4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 ELIGIBILITY for Government seats (G) seats:

- (a) A candidate must be a citizen of India; and
- (b) have studied and passed MBBS/BDS in a recognized Medical /Dental institution in the state of Karnataka; or
- (c) have studied and passed MBBS/BDS in recognized Medical / Dental institutions located in India and has studied for a minimum period of ten academic years commencing from 1st standard to 12th standard and must have appeared and passed either SSLC or 10th standard or 2nd PUC or 12th standard equivalent examination from the Karnataka State are eligible.”

In case of the candidate who has taken more than one year to pass a class or standard, the years of academic study is counted as one year only

Note: Children for the purpose of the rule means Natural born son / daughter and not adopted son/daughter and not grandson / granddaughter.

For the purpose of document verification and eligibility the following clauses shall be used.

4.2 ELIGIBILITY for Private seats

(GMP, OPN & MK, MA, ME, MU, MC, MM seats):

A. GMP

A candidate who fulfills the eligibility as per criteria clause b/c.

B. OPN

A candidate who is citizen of India; and have studied and passed MBBS / BDS in a recognized Medical / Dental institution.

C. For Religious Minority:

- i. Christian Minority of Karnataka* & Non-Karnataka.
- ii. Muslim Minority of Karnataka* & Non- Karnataka.

*Christian and Muslim minority candidates of clause b/c are considered as Karnataka Religious minority candidate.

** Karnataka Religious minority candidates will be considered first; then, non-Karnataka religious minority candidates if any will be considered later.

D. Linguistic Minority (MA, ME, MK, MU):

- i) Linguistic Minority Reservation is applicable to persons belonging to linguistic minority of the Karnataka state whose mother tongue is Tamil or Telugu or Kodava or Tulu; and
- ii) A candidate who has studied and passed in one or more Government or Government recognized, educational institutions located in the State of Karnataka for a minimum period of TEN academic years commencing from 1st standard to 12th and must have appeared and passed either SSLC/10th standard or 2nd PUC/12th standard examination from Karnataka State.

E. St. John's Medical college, Bangalore:

Category-1.	Roman Catholic Religious Nuns with SJMC approved two year rural service.
Category-2.	SJMC Alumni with SJMC approved two year rural service.
Category-3.	Roman Catholic Christian.
Category-4.	General Open Merit.

4.3 ELIGIBILITY for NRI seats(N):

- i. Has obtained MBBS or BDS degree in a Medical or Dental in recognized institutions which should be approved by MCI / DCI.
- ii. All NRI / NRI Wards / PIO / OCI candidates and Foreign Nationals.
- iii. Children of Non-resident Indian or their Wards. (As per Hon'ble High Court in WP Nos.17999-18002/2017)
- iv. Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No. 689/2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. dated 22-08- 2017.
- v. As per the definition defined in The Karnataka Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) Act, 2006 read with the Karnataka Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) (Amendment) Act, 2017 and the Income Tax Act 1961 Section 115 C (e) & 6, i.e., " Non Resident Indian" means an individual resident outside India who is a citizen of India or is a Person of Indian Origin and includes Persons of Indian Origin and Overseas Citizens of India.

4.4 ELIGIBILITY for Other seats (Q):

Has studied MBBS or BDS degree in a Medical or Dental colleges affiliated to any University established by law in India recognized by Medical Council of India or Dental Council of India and Government of India. All the candidates who have qualified in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 are eligible except NRI / PIO / OCI and Foreign Nationals.

5. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED

The Karnataka Examinations Authority or the Entrance Test Committee may from time to time specify for submission such other additional documents and issue directions as deemed essential for all candidates for maintaining absolute transparency and integrity in the document verification process, determination of eligibility and seat allotment and admission - through a notification on the website of KEA / updates on MCI / MCC.

5.1 MANDATORY documents

1. KEA 'PGET-2024' Registration form duly filled (print out).
2. Photo identity and address proof document (PAN Card / Driving License / Voter ID / Passport / Aadhaar Card / Ration Card)
3. 'NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024' **Admit Card & score card** issued by NBE for Medical & Dental courses.
4. SSLC or 10th Standard / equivalent marks card (For date of birth).
5. 2nd PUC or 12th standard Marks Card.
6. MBBS / BDS marks card issued by Universities of all phases/years.
7. Qualifying degree certificate.
8. Provisional Degree Certificate - only to those who have passed MBBS / BDS during 2024.
9. Certificate of internship completion in **Annexure 5** for candidates who have already completed internship. (Provisional internship completion certificate will be accepted for Candidates completing their internship 30-06-2024 for MDS and 15-08-2024 for MD/MS, only for 1st round of counseling in **Annexure 6**).
10. Certificate from the head of institute certifying that the Medical / Dental College from which the candidate has passed MBBS/BDS examination is recognized by MCI/DCI.
11. State / Central Medical / Dental Council Registration Certificate. [Provisional registration certificate will be accepted only for the candidates who have passed MBBS / BDS during 2024. Permanent State / Central Medical / Dental Council Registration Certificate to be compulsorily submitted at the time of admission process. (Candidates who have passed prior to 2024, should compulsorily possess the Original Permanent Registration certificate and upload the same)]
12. Eligibility Certificate (Other University)

13. All the candidates are also required to produce UNDERTAKING (**Annexure 7**), taken on a white paper. Further the same undertaking obtained on Rs. 20 e-Stamps Paper brought out in the name of the candidate to the Karnataka Examinations Authority as shown in (**Annexure 7**), only on submission of this document, candidate's admission process is stated to be completed and he /she becomes eligible for admission /allotment of User ID and Secret Key.

371(j) (Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) certificate - If applicable, Certificates issued by the competent authority for claiming reservation under 371(j) (Hyderabad-Karnataka Region). (**Annexure-8**) should be uploaded.

NOTE: Indian citizens or Overseas Citizens of India who have obtained their Primary Medical Qualifications from Medical Colleges outside India should have qualified in the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) which is conducted by National Board of Examinations - Document mandatorily to be uploaded. Further, they should have been registered with MCI / SMC and should have completed their internship or likely to complete their internship on or before 30-06-2024 for MDS and 15-08-2024 for MD/MS. (**Annexure 18**)

Other mandatory certificates:

14. Eligibility Certificate by RGUHS for the candidates graduated from other university other than RGUHS (To be submitted at the respective admitted college).
15. Migration certificate from the concerned University if MBBS / BDS done from other than RGUHS, Bangalore. (To be submitted at the respective admitted college).
16. Compulsory rural service bond on Rs.100/- stamp paper (**Annexure 1**) and undertaking for three years service on Rs 200/- stamp paper duly notarized (**Annexure 2**). (to be submitted at the time of admission process)

Apart from the above documents, the other documents to be compulsorily produced by the candidates based on their eligibility clauses (as per SI No. 5).

NOTE: Caste certificate or Caste Income Certificate or 371(j) Kalyana Karnataka reservation, Income Certificate has to be in the name of the candidate and father.

5.2 Documents for Clause-a

Further, school study certificates should be counter signed by the concerned Block Education Officer (BEO) / Deputy Director of Public Instructions (DDPI) COMPULSORILY in the proforma prescribed. (**Annexure 11**)
- ii) SSLC / 10th Standard or 2nd PUC / 12th standard marks card for having studied and passed in Karnataka.
- iii) Qualifying degree certificate Stating studied MBBS /BDS from within the state of Karnataka (PDC/Pass/completion certificate will be accepted only for candidates who have passed MBBS / BDS during 2024).
- iv) In case of claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983).
- v) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate (**Annexure 17**)

(Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

- ii) SSLC / 10th Standard or 2nd PUC / 12th standard marks card for having studied and passed in Karnataka.
- iii) In case of claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983).
- iv) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate **(Annexure 17)**
(Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

The certificate shall also indicate the period during which he/she has served or is serving outside the state of Karnataka and if the parent is a State Government Employee, a Certificate from the concerned Head of Department or the Head of the Office where such parent is employed shall be produced in this regard.
- iii) In case of claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983)
- iv) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate **(Annexure 17)**
(Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

NOTE: Caste certificate or Caste Income Certificate or 371(j) Kalyana Karnataka reservation, Income Certificate has to be in the name of the candidate and father.

5.5 Documents for Clause-e

- i) A study certificate of the parent employee for having studied for at least 10 years in State of Karnataka from the Head of the educational institution where he/she had studied. Further, School study certificates should be countersigned by the concerned Block Education Officer (BEO)/ Deputy Director of Public Instructions (DDPI) COMPULSORILY in the proforma prescribed. **(Annexure 11)**
- ii) Home town declaration certificate of the parent employee as Karnataka while joining the service and showing that he is transferable anywhere in India issued by the employer. The extract shall be countersigned by the employing organization's competent authority.

In case of claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983).

- iii) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate **(Annexure 17)**

(Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

5.5 Documents for Clause-f

- i) Certificate showing that the parent is / was a Member of Parliament elected from Karnataka issued by the Parliament Secretariat.
- ii) Candidates study certificate for 10 years for 1st to 12th Standard including the duration of study in New Delhi.
- iii) In case of claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983).
- iv) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate **(Annexure 17)**
(Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

- iii) If claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983).
- iv) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate (**Annexure 17**)
(Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

- i) Qualifying degree certificate Stating studying MBBS /BDS from the outside the state of Karnataka (PDC/Pass/completion certificate will be accepted only for candidates who have passed MBBS / BDS during 2021)
- ii) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate (**Annexure 17**)
(Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

5.8 Documents for Clause-z (NRI /OCI /PIO/Foreign Nationals Candidates)

- i) Candidate's parents resident certificate issued by the Embassy of that country complying with the Income Tax Rules / any other certificates to establish evidence that they are resident of that country / affidavit on Rs.100/- e-stamp paper to that effect.
- ii) Candidate's Passport / VISA / Resident VISA.
- iii) Citizenship of the candidate.
- iv) Income Tax Documents required as per the Income Tax Act 1961.

- v) If candidate is foreign medical graduate must submit screening test certificate.
- vi) Candidate's Study certificate for having studied outside India where applicable for the qualifying examination.

(Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

For Foreign Nationals

Foreign national's qualification registration certificate by the corresponding Medical Council or concerned authority in his / her own country from where he / she has obtained his / her basic medical graduate qualification. Obtain Temporary registration certificate from MCI/DCI within one month of securing admission.

Note: For the purpose of verification e-document may be considered with regard to NRI ward certificate subject to submitting the original at the time of taking the admission.

NOTE: Apart from the above documents, the other documents to be compulsorily produced by the candidates based on their eligibility.

5.10 Religious Minority (Muslim & Christian Minority)

- i) Religious Minority certificate issued by the concerned Tahshildar of Karnataka in the format **(Annexure 11 & 12)** along with a study certificate for having studied for a minimum period of 10 years from 1st standard to 12th Standard including either 10th or 12th Standard from the Head of educational institution located in State of Karnataka.

OR

- ii) Religious Minority certificate issued by the concerned Tahshildar for others to claim Religious Minority Quota under Non Karnataka Religious Minority.

5.11 Linguistic Minority (Tulu, Tamil, Telugu & Kodava)

Linguistic Minority certificate issued by BEO/DDPI **(Annexure 09 and 10)** and a study certificate for having studied for a minimum period of 10 years from 1st standard to 12th Standard including either 10th or 12th Standard from the Head of educational institution located in State of Karnataka. **(Annexure 09 and 10)**

5.12 St John's Medical College, Bangalore

- i) For Roman Catholic religious Nuns with two year rural service in SJMC approved centers.
 - a) Certificate of bona-fide membership in a Religious Congregation from Superior General / Provincial Superior. **(Annexure 13)**

- i. The Karnataka Examinations Authority or the entrance test committee may from time to time specify for submission such other additional documents as deemed essential from all candidates through the application form or through a notification on their website.
 - ii. The candidates claiming any of the exemption specified above shall produce such certificate as specified by the committee for claiming such exemption.
 - iii. In case, if any of the documents produced in respect of the Clause claimed by the candidate is found to be false / incorrect, the seat allotted to the candidate will be cancelled at any stage and the entire fee amount paid by such candidate will be forfeited.

Mere qualifying in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET PG MDS-2024 does not confer any right on the candidate for admission unless the candidate fulfils eligibility conditions / submits the documents / certificates. Further, only the candidates who complete the registration process including document verification are eligible for PG Medical seats in Government / Private Colleges in Karnataka.
2. Candidates have to appear for verification of documents as per the schedule according to PG NEET 2024 All India rank in the Centre.
3. Candidates will be allowed to enter the premises in the order of All India Rank and only 15 minutes before the scheduled time; hence candidates are advised to appear as per the scheduled time.
4. Candidates should compulsorily produce all the required documents in **ORIGINAL with two sets** photocopies of all the original documents.
5. The candidates who become eligible after verification will only be considered for entry of options to become eligible for allotment of seats.
6. Candidates have to be personally present as per the schedule for verifying the documents and **no one can represent them**.
7. KEA will publish the details of eligible candidates on the website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> after verification.
8. Candidates can bring drinking water bottle with them, candidates may carry some food and medicines if required.
9. The candidate should bring all necessary original documents with them in support of their claim / reservation made in their online application.
10. Verification of original documents requires more time for scrutiny of each certificate produced by the candidate. Hence the process may get delayed. Candidates have to appear in the order of All India Rank / schedule. Request to verify documents before the schedule time will not be entertained. Candidates have to arrange their return journey accordingly.
