Subject: Last opportunity to submit deficient documents - FMGE June 2024

- 1. In line with the clause 2.8.3 and 8.27.2 of the Information Bulletin for FMGE June 2024, a list of candidates who have failed to rectify the deficiencies in their applications by 14.06.2024 was published vide NBEMS notice dated 21.06.2024.
- 2. It has been noted that a number of FMGE June 2024 applicants have failed to rectify the deficiency in their applications related to following documents even by the last date prescribed i.e. **25.06.2024** vide above mentioned notice dated 21.06.2024.
 - a. Primary Medical Qualification Degree certificate/Provisional Pass Certificate duly <u>apostilled/attested by the Embassy of India</u> in the country from where the primary medical qualification has been obtained
 - b. Eligibility Certificate issued by the NMC/MCI (If applicable)/ Admission Letter/ Proof of qualifying NEET-UG
 - c. Proof of Citizenship
 - d. Mismatch in Name/Date of Birth in documents submitted
 - e. Supportive documents for transfer from one medical institution to another
 - f. Mark sheet of standard 12th and Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC)

- 4. It has been decided to extend one more opportunity to submit the documents <u>during 28.06.2024</u> (<u>2PM onwards</u>) to <u>30.06.2024</u> (<u>till 11:55 PM</u>). The last date for submission of documents as mentioned under clause 2.8.3, 2.8.4, 2.13, 8.27.2, 8.27.3 and important dates of the Information Bulletin for FMGE June 2024 should be read accordingly.
- 5. Documents can only be submitted through the Online Deficient Document Submission Portal which can be accessed through following weblink:

- 6. In terms of clause 2.8.4 and 8.27.3 of the Information Bulletin for FMGE June 2024, candidates who fail to submit duly completed applications with requisite documents and/or fail to rectify the deficiencies in their applications by the last date prescribed for rectification shall be declared ineligible. Admit Card shall not be issued to candidates who are declared ineligible before the conduct of the examination.
- Candidates who will fail to submit the required documents shall be declared INELIGIBLE for FMGE June 2024 session. <u>No further opportunity to submit documents shall be given.</u>
