**Subject-Regarding filling up of 02 vacant seats of Jaslok Hospital and research Centre in the discipline DNB Nephrology**

In pursuance of the directions passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in "*W.P No. 264 of 2023 in Jaslok Hospital and Research centre vs Union of India & Ors.*", the competent authorities of MoHFW have decided to conduct a limited event of filling up **02 vacant seats of DNB Nephrology in Jaslok Hospital and Research Centre.**

The candidates '**Eligible**' for participation are as below:-

- Candidates who have already registered for NEET (SS)-2022 counselling and are not holding any seat as there will be no new registration.
- Candidates who have secured 20<sup>th</sup> percentile or above in NEET(SS)-2022 Examination.
- Candidates who have not been allotted any college in any of the rounds of NEET (SS)-2022 counselling.

- d) The candidates who are eligible for applying for Nephrology Course, as per NMC Norms.

The candidates '**Not Eligible**' for participation are as below:-

- a) The candidates who have already joined a seat through counselling process.
- b) The candidates who have resigned from their allotted seats either in offline/online mode.
- c) The candidates who have not qualified the desired percentile cut off.
