The notification is issued for registration of candidates to appear for Final MBBS Part I Examinations commencing from **30.12.2021**.

ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR FOR FINAL MBBS PART – I THEORY EXAMINATIONS, DECEMBER 2021:

- 1. The MBBS students who have been admitted into the Medical colleges affiliated to KNRUHS in Telangana State, whose admissions are approved by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2017-18 are eligible to appear for FINAL MBBS Part I examinations in the month of December, 2021.
- 2. The Candidates who are failed, detained and not written the FINAL MBBS Part I examinations held previously are eligible to appear for the FINAL MBBS Part I examinations subject to fulfillment of regulations.
- 3. Candidates who are having 75% (SEVENTY FIVE PERCENT) of attendance and scored 35 % (THIRTY FIVE PERCENT) of marks in internal assessment examinations are eligible to appear for the FINAL MBBS Part-I examinations.
- 4. Cutoff date for calculation of attendance percentage will be **20.11.2021**.
