PG (DENTAL) ADMISSIONS 2022-2023 Non-Service Phase-II of counselling NOTIFICATION

In continuation to this Office Notification, dt.15-10-2022, Dr.NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-II of counselling for admission into **State Quota (SQ)/Competent Authority Quota (CQ)** Non-Service seats of PG Dental Degree/Diploma courses available in Un-aided Non-Minority Dental Colleges affiliated to Dr.NTR UHS for the academic year 2022-23 by the eligible **Non-service candidates**.

SCHEDULE

All the eligible **Non-Service candidates** whose names are in the Merit Position notified in the University Website are only eligible to exercise web options as per the above dates. The candidates who have joined allotted seat of Phase-I are also eligible to exercise web options of this Phase-II of counselling.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Candidates to whom allotment message is given have to pay Rs.23,600/- before obtaining allotment letter through payment Gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking).

Candidates who have already paid Rs.23,600/- in Phase-I Counselling are not required to pay the same.

TUITION FEE FOR PG DENTAL: The following is the **Tuition fee structure** to be payable for the State Quota/Competent Authority Quota seats in Private Un-aided Non-minority Dental Colleges as per GO.Ms.No.56, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 29-05-2020 of Government of Andhra Pradesh:

Note: The fee structure in Private Unaided Non-Minority Colleges is as per G.O.Ms.No.56, HM&FW (C1) Dept., Dt.29-05.2020 as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.10159 of 2020 and batch, dt.09-07-2020, which is read as "to permit the petitioners/students to pay fee fixed by the Regulatory authority by executing bond in the proforma prescribed by the Andhra Pradesh Private Medical and Dental Colleges Managements Association within the specified time as notified by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada".

As per the directions of Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.21389 of 2021, dt.01-10-2021 "to pay the stipend being paid by the dental colleges under G.O.Ms.No.75 Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, dated 06-05-2017 pending further orders".

Instructions to Candidates:

- A candidate who exercised options and joined in an allotted seat in this Phase-II counselling shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat. In case any candidate withdraws from the allotted seat, the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years for admission into Post Graduate Dental Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,54,000/- (Including GST 18%) as per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017.
- 2. Candidates who have joined in Phase-I counselling will also be covered under Phase-II rules.
- 3. As per G.O.Ms.No.252, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.07-10-2022 of Govt. of A.P the candidates who have joined PG (Dental) courses under In-service quota seats shall execute a bond covering the following rules:

The maximum duration to complete PG (Dental) course is six (6) years from the date of admission including University examinations and the maximum duration to complete PG (Medical) Diploma is four (4) years from the date of admission including University Examinations failing which the candidate will be deemed to be discharged from the

Note: 1. As per the Notice No.U-12021/01/2022-MEC, dt.12-07-2022 of DGHS, HM&FW Govt. of India, New Delhi, the joined candidates up to round 2 of AIQ or State Quota shall not be eligible to participate in the further rounds for All India Quota or for State Quota from the academic year 2022-23 onwards.

> Hence, the joined candidates upto round 2 of AIQ or any State Quota are not allowed for exercising web options in this Phase and also further Phases. If it is found at a later stage that such candidates have exercised options, such candidates will not be allotted any seats and necessary action will be initiated as

- 2. a) Candidates who have been allotted any seat in any Phase of counselling are not allowed to participate in the MoP Up Round.
 - b) Candidates already joined any seat are also not eligible for MoP Up Round.
- 5. Vacancies available for this Phase-II of counselling (placed on website):

After completion of Phase-II/Final counselling of service seats, the unfilled service seats

and not reported service seats are added to Non-service seats, for its original category as was earmarked in the original seat matrix of the service seats for Non-service seats as per G.Os.

Total Seats

6 Candidates opting for PG Dental Degree/Diploma courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web options. Candidates can exercise any number of options for any number of subjects and colleges if the candidate is interested to join as per eligibility.

The candidate who has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I, that particular seat will not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in this Phase-II of counselling.

7. Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the Web and take the print out of the saved options. Candidates are advised to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are really interested irrespective of the vacancies. If they are not interested to join any subject or college then they should not exercise options for the same.

Candidates while giving options should note that the seats vacated by the candidates selected in Phase-I counselling and slided to other college/course during this Phase-II of counseling process will be added & allotted simultaneously during this Phase of counseling itself.

The candidates are therefore advised to exercise options for all the seats in all the colleges as per their priority irrespective of vacancies shown in seat matrix. <u>Candidates are advised to give options to the courses for which they are really interested to join, so as to give chance to next meritorious candidates.</u>

- 8. Candidate can exercise web options from any place having internet facility One Time Password will be sent to the registered mobile number at the time of saving Web options.
 - I) Selected Options can be slided either up or down, added and deleted.
 - II) Web options opted must be saved by the candidate.
 - III) Web options once submitted can not be Edited.
 - IV) Web options saved but not submitted until the cut off date and time will be Auto submitted.
- 9. The selected candidates can download the provisional allotment order on payment of University Fee of Rs.23,600/- through payment gateway and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment order.

Candidates who have already paid Rs.23,600/- in Phase-I Counselling are not required to pay the same.

- 10. The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the above criteria to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.
- 11. Candidates who were allotted a seat in Phase-I counselling in any college of AP State, joined and slided to another college in AP in this Phase-II counseling, should submit the tuition fee receipt along with relief letter issued by the earlier college through e-mail (or) In person, for admission at the newly allotted college. The first college where the candidate initially joined in Phase-I will transfer the tuition fee, Original certificates etc., to subsequently allotted college in AP State.
- 12. The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr.NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling, the original certificates will be sent to the slided college by the concerned college where the original certificates are present.
- 13. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
