Procedure for Institution stray vacancy Round at Private Unaided/
Minority Dental Colleges for A.Y. 2022-23

1. Institutional stray vacancy Round is only for Private Unaided/Minority Medical colleges and for seats remaining vacant after MOP UP Round.
2. All the admission at Institution stray vacancy should be done as per Rules of NEET MDS 2022 Information brochure.

3. The list of ELIGIBLE candidates for the institutional stray vacancy round will be published on the website on 30/11/2022 as per schedule.
4. It will be responsibility of the institute to verify and ascertain eligibility of the candidate as per respective Central Council rules before admitting the candidate even if name appear in list of ELIGIBLE candidates.
5. For institutional stray vacancy round eligible and interested candidates should approach to the Dean/Principal of the respective colleges within prescribed time and submit application for vacant seats **in person or any person**. Such type of applications should not be submitted in the State CET Cell in person or email. Such type of applications submitted in State CET Cell will not be considered valid for any institutional stray vacancy admission process.
6. For admission during Institution stray vacancy round the college / Institution should form a Committee of four members under Chairmanship of Dean/Principal to supervise the admission process.
7. College should display on their website & Notice board Vacancy Position, Applicants List, Merit list, List of selected candidates, Waiting list as per schedule.
8. The Rules of Ear Marking should be followed if two PG seats in State quota in same subject (One in Reserve and other in Open Category) is available. Please refer Annexure “C “ Page No 37 to 39 of NEET MDS 2022 Information brochure.
9. The rule of inter-se should be strictly followed if any reserve category seat remains unfilled. Please refer Annexure C page no 37 to 39 of NEET MDS 2022 Information brochure.
10. At the time of admission during institutional stray vacancy round a candidate should submit all his original documents along with requisite fees in the form of DD/Cheque during prescribed time limit.
11. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to submit all his original documents and requisite fees at the time of admission.
12. The admission process should be completed before Cut-off date prescribed for each course that is declared by respective Central Council and Competent Authority from time to time.
13. All the admissions are subject to approval of Admissions Regulating Authority after Cut-off date. The College should upload the information about admitted candidate in College Feedback Module of State CET Cell.
14. If any candidate not registered with STATE CET CELL and admitted during institution level round, such a candidate's admission will not be approved by Admission Regulation Authority (ARA).

Note:

1) If a candidate is not able to submit DD due to Bank Holiday, he /she may pay the fees by Cheque and replace the same on next Bank working day.
