5. Candidates availing constitutional reservation must show valid proof of their claim for reserved seat at the reporting INIs when they are depositing original certificates. In case they do not possess a valid certificate then their claim for the allocated reserved seat will be nullified, and they will be eligible to appear in the further round as UR candidate subject to cut off in UR merit list. The OBC/EWS certificate must be valid for admission in Central Govt. Institution. The validity of OBC/EWS certified shall be as follows:
 - a) Issuing date of OBC (NCL) Certificate should be within 21.03.2021 to 08.05.2022 (both dates inclusive).
 - b) EWS certificate must be valid for financial year 2022-2023 and issued on or after 01.04.2022 to 08.05.2022 based on income of year 2021-2022.
- 6. Candidates availing PWBD horizontal reservation must show valid proof of their claim for allocated reserved seat at the reporting INIs when they are depositing original certificates. Confirmation of admission shall be subjected to verification of Disability by Medical Board of AIIMS, New Delhi for all candidates (more details will be provided in result of respective round of seat allocation). In case they do not possess a valid certificate then their claim for the reserved seat allocated will be nullified, and they will be eligible to appear further in their respective category (UR/OBC/SC/ST/EWS) candidate as applicable without PWBD reservation subject to cut off in respective category.
- 7. The allocation of the PWBD candidates will be done as per Guidelines available with the Notice No.113/2022 dated 28.07.2022 regarding Final seat

position of PwBD candidates for admission to PG courses of INIs for July 2022 session.

8. FOREIGN NATIONAL CANDIDATES:

- a) The seat allocation will be done in order of merit and according to choices made by the candidates as described in point no 2.
- b) The Exercise of choice only as per Subject/ Institute those are filled in the online registration form will be final and not alteration is allowed.
- c) All allocation of Foreign National/OCI candidates will be done on the basis of as per Subject/Institute filled in the online registration for July 2022 session.
- d) Only one best Subject/Speciality and Institute available at that rank will be allocated during online seat allocation.
- e) The process of admission will be done as per procedure available for other candidates.

9. SPONSORED CANDIDATES:

- i. The seat allocation will be done in order of merit and according to choices made by the candidates as described in point no 2.
- ii. In case any discrepancy found in online data with Sponsorship certificate valid information as in Sponsorship certificate will be accepted as per eligibility criteria.
- iii. The candidates need not to exercise of choice for this round, it will be allocated as per the choices filled during first round, only as per Subject/Institute those are available in the Sponsorship Certificate.
- iv. In case, the NOC has been received in place of Sponsorship certificate, the seat allocation will be done as per subject/Institute available in the online registration.
- v. If the subject is not mentioned against the candidate name in the Sponsorship certificate, no allocation will be done for that institute.

- vi. All allocation of Sponsored candidates will be done on the basis of Subject/Institute available in the Sponsorship Certificate/online registration for July 2022 session.
- vii. Only one best Subject/Speciality and Institute available at that rank will be allocated during online seat allocation.
- viii. The process of admission will be done as per procedure available for other candidates.

Note: -

- Those who have not been allocated any seat in the first round of seat allocation, the allocation will be done in the second round of seat allocation as per their choice in order of merit, if they follow the guidelines given in the Information brochure of 2nd Round of Seat Allocation
- The counselling of the subject available in Sponsored Category for PGIMER is being conducted by PGIMER Chandigarh separately

10. Upper Age Limit

a) **NIMHANS, Bengaluru (As on 1st July 2022):** The age validation for Courses of NIMHANS under INI-CET for July 2022 session:

For MD Psychiatry Course:

- **General/Unreserved Category**'- 32 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.07.1990 are eligible)
- 'OBC Category'- 35 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.07.1987 are eligible)
- 'SC/ST Category'-37 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.07.1985 are eligible)
- 'Sponsored Category'- 45 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.07.1977 are eligible)

M.Ch Neurosurgery (Post MBBS) Course -

- 32 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.07.1990 are eligible)
- b) SCTIMST Trivandrum (As on 1st July 2022): The age validation for Courses of SCTIMST under INI-CET for July 2022 session:
- General/Unreserved/OBC/EWS/Sponsored/Foreign National category-40 Years (candidates Born on or after 01.07.1982 are eligible)
- SC/ST 45 Years (Candidates Born on or after 01.07.1977 are eligible)
- 11. The schedule of Open Round of online Seat Allocation is available in the Important Dates link.
