### 1. Introduction

## 2. Aims & Objective

In the field of postgraduate and post-doctoral education, the most important function of an Institute of National Importance is to provide opportunities to train teachers for medical colleges in the country in an atmosphere of research and development. Postgraduate and Post-Doctoral students are exposed to newer methods of teaching and given opportunities to actively participate in teaching exercises. The other important objectives of the Institute of National Importance are to bring together in one place, the educational facilities of the highest order for the training of personnel in all the important branches of health activity and to attain self-sufficiency in postgraduate medical education. The educational principles and practices being adopted are best suited to the needs of the nation.

The objective of INI-SS is to conduct a common entrance test for preparation of merit list as per scheme of evaluation/admission applicable at different INIs for admission in super specialty courses at participating Institutes of National Importance and allocation of single seat to each candidate based on his/her overall merit based on synchronized allocation of seats.

## 3. Administration

- 3.1. AIIMS, New Delhi is the authority for deciding of all aspects related to Combined Entrance Test such as application, conduct of exam, declaration of results. Seat Allocation is done by AIIMS New Delhi as per policy, rules & regulations of respective INI's.
- 3.2. Seat allocation & Admission into any of the participating INI will be governed by the rules and regulation of respective Institute as applicable and will be administered by the Head of Institutions of respective INIs (the details are mentioned in Part B of the Prospectus of INI-SS, January 2024).
- 3.3. - 4.3.2. The candidates must have completed the requisite qualification, degree and tenure by 31.01.2024. The candidates who are likely to complete their 3 years requisite qualification, degree and tenure after 31.01.2024 will not be eligible to appear in this examination.
- 4.3.3. The courses will start from dates as mentioned in *important dates at a glance*.
- 4.3.4. Last date for admission to the DM/M.Ch. & MD (Hospital Administration) course will be as per dates mentioned in important dates at a glance. In any circumstances, last date for admission will not be extended after dates as mentioned above. This includes candidates on the wait list who may be offered a seat if the selected candidates does not join.

### 5.2. Eligibility

- (1) The candidate must possess MBBS or an equivalent degree (As per NMC)
- (2) Must possess minimum experience of three years in a Govt. Hospital in the relevant field or five years in general practice. A certificate issued by the District Magistrate in support of the general practice claimed should be uploaded.
- (3) Candidates belonging to UR/OBC/EWS/Sponsored must have obtained 55% in aggregate in all MBBS Professional Examinations. Candidates belonging to SC/ST must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate in all MBBS professional.
- (4) Must be registered with Central /State Medical Registration Council.
- (5) The candidates who have already done MD/MS or equivalent are not eligible for this course.

**Graduated from Foreign Universities:** Indian National candidates who have been graduated from foreign Universities must fill their NMC screening exam marks in percentage in the online form. Candidate must have obtained marks as mentioned above in FMGE exam conducted by NBE any other authority of Govt. of India, Delhi.

### 5.3. Other Terms & Conditions

The candidates must have completed the requisite qualification, degree and experience by 31.01.2024. The candidates who are likely to complete their requisite qualification, degree and experience after 31.01.2024 will not be eligible to appear in this examination.

Under MD (Hospital Administration) seat that remains unfilled in reserved category will be converted in open round (if any) as per following:

1. EWS seats to UR
2. OBC seats to UR
3. ST seats to SC and if still unfilled, to UR
4. SC seats to ST and if still unfilled, to UR

### 6.2. Stage – II: Applicable to all AIIMS only

**Total Marks: 20**

- Candidate must secure 50 percent (%) or more marks in Stage-I[as per the decision of the meeting of the 116th Academic Committee (item No.AC/116/10 dated 06.03.2018)].
- Candidate must have applied in online registration for AIIMS seats in respective specialty/course.
- Candidate must be eligible as per eligibility criteria of AIIMS.
- Out of the candidates who fulfil above criteria, candidates- 3(three) times the number of seats advertised for AIIMS OR2(two) times the total number of seats in AIIMS & other INIs whichever is higher or as decided by the competent authority at the time of declaration of result will be called for departmental clinical/practical/lab-based assessment (carrying 20 marks) related to sub-specialty/systems/component of the specialty/course for which the candidate has applied in respective department at AIIMS, New Delhi.
- To qualify for AIIMS Seat allocation a candidate must obtain 50 percent (%) or more marks in Stage-I & Stage-II combined.
- In case a candidate gets marks more than 50 percent (%) in Stage-I but less than 50 percent (%) marks in Stage I & II combined, he/she will not be treated as qualified for AIIMS Seats.
- Candidates called for departmental assessment (Stage – II) and remain absent in Stage – II, he/she will not be treated as qualified for AIIMS Seats.

### 6.3. Preparation of Merit Lists

Two list of qualified candidates in order of merit will be declared based on performance in Stage – I & Stage – II examination (as applicable) as described below: -

#### 6.3.1. Common Merit List (CML)

- Candidate must have appeared in the test for Stage – I.
- All qualified candidate in Stage – I examination as per scheme of examination will be assigned a rank and will be placed in the list in order of overall rank.
- This merit list (CML) will be used for allocation of seats in all INI except AIIMS as per method of allocation described in prospectus.

#### 6.3.2. AIIMS Merit List (AML)

- This Merit List (AML) will be used for allocation of Seats in all AIIMS only
- Candidate must have appeared & qualified in both examinations Stage – I & Stage – II as per scheme of examination described above.
- The list will be based on marks obtained in Stage- I & Stage – II combined (100 marks) for qualified candidates only.
- All qualified candidates will be assigned a rank and will be placed in the list in order of overall rank.

### 6.4. Sponsored/Foreign National category candidates

They will be placed in respective merit list as per their performance and eligibility, as applicable to all other general candidates as described above with respective category tag mentioned against their rank. Such candidates will be considered for Seats under Sponsored/Foreign National category in order of merit. The seat advertised under Sponsored/Foreign National is strictly non-convertible/Interchangeable from the seat advertised under General Category or vice-versa.

#### Overseas Citizen of India (OCI):

As per the decision dated February 03, 2023 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) 891 / 2021, the OCI candidates shall be considered as Indian nationals.

Overseas Citizen of India candidates will be eligible ONLY for open category (Unreserved) seats for Indian Nationals, not for any Foreign National Seats.

The OCI candidates shall be considered for seat allocation under the Unreserved and Unreserved-PWBD categories, as applicable, at the time of seat allocation.

OCI candidates are not required to obtain NOC, however must upload the scan copy of OCI card on or before date(s) mentioned in Important Dates Section of Prospectus Part-A.

### 6.5. Method of Resolving Ties

According to age (Date of birth), the older candidate shall get preference over the younger one.

## 7. Other Instructions

### 7.1. General

- Any candidate applying for any course will be deemed to have read the information brochure/prospectus, notices published in website.
- In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions/ terms/ rules/criteria regarding the determination of eligibility/conduct of examinations/ registration of candidates/ information contained herein, the matter will be decided at the discretion of the Director, AIIMS, New Delhi and same shall be final and binding in nature.



- c. Any wrong information provided by the candidate on same may invite disciplinary action including debarment from future examination.
- d. AIIMS, New Delhi reserves its right to alter, amend, modify or apply any or some of the instructions/ guidelines contained in this information brochure.
- e. Candidature is liable to be cancelled in case of any discrepancy detected at any stage regarding eligibility even after grant of admission

### 7.2. Sponsored Candidate

- a. It is mandatory to upload valid Sponsored certificate in the Completion of Application **on or before date(s) mentioned in Important Dates Section of Prospectus Part-A.** Please note that candidates must have to submit original sponsored certificate at the time of reporting/joining for the allocated postgraduate seat, failing which, their candidature will be cancelled.
- b. All columns available in sponsorship certificate should be duly filled. If any columns not pertain to candidate should be mandatory strike out (X).
- c. For Detail see the Performa for Sponsorship certificate as applicable for different Institutes.
- d. **In case it is found that an applicant who does not full fill the eligibility qualification / criteria has provided false information then applicant's candidature will be cancelled**

### 7.3. Foreign National/ OCI/PIO

- i. Candidates who are NOT citizens of India (by birth or naturalized) (but not OCI/PIO candidates) shall be considered as FOREIGN NATIONALS.
- ii. Foreign nationals are required to fill in the prescribed online application form indicating the choice of subject (only one subject) for admission to Postgraduate courses leading to award of DM/M.Ch. & MD (Hospital Administration) Entrance Examination.
- iii. The foreign nationals are required to send their Registration Slip of Online application through Diplomatic Channel. They are also required to appear in the Competitive Entrance Examination along with other candidates. The No Objection Certificate (NOC) obtained from Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, should be submitted to the Examination Section **on or before date(s) mentioned in Important Dates Section of Prospectus Part-A. Kindly note that no objection certificate obtained solely from Ministry of External Affairs is not considered as valid NOC for INI-SS.**
- iv. **Overseas Citizen of India (OCI)/PIO:**  
Eligibility of OCI/PIO candidates will be based on the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) 891 / 2021 dated February 03,2023.
  1. Candidates born before 04.03.2021 and who have secured the OCI Card Before 04.03.2021 Shall be considered INDIAN NATIONALS and will be eligible ONLY for open category (unreserved)seats for INDIAN NATIONALS. They will not be eligible for consideration for seats for Foreign Nationals.
  2. OCI/PIO card holders who are not to be considered as India Nationals based on the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) 891 / 2021 dated February 03.2023 shall be considered as FOREIGN NATIONALS. They will not be eligible for consideration of seats for Indian Nationals.

OCI candidates are not required to obtain NOC, however must upload the scan copy of OCI card on or before date(s) mentioned in Important Dates Section of

Prospectus Part-A. The earliest issued, valid OCI card must be uploaded on the portal. Any attempt at hiding a valid older OCI card or uploading only a newer card will be considered as providing false information and the candidature may be cancelled.

- v. The foreign nationals will be considered against the seats advertised for DM/M.Ch. & MD (Hospital Administration) Entrance Examination courses as per rules applicable at respective participating Institute. They should be registered with NMC before they will be allowed to join the said course, If they are selected for the same.
- vi. Seats are not reserved in any discipline for foreign nationals (except the bilateral agreement between the Government of India and any other nation).
- vii. Nominations/No objection for the candidate should reach the Examination Section before the date as specified under "IMPORTANT DATE AT A GLANCE". In case of non-receipt of the nominations/clearance/no objection from the concerned Ministry by due date, their candidature will not be considered.
- viii. No emoluments will be paid by AIIMS to the Foreign National candidates. Rules at respective INI shall be applicable as per prospectus part B in this regard.

#### 7.4. Submission of Application by Candidates who are employed

The Institute does not have any objection if the candidates in employment apply for the above postgraduate course (except candidates for sponsored candidates for all courses submit their applications direct i.e. they are not required to submit their applications through proper channel). However, all such candidates should inform their employer in writing that they are applying for this Entrance Examination. They should also sign the Undertaking in the downloaded copy of Registration Slip that they have informed their employer about the submission of the application to AIIMS. If any communication is received from their department/office withholding permission to the candidate's appearing at the entrance examination/admission to the course, the candidature/admission of the candidate will be cancelled, and no further correspondence in this regard will be entertained. **(Sponsored candidates are required to route their Registration Slip through proper channel).**

#### 7.5. Miscellaneous

- No Seats are reserved for OBC/SC/ST/EWS etc in DM/M.Ch Courses.
- All seats are advertised under three groups viz. General Seats, Sponsored Seats & Foreign National Seats.
- Seats are strictly non-convertible/non interchangeable between different categories/groups unless expressly mentioned as per rules applicable at any of the participating INI.
- Any seat remaining vacant in respective categories/ groups (General Seats, Sponsored Seats & Foreign National Seats) shall be filled subsequently as per rules applicable at respective INIs.

### 8.1. Cities for appearing in Examination

1. The applicants are required to indicate his/her choice of three cities (in order of preference) for appearing in the examination.
2. The allocation of cities\* for taking examination will be based on Completion of Application (first come-first allotted) and availability of computer nodes in the city. Applicants are therefore advised to complete process of application at earliest without waiting for last date.
3. The choice of cities made by applicant cannot be changed after submission of Application. The applicants should therefore make choices with utmost care.

\* Although AIIMS will make all efforts to ensure that the candidate is allotted a centre in the cities chosen by the applicant, if due to circumstances such as lack of sufficient number of candidates, logistic, administrative and other reasons, an Examination Centre in another city may be allotted finally. The cities may be added or removed, if deemed necessary. Applicants are therefore required to be prepared to appear for the examination in the Examination Centre allotted to them.

## 8.3. Phase I - Application Process

All information as well as access to process related to INI-SS will be done through its online portal. The portal for INI-SS can be accessed from [www.aiimsexams.ac.in](http://www.aiimsexams.ac.in) >>Academic Course Tab >>and clicking on INI-SS. The applicants are requested to visit the site frequently to keep themselves updated with latest information. The access and different components of application process will be enabled/disabled as per the dates specified in the Important Dates Tab.

### Eligibility for Scribe and/or compensatory time:

1. **The persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) defined under section 2(r) of the RPWD Act, 2016.**
  - A. Persons with Benchmark Disabilities in the categories of blindness, locomotor disability (both arms affected – BA) and cerebral palsy will be provided with the facility of a scribe if desired by the person against self-undertaking as per Appendix A Part A-1.
  - B. The PwBD candidates in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arms affected-BA) and cerebral palsy are allowed Compensatory Time of twenty minutes per hour of the examination if desired by the person against self-undertaking as per Appendix A Part A-1.
  - C. In the case of other categories of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities as defined under section 2(r) of the RPWD Act, 2016, the facility of scribe / Compensatory time will be allowed to such applicants on the production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned

has physical limitation in to write, and scribe is essential to write the examination on his behalf from the Chief Medical Officer/ Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care institution as per the prescribed proforma (Appendix A Both part A-1 and A-2).

**2. The persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of section 2(s) of the RPWD Act, 2016 but not covered under the definition of section 2 (r) of the said Act, i.e. persons having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing.**

- A. In the case of those with less than Benchmark disabilities as defined under section 2(r) of the RPWD Act, 2016, the facility of scribe and or / Compensatory time shall be granted solely to those having difficulty in writing subject to the production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from the competent medical authority of a Government Health Care institution as per prescribed Performa ( Appendix A Both part A1 and A-3).

Note :-

1. All required certificates must be submitted within due dates as specified in the Important Dates section of this document, failing which no facilities will be provided on the day of examination.
2. The applicants have the discretion of opting for his/her scribe or requesting the Examination Section for the same and should indicate their choice at the time of Completion of the Application for the Test.
3. In case the applicant opts for his/her own scribe, then additional information related to the scribe will be sought from the applicant before the examination. The qualification of the scribe provided by the Examination Section and own scribe will be one step below the minimum qualification criteria of the Test (i.e. one step below MBBS/ equivalent medical degree). However, the qualification of the scribe will always be matriculated or above. If the applicant has opted for his/her own scribe and does not bring own scribe on the day of the examination, then it will not be possible for AIIMS to arrange a new scribe.
4. If the applicant has opted for his/her own scribe, the Remuneration/Honorarium/TA will be the applicant's sole responsibility.
5. The Scribe can render only assistance to the candidate, i.e., reading instructions, test paper and mouse clicks, if the candidate is not able to do so. Explanation/Interpretation of question paper is strictly prohibited and may result in cancellation of the candidature.
6. All persons eligible for scribe and/or compensatory as described above shall be provided compensatory time of not less than 20 minutes per hour of examination. In case the examination is less than an hour, the duration of compensatory time should be allowed on a pro-rata basis. - b) Please see scheme of examination for qualifying criteria.

- c) Institute wise synchronised allocation of seats will be carried on based on over all rank in CML/AML and choices in order of preference as filled by the candidate.
- d) Single Best choice available seat at merit rank will be allocated in INIs on the basis of both Merit List (1) **Common Merit List (CML)** (2) **AIIMS Merit List (AML)**.

#### 9. Legal and Disciplinary Action

- Any dispute in regard to any matter referred to herein shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi Courts alone.

  6. uploading irrelevant photos in the application form in place of actual photo/signature/left thumb impression; or

  8. making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information; or
  9. Any seat remaining vacant in respective groups (General Seats, Sponsored Seats & Foreign National Seats) shall be filled subsequently as per rules applicable at respective INIs.
