Suggested list of activities

Nation-wide celebration of National Doctor's day (1 July 2022) may be done in the following ways :-

1. By making "Ek Shaam Doctor Ke Naam"

• A cultural event of recitations, songs and performances singing the glory of doctors of the country may be conducted in dental colleges and hospital.

2. Award for the doctor

- An award to be given to the doctors for their outstanding performance.
- Award could be a certificate, a rose or anything which is found suitable and respectable for the award winner
- Photos of the awards ceremony could be shared by all concerned in social media and popularised hashtags.

3. Exhibitions on: A day in the life of a doctor

- Some exhibition may also be arranged in the lobby and encourage people to interact with the doctors
- Ek Selfie Doctor Ke Saath could also be encouraged in this, where a selfie being taken by public with the doctors.

4. Visit by the doctors of local hospital to schools, orphanages, old age homes

- Doctor and other health staff to visit schools to do advocacy on
- ↓ Healthy living
- 4 COVID appropriate behaviours etc
- 4 Sensitise how a doctor works in the hospitals to take care of them
- Specialised services to the under privileged in orphanages, old age home residents.
