OFFLINE COUNSELING FOR STRAY VACANCY FOR SELECTION AND PROVISIONNAL SPOT ADMISSION OF THE CANDIDATES INTO THE 1^{5T} YEAR MBBS COURSE IN THE GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGES OF ASSAM FOR THE SESSION 2021.

This is for general information that the offline counseling for Stray vacancy for selection and spot admission of the candidates into 1st year MBBS course in the Government Medical Colleges of Assam for the session 2020 under Un-reserved category shall be held on 28th April/2022 at the office of the Director of Medical Education, Assam, Sixmile, Khanapara Guwahati-22 at 11.00 am. The candidates who secured Assam State Rank upto 517 of NEET-UG-2021 may appear in the said counseling.

Candidates who were selected through 1st, 2nd and Mop-up round of online counseling and admitted thereafter are also eligible to attend the offline Stray vacancy round of counseling.

Candidates who are satisfied with their allotted seats and institutions during the 1st 2nd and Mopup round online counseling need not appear the Stray vacancy round of counseling and their seats which are already allotted shall remain unchanged.

However those candidates already selected during first, second and Mop-up round of counseling who want to change their institution as per available vacancy in order of merit may appear in the Stray vacancy round of counseling.

The new candidates called up for Stray vacancy counseling must bring the Application Form (Schedule-I) in original, duly and properly filled in, Marks sheets of 10+2 (Sc.) examination, Admit Card of HSLC examination, Pass Certificates of HSLC & 10+2 (Sc) exam, PRC, Caste certificates, Admit card & Score card of NEET(UG) 2020 and other relevant documents in original. A set of photo copies of all the said documents signed by the candidate himself/herself are to be submitted along with the Application Form (Schedule-I) at the time of counseling.

The candidates who had already submitted the complete Application Form (Schedule-I) at the time of admission during 1st and 2nd and Mop-up round of counseling need not submit the same. However, they shall have to produce the admission acknowledgement receipt at the time of Stray vacancy round of counseling.

Candidates must appear physically for counseling on the scheduled dates and time, failing of which no seat shall be allotted in this counseling.

NOTE: - The date of counseling for stray vacancy round of BDS course in the Government Dental Colleges of Assam will be published later.
