| | <p>The captioned petition is filed by the petitioners who have obtained M.Sc. and Medical Ph.D. degrees and are presently working as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor in Rajarajeshwari Medical College and Hospital at Bengaluru.</p> <p>Petitioners' apprehension is that respondent No.2 is insisting to enforce the teachers eligibility qualification in Medical Institution Regulations, 2023 even to the present petitioners who are appointed based on their respective degrees and admittedly, do not possess degree in MBBS. Their apprehension is that respondent No.2 in coordination with the college where petitioners are serving may be demoted by applying 2023 Regulations.</p> <p>Perused the material on record.</p> <p>The apprehension of the petitioners is found to be reasonable and justified. Whether Regulations 2023 can be retrospectively applied even to those candidates who were appointed based on their M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees is the question that requires consideration at the hands of this Court.</p> <p>In that view of the matter, respondent Nos.1 and 2 are hereby directed not to implement the Guidelines for undergraduate courses under establishment of New Medical Institutions by implementing 2023 Regulations dated 16.08.2023 vide Annexure-C till the next date of hearing.</p> <p>Sri. Rajashekar S., learned counsel has already filed Vakalath for respondent No.1.</p> <p>Sri N.Khetty, learned counsel is directed to accept notice for respondent No.2.</p> <p>Petitioners shall serve two sets of writ petition copies on counsel appearing for respondent No.2 and shall also notify the grant of interim order by this Court.</p> | |
