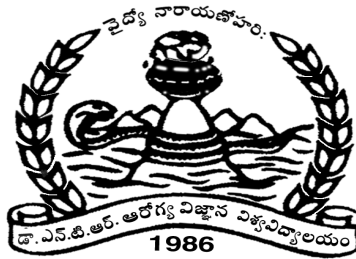

Prospectus for admissions into "Post Graduate Medical Degree / Diploma Courses under
Competent Authority Quota for the academic year 2021-22"

REGULATIONS:

The following are the Regulations for admission into the State Quota seats of all Post Graduate Medical Degree / Diploma Courses under Competent Authority Quota in all the Medical Colleges affiliated to Dr.NTR UHS and in Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), TIRUPATI for the academic year 2021-22.

1. NUMBER OF SEATS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA:

Dr. NTR UHS (Affiliated Colleges):

- 1.1 **Government Medical Colleges:** 50% of the total available seats are AIQ. Remaining 50% of seats are in State Quota under Competent Authority.

Private Un-Aided Non Minority Medical Colleges: 50% of the total available seats are in Competent Authority Quota. Remaining 50% of seats are Management Quota.

- 1.2 The details of the seats available and Seat matrix under Competent Authority quota for the year 2021-22 will be displayed in the University website before the date of exercising web options.

Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati (SVIMS):

50% seats of the total available seats are State quota under Competent Authority. The details of the seats available for the academic year i.e., 2021-22 are given in the Page No.42.

2. ELIGIBILITY

THE CANDIDATES WHO FULFILLED THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA ARE ELIGIBLE:

- 2.1. Candidates should have passed MBBS from a recognized Medical College / University.
- 2.2 NEET PG – 2021 CUT OFF SCORE DETAILS: The candidates qualified in NEET PG-2021 examination with the following cutoff scores and above are eligible to apply.

Category	Eligibility Criteria	Cut-off score (out of 800)
General Category (UR/EWS)	50 th percentile	302
SC/ST/BC (Including PWD of SC/ST/BC)	40 th percentile	265
UR-PWD	45 th percentile	283

Candidates should have completed internship latest by **30-09-2021**.

3. RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES

- 3.1** Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 for Non- State-Wide courses as given in Annexure-III of GO (P) No. 646, Edu. (W1) Department, dt.10-7-1979.

3.2 STATE-WIDE COURSES:

The courses at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada are State-Wide courses and admission into these Courses shall be regulated as per the provisions in the A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) Order, 1974 for State-Wide courses as given in Annexure-IV of GO (P) No. 646, Edu. (W1) Dept, dt.10-7-1979.

3.3 LOCAL AREA:

- 3.3.1 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as the local area for the purposes of admission to the Andhra University, (Nagarjuna University) and to any other Education Institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- 3.3.2 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Telangana State shall be regarded as local area for the purposes of admission to the Osmania University, (the Kakatiya University) and to any other educational institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- 3.3.3 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Ananthapur, Kadapa, Kurnool, Chittoor and Nellore shall be regarded as local area for the purposes of admission to Sri Venkateswara University and to any other educational institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

3.4 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

- 3.4.1 A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area.
- i) If he/she studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.
- or
- ii) Where during the whole or any part of the 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in Educational Institutions, if he/she had resided in that local area for a period of not less than 4 years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

3.4.2 A candidate who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub-regulation Above in relation to any local area shall

- i) If he/she has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than 7 consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as local candidate in relation to:
 - a) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.
 - b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has last studied in such equal periodsor
- ii) If during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but he/she has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of 7 years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to
 - a) Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.or
- b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.

3.4.3 EXPLANATION: (for purpose of this sub-regulation).

- i) "Educational Institution" means a University or any Educational Institution recognized by the State Government, a University or any other Competent Authority.
- ii) "Relevant qualifying examination in relation to admission to any course of study" means the examination, a pass in which is the minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study.

NOTE: The relevant qualifying examination for admission into Post Graduate courses is MBBS examination. The question whether the candidate is a local candidate or not will be determined with reference to his/her first appearance in the Part II of Final MBBS examination.

- iii)
 - a) In reckoning the consecutive academic years during which a candidate has studied any period of interruption of his/her study by reasons of his/her failure to pass any examination and any period of his/her study in a State wide University or a Statewide Educational Institution shall be disregarded.
 - b) The status of candidates who passed MBBS from Siddhartha Medical College (State Wide Institution) will be decided basing on their study period prior to their admission into MBBS course at Siddhartha Medical College for arriving at the local and non-local status, since it is a Statewide Institution.
 - iv) The question whether any candidate for admission into any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his/her parent or guardian.
- 3.5 While determining the number of seats to be reserved in favour of local candidates under sub-regulation (3.1), any fraction of seat shall be counted as one, provided that there shall be one unreserved seat.
- 3.6 If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill any seats reserved or allocated in favour of local candidate in respect of that local area, such seats shall be filled in as if it had not been reserved.
- 3.7 The applicant who claims to be local candidate with reference to sub-regulation 3.4.1 (i) or 3.4.2 (i) shall produce study certificate/certificates issued by the Head of the Educational Institution / Institutions concerned indicating the details of the year or years in which the Candidate has studied in educational institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4/7 consecutive academic years as the case may be ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the Part-II of Final MBBS examination.
 Those who did not qualify as local candidate under sub-regulation 3.4.1 (i) and 3.4.2 (ii) but claim to qualify by virtue of residence shall produce a certificate issued by an officer of the Revenue Department not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer independent charge of Subtaluk / Mandal in the form annexed to G.O.No.628, Education dt.25-7-1974.
- 3.8 **The following categories are eligible to apply for admission to the remaining 15% of un-reserved seats.**
 - 3.8.1 All candidates defined under sub-regulation (3.4) of Regulation-3.
 - 3.8.2 Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of study outside the State, or either of those parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State.
 - 3.8.3 Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi-Public Institutions in the State.
 - 3.8.4 Candidates, who are spouses of those in employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other Competent authority and similar other Quasi Government Institutions within the State.

- 3.8.5 Candidates who are employed in the State Government Undertakings, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-Public institutions within the State.
- 3.8.6 Candidates who are spouses of the local candidates as per Regulation - 3.4
- 3.8.7 ***Guidelines vide circular Memo No. 4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated 08-08-2016 and 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dated. 20.11.2017 of General Administration (SPF & MC), Govt. of AP shall also be observed while determining the local area of a candidate.***

NOTE: Relevant certificates must be uploaded along with application in respect of their claim for 15% Unreserved seats. In respect of proof of 10 years residence, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue Authorities not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar.

4. SERVICE CANDIDATES:

As per G.O Ms.No. 29, dt.22-03-2018 of HM & FW (C1) Dept., Government of AP, the service candidates will be given weightage of marks for determining their Merit position in the State as noted below:

(a) Tribal Area means:

- i. Candidate should have completed a minimum 3 years of regular and continuous service in PHCs/ Upgraded PHCs/ CHCs/ Area Hospitals/Sample Survey cum assessment units/ Leprosy temporary hospitalization wards etc in Tribal areas.
- ii. Incentive weightage of marks would be calculated @ 10 percent marks per year on the marks secured by the qualified candidate in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) PG-2021 examination up to a maximum of 30%.

(b) Rural Area means:

- i. Candidate should have completed a minimum 3 years of regular and continuous service in PHCs/ Upgraded PHCs/ CHCs/ Area Hospitals/Sample Survey cum assessment units/ Leprosy temporary hospitalization wards etc in rural areas;
- ii Incentive weightage of marks would be calculated @ 8 percent marks per year on the marks secured by the qualified candidate in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) PG-2021 examination upto a maximum of 24%.

Note: service rendered up to **31-03-2021** will be considered for giving above said weightage.

- The candidates who avail incentive weightage marks should serve in the same area (Tribal/Rural) for a period of 3 years after completion of course.
- All the candidates who are in-service and seeking admission to the Post Graduate courses shall submit the online application with details of service rendered by them in a prescribed proforma along with applications.
- Candidates shall upload "Eligibility Service Certificate" issued by the concerned Head of the Department in the prescribed form along with other certificates.
- Applications which are not accompanied by the "Eligibility Service Certificate" will not be considered for awarding incentive of weightage marks.

Eligibility for deputation and deputation period:

- "Deputation to in-service candidates selected after addition of weightage of marks shall be restricted to 3 years only i.e., (36 months). The candidates selected to prosecute Post Graduate courses shall be sanctioned deputation for not more than one course in his service.
- In case, if a service candidate is selected after addition of weightage of marks for diploma course (if PG Diploma Seats are available) the candidate may be given deputation for a period of 2 years if the candidate is otherwise eligible. If a candidate is selected for a postgraduate degree, the candidate may be given deputation for a Period of 3 years.
- If a candidate has already completed PG Degree before joining Government Service, he/she will not be given deputation to do another PG Degree. If a candidate has done PG Diploma course before joining Government Service or after joining Government Service, if he/she is selected for a PG Degree, then the deputation period will be as per the orders issued by the Government of AP from time to time.
- In-service candidate shall join the course on or before the commencement of the course after getting relieved from the concerned Head of the Institution. The Heads of the Medical Institutions shall relieve them immediately if they apply for relief enclosing a copy of the selection and allotment order issued by the Competent Authority.
- The candidate should have a leftover service of minimum 8 years for Degree and minimum 7 years for Diploma course to be eligible for deputation as service candidate.

Note: The In-service candidates shall serve for a period of 5 (five) years, in Government service after completion of Post Graduate course and in default he / she shall compensate the Government by remitting a sum of ₹.20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty lakhs only) and refund the salary received during the study period as per G.O.Ms.No.122, HM & FW (E2) Dept., dated 13-4-2006 and amended as per G.O.Ms.No.87, HM & FW (E2) Department, dated 21-03-2007.

- All candidates who are in-service seeking admission into PG Courses shall submit application forms with details of service rendered by them in the proforma as per Annexure-IV-A.
- In-service candidates shall submit service certificate issued only by the concerned Directorate/ Commissionerate in the prescribed form appended as Annexure IV – B if already available with them.

5. RESERVATIONS:

5.1 Seats of Post Graduate Degree and Diploma Courses are reserved for SC, ST and BC and BC sub groups as detailed below, which are called vertical reservations.

- SC Category – 15%
- ST Category – 06%
- BC Category – 29% (BC-A-7%, BC-B-10%, BC-C-1%, BC-D-7% & BC-E-4%).

- 5.2 Candidates claiming reservations under SC/ST/BC categories shall submit a permanent social status certificate issued by Andhra Pradesh Government as specified in the application form. The social status of SC/ST/BC candidates shall be subject to the scrutiny as per G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept. Dt 12-5-97.
- 5.3 Seats of Post Graduate Degree and Diploma Courses as per NMC guidelines shall be reserved for women and differently abled candidates, which are horizontal reservations for PG (Medical) Courses as detailed below.

Women reservation - 33 1/3%

Physically Challenged - 5%

5.4 **RESERVATIONS FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS (EWS):**

The reservation of 10% in favour of Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in admissions will be implemented only if seats are sanctioned for EWS Quota by Govt. of India / National Medical Council for the academic year 2021-22.

- 5.5 The candidates seeking the benefit of reservation under PwD category should enclose a valid disability certificate issued within three months prior to presenting his / her application.

The guidelines of Govt. of India and regulations of National Medical Council shall be observed in making admissions of persons with disabilities (PwD candidates).

The Medical Board constituted by the University will scrutinize / verify the disability certificates as per G.O.MS.No.31 Women development, Child welfare & disabled welfare (DW) department dated 01-12-2009 and candidates claiming reservation under PwD quota for confirmation of eligibility and the decision of Medical Board specially constituted for the purpose is final and binding on the candidates.

6. **APPLICATIONS THROUGH ONLINE:**

- 6.1 The on-line application forms will be available on the Website <https://pg.ntruhsadmissions.com/> from 11.00 AM on 05-11-2021 to 05.00 PM on 11-11-2021
- 6.2 The candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus / Instructions from the website <http://ntruhs.ap.nic.in>, before proceeding to fill the application form.
- 6.3 The candidate should fill the online application form available on the Website with the data required-for, through internet. The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection (home/internet café/net center). The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates ready to enter his/her correct data.

Procedure of filling online application form and payment of fee through online.:

The fee can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.

- a. The fee paid by the applicants is not refundable under any circumstances.
- b. Read the Notification, Prospectus / Regulations carefully regarding eligibility under local and non-local.
- c. The Registration number which will be sent to the registered mobile after entering the basic details, should be noted for further use. The Registration number should be kept confidential and should not be disclosed to others.
- d. The candidates should fill - in all the correct details in the online application form and shall upload all the requisite documents.

1. Registered Medical Practitioners should be careful to send the registrar immediate notice of any changes in their registered addresses.

6. All persons registered under this act are eligible to practice modern system of Medicine.

(Registration fee ₹. 3,000/- + 540/- GST 18% & Processing fee
₹.2,000/- + 360/- GST 18%).

Verification Fee: In addition to the above said Registration & Processing fee:

1. The candidates who acquired their MBBS Degree outside the AP/TS State shall pay ₹.3,540/- (i.e., ₹.3,000/- + 540/- GST 18%)
 2. The candidates who acquired their MBBS Degree in Abroad/Foreign Country shall pay ₹.8,260/- (i.e., ₹.7,000/- + 1,260/- GST 18%)
- The fee can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking
 - **The verification fee, registration fee and processing fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances. - 6.5 The candidates are advised to submit a printout of filled in online application form duly signed at the declaration area at the reporting college.

7. MERIT LISTS:

- 7.1 The merit position of the candidates applied shall be determined basing on NEET PG- 2021 Ranks and as per their eligibility.
- 7.2 The University will release final merit position of the candidates eligible for exercising Web options, after completion of the verification of data and certificates uploaded by the candidates.
- 7.3 Candidates who are included in the final merit list will only be eligible for exercising web options and the counseling for admissions will be held through online (web) mode only.

8. Tuition fee Structure:

The tuition fee structure in Private Unaided Non-Minority and Minority Colleges is as per G.O.Ms.No.56, HM&FW (C1) Dept., Dt.29-05.2020 and as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.10159 of 2020 and batch, dt.09-07-2020, which is read as "to permit the petitioners/students to pay fee fixed by the Regulatory authority by executing bond in the proforma prescribed by the Andhra Pradesh Private Medical and Dental Colleges Managements Association within the specified time as notified by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada".

9. Allotment of Seats:

The Selection procedure is as per

1. G.O.Ms.No.43, HM & FW (E1) Dept., dt.13-03-2013;
2. G.O.Ms.No.57, HM & FW (C1) Dept., dt.29-05-2020;
3. G.O.Ms.No.135, HM & FW (C1) Dept., dt.12-10-2021 and, any other orders that may be issued by the Govt. of A.P/Dr. NTR UHS from time to time.

10. SVIMS, Tirupati:

As per the direction of the Ministry of Health and Family welfare, Govt. of India Vide F.No.V.11011/1/2015-MEP(Pt.), dt.10/03/2017, and as per letter no. 420055/C1/2016, dated 28-03-2017 of Principal Secretary to Government, HM&FW Department, Government of A.P., the counseling for admission into PG courses offered by SVIMS, Tirupati shall also be conducted by Dr. NTRUHS.

Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), Tirupati is a University established by Govt. of AP State Legislature Act 1995 as an autonomous institute. The tuition fee, training, rules and regulations, stipend, bonds, honorarium during compulsory service etc., are as per SVIMS norms appended herewith. The details are also available in the website <http://svimstpt.ap.nic.in>. For further details contact: 0877-2287777, Ex: 2202, 2217.

11. ADMISSION RULES:

- 11.1 The cutoff date for joining by the selected candidates will be communicated in the allotment order.
- 11.2. All the candidates including service candidates joining the Post Graduate degree, diploma courses should execute bond on a stamped paper of ₹. 100/- value as prescribed in Annexure-III to the effect that he / she will complete the prescribed period of training or in default to pay ₹.3,00,000/- + 18% GST to the University and shall refund the amount received as stipend upto that date to the Government as notified by the University from time to time.
- 11.3 As per G.O.Ms.No.67, HM&FW (C1) Department dated 21-04-2017 candidates have to pay the discontinuation penalty of ₹. 3,00,000/- + 18% GST and they will be debarred for three years for admission into Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh for admission into PG Medical courses subject to receipt of orders from the Government if any and as notified by the University from time to time.

12. **ATTENDANCE:** Candidates selected for the various courses shall be the whole-time students. Service candidates will have to apply for leave to prosecute their studies and are required to produce the leave sanction order from the Competent Authority not later than three months after joining the course. The candidate is required to put in a minimum of 80% attendance during each calendar year for being eligible to appear for the University examination.

In a year all 365 days will be considered as working days and students should get 80% attendance each year separately to get eligibility for appearing University exams. The remaining days of absence (including maternity leave) will be considered for extension of study period.

13. **LEAVE:** Students will be permitted to avail 30 days leave per year. No Post Graduate is allowed to go on leave more than 8 days at a stretch. In case the absence of the candidate availing Medical Leave / Maternity Leave / Any other Leave or unauthorized absence is beyond 30 days in a year, the study period of the candidate will be extended to the extent of such period. No other leave is permitted.
- 13.1 **MATERNITY LEAVE:** Women students can avail maternity leave upto 120 days only once in their PG course of study and the study period will be extended to the extent of Maternity leave availed. The candidate shall not be eligible to appear in the University examinations till the completion of study period as per NMC Regulations (Duration of course).
- 13.2 **BREAK OF STUDY AND RE-ADMISSION:** If a student is absent continuously for a period of 91 days or more and seeks permission to attend the course, his / her application in prescribed format vide annexure V & VI by paying requisite fee in favour of Registrar, Dr NTR University of Health Sciences payable at Vijayawada shall be forwarded to the Registrar, Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences with the recommendation of the Principal. The candidates are advised to refer the regulations before submitting the application and paying the fee. If they fulfill the conditions, they may submit applications through the Principal of the College by paying the fee.
14. **PRIVATE PRACTICE:** No Post Graduate is allowed to do any private practice or consultation and should not accept any part time employment in any State or Central or Quasi Government or Private organizations during the period of Post Graduation study. The Principal has to take appropriate action after giving opportunity for explanation, if any student violates this rule.
15. **COLLEGE REGULATIONS:** Candidates are required to follow the rules and regulations of the college and should also abide by the regulations of the University. Under any circumstances they should not have any correspondence with the higher authorities directly without routing through proper channel.
- 15.1 Deputation to in-service candidates selected shall be restricted to 3/2 years only i.e., 36 months / 24 months for PG Degree & Diploma Courses respectively. The in-service candidates selected to prosecute Post Graduate courses shall be sanctioned deputation for one course only in his/her service time. The in-service candidate selected shall be permitted to take any course of his/her choice based on merit.

- 15.2 In case, if a service candidate is selected for Diploma Course the candidate may be given deputation, if the candidate is otherwise eligible for a period of 2 years. If a service candidate having a PG Diploma either before entry into Govt. Service or after entry into Govt. Service is selected for a PG degree in any specialty, he/she shall be allowed deputation for another period of 12 months only. No candidate shall be allowed deputation for studying 2nd Post Graduate Diploma course under service quota.
- 15.3 In-service candidates shall join the course on or before the closure of the admissions after getting relieved from the concerned Head of the Institution. The Heads of the Medical Institutions shall relieve them if they apply for relief enclosing a copy of the selection and allotment order issued by the Chairman, Selection Committee.
- 15.4 Any candidate in Government service other than the In-service candidate as defined under regulations, if selected for any Postgraduate course shall not be entitled for any kind of leave including extra-ordinary leave without allowances for prosecuting Post Graduate courses unless the candidate has put in a minimum service specified in regulation.

16. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

- 16.1 The admissions shall be closed on the date as notified by the University.
- 16.2 Any vacancy as on the date of closure of admissions shall not be filled. They will not be carried forward to the next year as per the directions of Supreme Court of India.

17. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The course shall commence as per the schedule notified.

18. DURATION OF COURSE:

The duration of P.G. Diploma course is 2 years and P.G. Degree course is 3 years. In the case of students having a recognized two year Post Graduate Diploma course in the same subject, the period of training for PG Degree is 2 years including the period of examination. If the break of study is more than three months the candidate has to apply (vide Annexure-VI) to the University through the Principal/Dean of the college. The University can give permission to the candidate to complete the course within twice the years of the study of the particular course based on evidences produced by the candidate for the break of study.

19. DISSERTATION:

The Post Graduates who are admitted must register the topic of their dissertation with the University within six months of commencement of the course and approval of the University should be obtained.

The dissertation should be submitted within 2 ½ years of commencement of the Course. In the case of the candidates who are granted exemption of one year of study period of degree course, the dissertation should be submitted within 1 ½ years of commencement of the course. If the above schedule is not followed the period of Post Graduation will be extended by six months.

- 19.1 A postgraduate student in broad specialties shall present one poster presentation, to read one paper at a national/State conference and to present one research paper which should be published/ accepted for publication/sent for publication during the period of his/her postgraduate studies so as to make him/her eligible to appear at the postgraduate degree University examination.
- 19.2 A Candidate registered for MD/MS Degree Examinations shall clear the examinations within 8 (eight) years from the date of joining for the course and the candidates registered for P.G. Diploma courses should clear the examination within 7 (seven) years from the date of joining of the course. If he/ she does not pass the examination within the period specified above, he/she shall not be permitted to appear for examinations thereafter.

20. MIGRATION AND TRANSFER OF CANDIDATES:

Migration / Transfer / Mutual transfer of Post Graduate students from one medical college to another Medical College, from one course to another course and from Degree to Diploma and vice versa are not allowed under any circumstances.

21. POWERS OF PRINCIPALS:

Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Principals of Medical Colleges in the State may at any time before completion of the Post Graduate course either on their own or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of the receipt of the show cause notice to submit written explanation and on personal hearing, order, cancellation of admission to the 1st year Post Graduate Degree/Diploma course if in his/her opinion such candidate had furnished incorrect particulars/false information in the certificates or in the documents attached thereto or in the Statements made either before the authority in charge of admission or the Principals or in any other manner. Against any such order of the Principal, an appeal shall lie with the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, A.P. Vijayawada.

22. POWERS OF THE DR. NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES:

Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada may either suo moto or on an application made to them, call for and examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof in respect of the admission made by the concerned authority, for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness of legality or propriety of such selection or cancellation and pass such order in relation there to as they deem fit including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made, provided that the University may, before canceling such selection or admission, give an opportunity to the authority and to the person affected to show cause against such cancellation. Dr.NTR UHS has every right to cancel the admission of any candidate without any notice, if the certificates produced by the candidate are found to be fake / false/forged

Note: If a candidate is found to have submitted false information such candidate is liable to be disqualified for admission and in case already admitted, the admission will be cancelled. Further disciplinary action against him/her will be initiated by the University as per rules.

3. RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The courses are full time courses. The candidate shall be full time resident. No postgraduate is allowed to do any private practice or consultation and shall not accept any part time employment in any state or central or Quasi Government or private organizations during the period of Post Graduate study. If any student violates this rule, appropriate action shall be taken.

2. FEES:

1. The Selected candidate has to pay the University fee as fixed by Dr NTRUHS, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh. Other Fees as per SVIMS.

3. At the time of reporting for admission, the candidate has to pay
 - a) Rs. 23,500/- towards University fee by All India Quota candidates by way of DD & State Quota candidates have to pay to Dr. NTRUHS.
 - b) Rs.11,200/-(10% of tuition fee & other fee)which is non refundable by way of DD.
 - c) Balance fees of Rs.1,00,800/- by way of another DD.
 - d) The demand draft (DD) shall be drawn in favour of, **“The Director, SVIMS, Tirupati”**, payable at Tirupati. The DDs shall be drawn on or after commencement of admission schedule.

In case, the candidate wants to slide to other college, the amount paid under (b) will not be refunded, the rest of the fees will be returned.

3. Hostel Accommodation:

i. Shared accommodation will be provided to the candidates on rent fixed as per rules of the institute subject to availability. They will have to necessarily stay in the accommodation.

ii. The students are required to vacate the hostel accommodation within seven days of the completion of their course failing which Rs. 100/- and Rs. 200/- per day will be levied for bachelor and married hosteller respectively as penal rent for unauthorized occupancy of hostel accommodation. Under such circumstances, the room will be vacated/evicted by the hostel authority/security staff during the unauthorized stay.

iii. The students will be responsible for proper upkeep of the furniture and other fixtures of the room. In case of damage/loss, a penalty would be imposed as assessed by the wardens of the hostels.

iv. No electrical/civil alternation in the room is allowed.

v. Use of air conditioner /heaters and other electrical appliances consuming high electrical energy is not permitted in the hostel.

vi. Hostel facility is available for the candidates who satisfy the following:

a. Payment of caution deposit of Rs.5,000/-(refundable) and hostel establishment fund (Corpus fund)of Rs.5,000/- (Non-refundable) to be paid on the day of allotment of hostel accommodation.

b. The mess charges shall be borne by the students apart from the hostel establishment charges as applicable.

At the time of allotment of hostel, the candidate has to pay 01 year mess establishment charges.

4. Stipend:

Monthly stipend as per SVIMS rules shall be paid to the candidate admitted to the course for the period not exceeding 36 months, taking their monthly attendance into consideration. At present they are being paid monthly stipend of Rs.80,904/-, 83,216/- and 85,528/- respectively during I, II and III year course of study.

Note: *In-service candidates will not be paid stipend if he/she draws leave salary in their parent institution.*

5. Resident's Manual :

After admission, each Postgraduate Resident will be issued a copy of the Resident's manual. The manual consists of the duties, responsibilities, attendance, leave, academics, thesis writing and other guidelines to be followed during the training period. A copy of the resident's manual for the year 2020 is available for reference in the institute website: <http://www.svimstpt.ap.nic.in>

6. Log Book:

The candidate shall maintain a log book. There shall be entry of various special investigations done, procedures, operations performed etc., by the candidate during the study period certified by the head of the department. The Log book shall be submitted to the examiners at the time of practical and viva voce.

7. Duties and responsibilities:

Duties and responsibilities of students joining PG (MD/MS) medical courses shall be fixed by the Institute from time to time. They will be required to pursue such works that may be needed in the legitimate interest of the patient care in the hospital. The service of the post graduate resident may be terminated without any prior notice by the Director-cum-Vice Chancellor on the following grounds:

- i) If SVIMS is satisfied on medical evidence that the resident is unfit and is likely to remain so for a considerable period, for reasons of ill health and unable to discharge his / her duties. The decision of the Director-cum-VC, whether the Resident is unfit and is likely to continue to remain unfit, shall be conclusive and binding on him / her.
- ii) If the resident is found to be guilty of insubordination, interference with the patient care/university administration or misconduct.
- iii) If any resident is absent continuously for more than 30 days without any intimation to the office, course completion certificate will be issued and deemed penalty will be levied.
- iv) If the certificates submitted by him/ her at the time of joining the course are found to be not genuine by competent authority at any time during or after the course his / her Degree is liable to be cancelled.

8. The Performance of the candidates joining the course will be evaluated periodically by a committee constituted for the purpose and in case of unsatisfactory performance, the Institute has the right to take appropriate action to extend the period of training or detain the candidate and make him/her ineligible for appearing for final examination including the removal of the name of the candidate from the rolls of the institute.

9. Library:

There is a well established separate library building in 45,000 sq.ft. available in SVIMS Campus with good collection of (11670) books with subscription for 148 print journals (79 foreign and 69 Indian). The library has back volume journal collection of 6865 dating back to 1993. The Library is well equipped with modern facilities such as e-learning to access internet and web resources including online journals and e-books. All library services are being automated on modern line by adopting KOHA Library Automation Software. The computerization of collections is under process which will be accessible through OPAC. There is a computer lab consists of 25 nodes to access e-resources for library users on free of cost. The main thrust of the library continues to be improvement, of quality of services and facilities, achieving high degree of user satisfaction and modernization of its activities and operations. It has Scanning and Photocopying facilities for library users. The Library is kept open for 363 days in a year except Jan 26th and Aug 15th and functions 16 hours a day i.e. 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. (midnight). During festivals, holidays and Sundays, it works from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

10. Warning:

In case any candidate is found to have supplied false information or certificate or is found to have withheld or concealed certain information, he/she shall be debarred from continuing the course and shall face such appropriate action initiated against him/her by the Institute and his/her name will be referred to NMC/Medical Council of India.

11. Discipline:

The students shall maintain strict discipline during the period of study/training program in terms of conduct rules of the institute. The candidates shall not resort to any strikes during the period of their study. The students are not permitted in criticizing the policies of the Institute either before the print or electronic media or anywhere which amounts to dereliction of duties. Their grievances (if any) may be submitted to the Dean through proper channel. They are not permitted to approach the legal authorities/ NMC/MCI/ Govt. without prior permission by the institution. In case of violation of the conduct rules, the admission of the candidate is liable for cancellation apart from invoking the terms and conditions of the bond.

12. Ragging:

Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh, vide Act.No.26 of 1997, dated 21-08-1997 & amendments made from time to time and NMC/Medical Council of India (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges/ Institutions) Regulations, 2009 issued vide notification dated 03-08-2009.

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the student concerned shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/ her from the Institution and the information will be forwarded to NMC/ Medical Council of India for taking necessary action.

After admission, each candidate has to submit an affidavit duly signed by self and parent /guardian. The affidavit is available in the website www.amanmovement.org.

14. Powers of Dean:

Notwithstanding anything contained therein, the Dean, SVIMS may at any time before completion of the course either on his/her own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of receipt of the show cause notice to submit the written explanation and on personal hearing, order the cancellation of admission to the course, if in his/her opinion such candidate had furnished incorrect particulars/false information or in the certificates or in the statement made either before the Dean or any other manner. Against any such order of the Dean, the appeal shall lie with the Director-cum-VC, SVIMS, Tirupati.

15. Bonds:

1. The selected candidates have to execute two bonds. The proforma of the Indemnity Bonds are available at **Appendix-I**, which are to be submitted on or before the date of commencement of the course and receive the admission order.
2. The candidate shall execute the Indemnity Bond – I on a stamp paper (non-judicial) of Rs.100/- value, that, in the event of the candidate discontinuing the studies at any time during the course, he/she shall be bound to pay a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs only) + GST as applicable along with the full stipend amount received by him/her back to the Institute.
3. The candidate shall also execute another bond (Indemnity Bond – II), that in the event of not willing to work in the post and pay offered by the institute after successful completion of the course for a period of one year, he/she shall be bound to pay a sum of Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty lakhs only) + GST as applicable.

16. Compulsory Service:
