**NOTE :**

**Eligibility for MOP-UP Registration**

- 1) Candidates who failed to register in Round I as extended registration process.
- 2) Candidates whose fees is forfeited as per rules mentioned in Information Brochure & now want to participation in MOP UP Round(s)

**Mop-up Round Process:**

**Available Seats for Mop up Round(s)**

**i) Seats not allotted during Round-2.**

**ii) Seats vacant due to non joining/ cancellation by candidate(s) allotted in Round-2**

Following types of Candidates are eligible for seat allotment in Mop up Round:

- a) Registered candidates who did not fill choices in round 1 & round 2.
- b) Registered candidates who participated in round 1 & round 2 but did not get any seat allotted in round 1 & round 2.
- c) Candidates who have registered in Mop up Round.

Candidate will have to fill fresh preferences for Mop up Round. All previous preferences will be considered as null & void. These preferences will be used for all subsequent Online Stray Vacancy Round(s).

Candidates not eligible for Mop up round:

- Candidates who have joined seat in round-1 of State Quota seats and not participated in round-2.
- Candidates who have joined seat in round-2 of State Quota seats.
- Candidates who have joined status at the end of round-2 of All India Quota seats (as per Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated: 30/03/2022 in W.P No. 174 of 2022).

If a candidate is selected during Mop up Round, he/she will have to join the college / seat allotted during that round. Candidate selected during Mop up Round will not be eligible for subsequent Online Stray Vacancy round(s) of State Counselling Process.

**NOTE** - For ensuring faithful obedience of time schedule and also keeping in view the limited time available for conducting counselling, all participating institutes/ colleges are directed to treat all Saturdays/ Sundays and Gazetted Holidays as working days.
