Sub: Uploading the details of students to be admitted in BDS Course at Dental Colleges for the academic session 2020-2021, on DCI Website.

Sir,

In continuation of DCI letter No.DE-BDS(Gen)Admission-Act-2020/542 dated 23.12.2020 on the subject mentioned above, I am directed to say that, on the recommendations of DCI, the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide its letter No.V.12052/139/2020-DE dated 09.01.2021, has extended the last date of admission in BDS Course from 15.01.2021 to 30.01.2021 for the academic session 2020-21 only.

- 2. Accordingly, the college authorities of all dental colleges are hereby <u>directed to upload</u> the details of students, admitted in BDS Course at their dental institution for the academic session 2020-2021, on DCI Website, on or before the last date of admission i.e. <u>30<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 (12.00 midnight)</u>, positively. However, if any college faces any technical problem in uploading the details of their students on DCI Website, they may send such details, in attached DCI prescribed format, through e-mail / speed post / by hand, positively, which should be reached in the DCI office by 30.01.2021, failing which it shall be presumed that the college authorities have not admitted any student in BDS Course well within cut-off date at their college for the academic session 2020-2021. If the college authorities claim any admission after the cut-off date, the provisions of the Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 and Section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948 shall be attracted.
- 3. It is also stated that no request for extension of time to furnish / upload the above details of students or any other excuse or reason of technical fault, etc. shall be entertained, therefore, you are once again requested to ensure and make available all arrangements at your end to complete the above task, in time, so as to avoid any litigation and to enable this Council to take necessary action in a time bound manner.
- 4. In case, any admission(s) is/are made in violation of Revised BDS Course Regulations, 2007 as amended from time to time or the Time Schedule for the academic session 2020-21 or non-compliance of above directions for furnishing / uploading the details of the students on DCI website or violation of the provisions of the Dentists Act and Regulations made thereunder, the college authorities shall be liable to discharge such students. Non-compliance of these directions by any dental college / institution / University may attract provisions of the Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 providing for non-recognition of dental qualification in respect of such students or / and the provisions of Section 16A for withdrawal of recognition for violation of conditions of admissions, as the case may be, against such erring dental college(s).
