<u>Post – Graduate Program/ Courses Conducted by University</u> Introduction:

1.1 Master of Science in Pharmaceutical Medicine:

The discipline of Pharmaceutical Medicine concerns the medical and healthcare aspects of research, development, evaluation, registration, monitoring, and marketing of medicines and healthcare-related products. As is well-known, pharmaceutical products including health products play a major role in health care, promoting health, relieving symptoms, providing cure and palliation.

The Master of Science (Pharmaceutical Medicine) Program at the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS) provides an outstanding opportunity for graduates in the Health Sciences including Alternative systems of Medicine, Ayurveda, Unani, Homeopathy, Pharmacy, and Basic Sciences to pursue a very interesting and challenging career in contributing to the development of products ranging from biologicals, herbals, nutraceuticals, devices to health promotion.

The MUHS started the Master of Science (Pharmaceutical Medicine) Program in 2007, with a curriculum revision in 2012. Since inception-, students have completed the course and these alumni have made a mark and are pursuing successful careers in academia as well as industry in India and abroad. As our world evolves and progresses, it is important for us to keep up with the changes in healthcare, regulations, and education policy. By revising our course curriculum, we can better prepare ourselves for the skills and job readiness needed to succeed in our chosen fields. It is time to identify the gaps and work towards bridging them for a brighter future.

PROGRAM SCOPE:

The Program is designed considering the varied backgrounds ranging from health sciences, and pharmacy to basic life sciences, of students. The Program will provide an environment that will motivate, enlighten, and train students to pursue various challenging careers as professionals in clinical research, drug regulations, Pharmacovigilance, medical writing, entrepreneurship in drug development, and many more.

OVERALL GOAL:

The Master of Science in Pharmaceutical Medicine at MUHS aims to prepare competent, smart, skillful, motivated, and creative professionals with deep knowledge of pharmaceutical medicine with the required competencies and skills. The graduating professionals will be job-ready for working in research institutes (government and non-government) and industrial companies that develop, produce, investigate, and supply pharmaceutical products. They will also be able to pursue academic careers in pharmaceutical medicine and further studies in doctoral Program.

<u>1.2 MBA (Health Care Administration) :</u>

Healthcare is one of the fastest growing fields and is the third largest service sector in India. The industry is emerging as one of the promising sectors in the economy. Existing healthcare organizations are expanding by opening hospitals in new service areas and new organizations are entering with the latest Technology and Marketing Strategies. Besides, India is also eyeing the global Healthcare market to emerge as one of the possible destinations for international patients. This course is a professional course, approved by the Govt. of Maharashtra and ALL INDIA COUNCIL OF TECHNICAL EDUCATION (AICTE), New Delhi.

Healthcare administration plays a vital role in the healthcare system by overseeing the management and operation of healthcare facilities, including hospitals and clinics. Administrators are responsible for planning, organizing, and coordinating healthcare services, managing finances and resources, ensuring compliance with regulations, and fostering collaboration among healthcare professionals. Their role is essential for optimizing resources, maintaining quality patient care, and promoting the overall health and well-being of individuals and communities within the healthcare system.

1.3 Master of Public Health:

MPH is an intensive two-year course designed to provide an excellent grounding in Public Health to strengthen each learner's knowledge and skills contributing to the development of a cadre of public health professionals. It has been designed with an inherent recognition that individuals admitted to this Program have prior and current experience in the health sector. The Program is divided into classroom-based course work and field-based practical experience in Public Health. The exit competency of the Program allows the individuals to demonstrate their proficiency and mastery of the Program competencies in the real-world application in the form of a facility and community based project. The project assignment is to be undertaken as a core part of the course curriculum. This course is a professional course, approved by the **Government of Maharashtra.** The course provides systematic coverage of major topics in the area of Public Health based on international standards. It is appropriate for those who want to pursue a career in the area of Public Health. The course curriculum is designed with technical support from government organizations and experts in Public Healthbelonging to academic and medical education.

postgraduate Program/ Courses (screening test): - Objective based Screening test will be conducted to shortlist the applicants for all above postgraduate Program/ Courses. <u>Svllabus & Rules for Entrance Examination.</u>

Multiple-choice questions (M.C.Q.) shall be based on the **Basic Concepts of health and disease**. **National health policies and health Program**.

Students have to appear for objective type Common Entrance Examination (CET).

Applicant can choose any one of the following Examination Centre for CET, but the University will decide the examination center on the basis of choice of no. of applicant received for respective Centre.

 Details of Date of Examination, Time & Venue shall be informed on Hall ticket provided for CET. Hall ticket will be issued online to eligible candidates on their email address provided by them.

- Language of entrance examination shall be English.
- The examination shall consist of multiple choice question paper of 100 marks containing 50 questions, and duration of examination shall be one and half-hour.
- The candidate will be required to mark the correct answer by black / blue ball point pen in the given Objective question booklet.
- Each correct answer will be given two marks. There shall be no negative marking.
- Scratching, overwriting, multiple answers will be considered as wrong answer and no marks will be allotted to them.

Preparation of Merit list:

A Merit list shall be prepared of those candidates appearing for Entrance Examination (Screening Test). The said merit list shall be used for the process of provisional admission.

First Level

The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage upto 2 decimal points) at HSC.

Second Level

The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage upto 2 decimal points) at SSC.

Third Level

If the tie still persists then an older candidate will be preferred over the younger candidate.



13. Selection Process: -



At the time of admission, the selected candidate should bring all original documents and two set of attested copies of the same in support of claim made in application form i.e. Caste Certificate, Caste Validity

14. Disqualification for Admission: -

- A Candidate who has already taken admission to P.G. course in other subject or faculty will not be eligible for admission.
- Selected candidates who have cancelled their admission or do not take admission within stipulated period shall not be eligible for admission in future.
- A candidate who has failed to submit above-mentioned documents (Point No.10 (4) will not be eligible for admission.
- Failure of the candidate in making full and correct statements in the application form and / or suppression of any information would lead to disqualification of the candidate.



15. Attendance: -

80% attendance is compulsory failing which students will not be allowed to appear for the examinations. Medical certificate is necessary if absence is due to illness Information Brochure 2024-25

18. Conduct of Course: -

- The Candidate admitted in the fulltime Program/ Courses shall have to remain present in institute for full day. However, the Candidate admitted in the fulltime M.Sc. Pharmaceutical Program will have blended mode learning.
- The candidate admitted in these Program/ Courses will not be allowed to work in any other institute or will not be allowed to work as a medicalpractitioner part time / full time.
- The student while studying in this PG Program/ Courses, if found indulging in antinational activities, unlawful activities or ragging in any form, will be liable to be expelled from the Program/ Courses by the competent authority.
- It is responsibility of each student to have proper documents.
- For Program/ Courses, the maximum duration to complete the course after registration will be Up to 4 (four) years considering the maximum possible gap and attempts.

per Postgraduate Medical Education Regulation 2000 and Amendment Notification No. MCI.18(1) 2008-Med./54470 dated 25th march 2009 following is the criteria for reservation under physically handicapped Category "5% seats of the annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with locomotor disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70%.

- 2) Provided that in case any seat in this 5% quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates with locomotor disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% then any such unfilled seat in this 5% quota shall be filled up by persons with locomotor disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% before they are included in the annual sanctioned seats of State Quota.
- 3) The Candidate with a disability more than 70% will not be eligible for admission to Health Sciences (Post Graduate) Program/ Courses. No other disability shall be allowed as per the MCI regulations. However, such a candidate will be required to undergo medical examination by a Special Medical Board constituted for this purpose by the Competent Authority.
