#### ORDER

#### Per. Justice Sanjeev Sachdeva

Petitioner seeks a direction to the respondents to include the 48 seats allocated to the NRI quota in the General quota, in case they are not filled up by bonafide NRI candidates on the basis of merit.

2. Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State relies on Rule 14(A)(2) of the Madhya Pradesh Medical Education Admission Rules, 2018 and submits that in terms of Rule 14 (A)(2), in case the NRI seats are left vacant, the same are to be included in the last round i.e. mop up round in the General Category and are to be filled on the basis of merit-cumchoice. She submits that the left over seats out of the 48 NRI seats that





2 WP-3718-2025 remain vacant shall be filled up at the time of mop up round from the General Category based on merit-cum-choice.

- 3. The statement is taken on record.
- 4. In view of the above statement, learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the petition.
  - 5. Petition is accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.
