Sir,

In continuation to DCI Circular No.DE-NEET(MDS)Admission-2021/2896 dated 03.11.2021, I am hereby again directed to refer to various representations received from the Dental Colleges / Association / DME of the State of Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka and Haryana thereby requesting the Council to extend the dates of uploading MDS students details on DCI Website since the counseling process is not yet completed.

2. In this connection, I am directed to inform that as per Note (2) below the Time Schedule annexed to DCI Regulations, 2006 notified on 15.03.2018, the power to modify the Time Schedule / Counselling Schedule is vested only with the Central Government and even the Counselling Time Schedule circulated by DCI was also framed in consultation with MCC. Therefore, the States of Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka and Haryana directed to approach the Central Government for extension of last date of admission into MDS Courses for the academic session 2021-22, as per Note (2) below the Time Schedule annexed to DCI Regulations, 2006 notified on 15.03.2018

3. Further, it is clarified that in case the Central Government decided not to extend the date of admission, then, no admission will be considered valid taken beyond the last date i.e. 20.11.2021 in MDS Courses for the academic session 2021-22.
