Sir,

I am directed to say that this Ministry has decided to lower the qualifying cut-off percentile for NEET-MDS, 2022 by 25.714 percentile for each category (General, SC/ST/OBC and UR-PWD) in pursuance of DCI's MDS, Regulations, 2017 and 2<sup>nd</sup> proviso in clause 7(1) of DCI's Master of Dental Surgery Course (1<sup>st</sup> Amendment) Regulations, 2018, the qualifying percentiles for NEET-MDS, 2022 for the academic session 2022-23 now stand lowered as under:

3.	UR-PWD	19.286
