Important Points to Be Noted by Candidates

1. The NEET - PG MEDICAL Information Brochure is available on the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in. Candidates are advised to download the Information Brochure and read it carefully before filling the ONLINE application form. In the event of rejection of an incomplete application form, request for re-consideration will NOT be entertained.
2. This brochure is an information booklet alone. The guidelines contained are subject to modifications as per instructions received from time to time from the Government or Statutory bodies.
3. The entire counselling process from submitting application until admission will be made through ONLINE MODE ONLY.
4. Candidates are advised to fill the application form on their own and not through any agent or third party.
5. A candidate can submit only **ONE NEET- PG MEDICAL** application. Any candidate found to have submitted more than one application for **NEET- PG MEDICAL** shall be debarred from the NEET-PG MEDICAL Counselling process and his / her candidature shall be cancelled.
6. Submission of application will be only through the CENTAC website – www.centacpuducherry.in. Candidates should check the website regularly for updates until the completion of the admission process.
7. An exclusive mobile number and an email id of either the candidate or the parent / guardian of the candidate is an absolute necessity. The access to the candidate's dashboard can only be made through OTP validation that is sent to the candidate's registered mobile number. Candidates are advised to use the same mobile number till all the admissions are over.
8. Candidates must ensure that the e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in the Online Application Form are their own or of their Parents / Guardian only, as all communications with regard to the counselling process will be sent to the candidate through SMS on the registered Mobile Number only.
9. All communication with the candidate will be only through SMS sent to the candidate's registered mobile number or sometimes through email, should there arise a necessity for individual communication. Candidates should also regularly check the NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES that will be uploaded on the website from time to time.
10. CENTAC will not be responsible for consequences due to non-follow up of NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES published on the website regarding counselling to NEET PG - MEDICAL courses for the Academic Year 2025-2026. Hence, candidates should regularly check the NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES that will be uploaded on the website for updates.

11. The documents that are required in digital format to be uploaded along with the application are given in Part I, Clause 12 of the NEET PG - MEDICAL Information Brochure.
12. For information on Reservation of Seats for various categories, refer Part I, Clause 9 of the NEET PG - MEDICAL Information Brochure. The details of category-wise reservation (No. of seats) can be viewed from the Seat Matrix that will be uploaded separately on the CENTAC website.
13. Application submission comprises entering of Personal Details, Academic Information, Uploading of Documents, Payment of Fees and Submission of Course Preferences.
14. For information on Submission of Course Preferences refer Part I, Clause 16 of the NEET PG - MEDICAL Information Brochure. Failure to enter Course Preferences (at least ONE), will result in non-allotment of a seat. Course preferences once submitted for a Round will be final.
15. Candidates are advised to choose as many course preferences as may be possible. This would facilitate in securing admission to an alternate course / college, in case the candidate is not able to secure admission of the first choice.
16. Candidates are advised to go through the details of Tuition Fee notified by the Health Department published on the CENTAC website. The Tuition Fee for NEET PG - MEDICAL courses should be paid to CENTAC through the ONLINE mode only.
17. Candidates are also advised to visit the college website or contact the college authorities directly for any query regarding additional fee / bond before filling choices.
18. The candidate will be able to edit the entries made by him / her including personal details and course preferences till the last date permitted for submission of online application. After the last date, the data will be frozen with no further modifications possible. For the last date of submission of Online application refer NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES published in the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in.
19. MERIT LISTS / ELIGIBLE LISTS and ALLOTMENT LISTS for each Round will be available on the website and the results WILL NOT BE COMMUNICATED INDIVIDUALLY.
20. It is mandatory for the allotted candidate to physically report to the college along with the original documents and pay the prescribed fees so as to confirm the allotted seat. No other person in the place of the candidate will be allowed to submit the documents and take admission on behalf of the candidate.

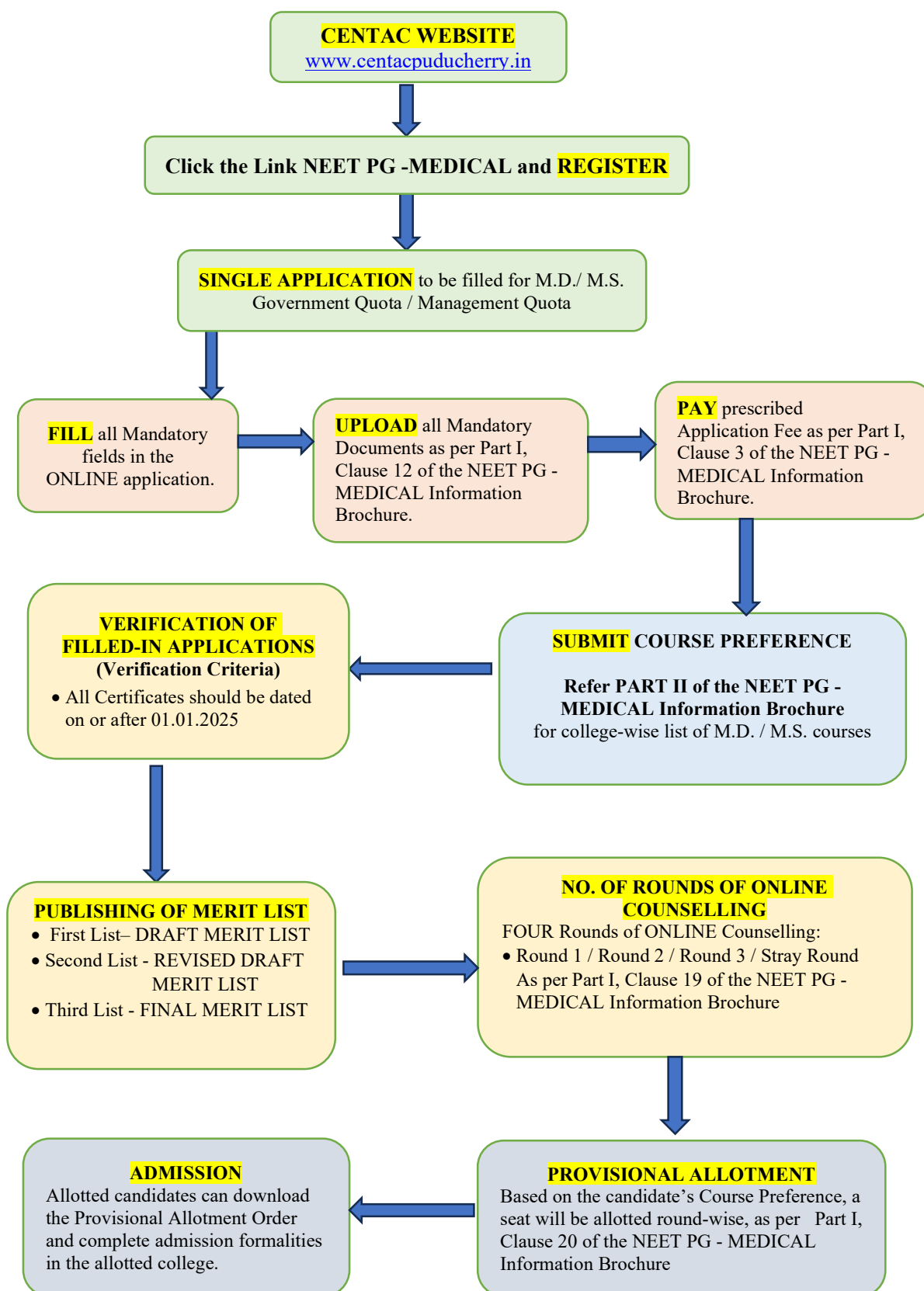

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AN OVERVIEW OF THE NEET PG MEDICAL ADMISSION PROCESS



SECTION – I: GENERAL INFORMATION

1. INTRODUCTION

The counselling for allotment of candidates to PG Medical (M.D. / M.S.) courses for the year 2025-26 will be done by the State Counselling Authority - CENTAC. All admissions to PG Medical courses will be done as per the relevant norms / guidelines / regulations notified by the concerned Regulatory Bodies.

Under the regulations framed by the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, admissions to Postgraduate Medical courses (M.D. / M.S.) in medical colleges affiliated to Pondicherry University and approved by the Medical Council of India will be based on the NEET PG Medical 2025 examination. The admissions for the Academic Year 2025–26 will be carried out by CENTAC, considering the NEET PG Medical 2025 score and rank.

The candidate should have passed the final M.B.B.S. examination from a recognized Institution / University and **must have satisfactorily completed One Year Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship (CRRI) as on 31st July 2025** and must submit their internship completion certificate at the time of admission.

Admission to the “Government Quota Seats” in Private Colleges will be as per the laws / regulations/ orders of the Government of India, or of the Government of Puducherry.

The Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) in the Directorate General of Health Services, MoHFS, GoI does the Counselling for admission to the M.D. / M.S. seats under the following quotas:

- All India Quota Seats (AIQ filled by DGHS): 50% seats surrendered by Government Medical Colleges run as per the approval of MCI are filled through the counselling conducted by DGHS and are known as All India Quota seats.
- Central Institutions / Universities (Filled by DGHS)
- Seats in Deemed Universities (Filled by DGHS)

3. DETAILS OF APPLICATION FEE

Payment of Application Fee is mandatory. Application Fee once paid is non-refundable. Applications without application fee will be deemed to be incomplete and will be summarily rejected. The candidate will be able to give his / her course preference only after payment of the Application Fee.

4. MODE OF APPLICATION

Application must be submitted ONLINE ONLY through the website www.centacpuducherry.in .	Physical applications will not be accepted.
A candidate can submit only ONE NEET PG - MEDICAL application.	If a duplicate application is found, both the applications will be rejected and his / her candidature will be cancelled.
Candidate should ensure that all information entered during the online registration process is correct. Information provided by the candidate such as name of candidate, contact address, category, educational qualification, marks, date of birth, etc., will be treated as correct. The CENTAC will not entertain any request for change after the Last Date for submitting applications.	Entering of false information by the candidate will result in rejection of the application.
The candidate will be able to make necessary updates even after the publication of the First List (Draft Merit List) and Second List (Revised Draft Merit List), but before publication of Third List (Final Merit List).	The CENTAC will not entertain any request for change in the information after publication of the Final Merit List.

a) Before filling the application, read the NEET PG – MEDICAL Information Brochure for the year 2025-26 available on the CENTAC website, carefully. Candidates are deemed to have read, agreed and accepted the process of counselling and the terms and conditions laid down by the CENTAC for the NEET PG - MEDICAL Counselling.

b) Mere submission of application does not confer any automatic right to secure a seat. The allotment of a seat is subject to fulfilling the merit, admission criteria, eligibility, and such criteria as may be prescribed by concerned regulatory bodies / affiliating University, NMC / MCC and the State / Central Government.

c) Candidates are advised to check the Tuition Fee structure on the CENTAC website and confirm any additional fees with the respective colleges, particularly Private Colleges, before submitting their course preferences. It is the responsibility of the candidate to verify the fee details in advance, as CENTAC will not be held accountable for any additional fee charged by the colleges and will not entertain requests or complaints in this matter. Candidates must ensure the accuracy of the fee information before filling up the course preferences. Course preferences once submitted by the candidate cannot be altered and no request for modification in course preference will be considered by CENTAC after the prescribed deadline.

d) Application for NEET PG - MEDICAL Counselling can only be submitted online through the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in. Application submitted through any other mode shall not be entertained.

- e) **Refer the CENTAC website for the opening and closing dates of ONLINE application.** CENTAC may reopen the ONLINE application, depending upon necessity.

5. MODE OF COMMUNICATION

- a) The candidate will be informed of all the rounds of counselling of CENTAC through SMS and the same will also be published on the CENTAC website through NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES. After the online application is opened, the candidate should refer to the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in, regularly.
- b) The candidate must ensure that the mobile numbers and e-mail address entered in the online application form are his / her own, as the CENTAC will send information / communication by SMS to the registered mobile numbers only, and if required, through the registered email address. Candidates are advised to check their SMS messages and emails REGULARLY. It is also advised that the candidate registers an alternate mobile number to which he / she has got access.
- c) No individual communication will be sent to any of the candidate regarding the counselling process, other than the SMS. **CENTAC will not be held responsible for non-receipt of information due to wrong mobile number / email address filled in the Online Application Form** or non-diligent follow up of NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES published on the CENTAC website or not checking the SMS / emails sent to the candidate.

7.1 Management Quota Seats in Private Medical Colleges

Management Quota seats for M.D. / M.S. courses in SMVMCH and PIMS will be available for counselling as AGE seats from Round 1 onwards.

7.2 Minority Management Quota Seats in Private Medical Colleges

- a) In Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3 Minority Management Quota seats for M.D. / M.S. in SVMCH&RC, Puducherry will be available for counselling for Residents of U.T. of Puducherry only.
- b) For Minority Management Quota seats in SVMCH&RI, candidates who are residents of the U.T. of Puducherry and belonging to **Telugu Linguistic Minority** alone are eligible.
- c) U.T. of Puducherry candidates claiming seats under **Telugu Minority Management Quota** should produce valid proof like Transfer Certificate (TC) to prove that his / her mother tongue is **TELUGU**. If mother tongue "TELUGU" is not mentioned in the Transfer Certificate attach certificate as per **Annexure - 7**.

8. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF CANDIDATES

8.1 NATIONALITY CRITERIA

- a) A candidate seeking admission for Government Quota, Other State Quota, Management Quota and Self-supporting Quota through CENTAC should be an Indian National. However, French Nationals residing in the U.T. of Puducherry and covered by the terms of the Treaty of Cession shall be treated on par with Indian Nationals, for the purpose of admission to all the courses.
- b) In terms of instructions of the Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India, Non-Resident Indians are entitled to all benefits available to Indian Nationals subject to such notifications that would be issued by the Government from time-to-time.

8.1.1 RESIDENCE CRITERIA

A) RESIDENTS OF THE U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY

(G.O. Ms. No. 64 dated 25th May 2006).

An applicant is considered to be a Puducherry Resident if he / she is an Indian National and satisfies at least ONE of the following criteria:

1. The candidate or whose parent (either Mother or Father or Both) or Guardian (in case of children who have lost both parents) has been residing continuously in the U.T. of Puducherry for at least five years preceding the date of application.

(OR)

2. Those who have passed the SSLC / HSC or any other public examination and for that purpose had undergone academic studies continuously **for 5 successive classes immediately preceding the qualifying examination** (including the year of qualifying examination) in a recognized educational institution located in the U.T. of Puducherry and having their residence in the U.T. Puducherry for 5

years continuously during that period. **Mere stay in places such as residential hostel would not amount to residence.**

(OR)

3. Children of natives of the U.T. of Puducherry who have declared any place in the U.T. of Puducherry as their home town and so certified by their respective Heads of Office.

(OR)

4. a) Children whose parents are Central / State Government Servants / Defence Personnel / Central Paramilitary Forces / Employees of Public Sector Undertakings wholly or substantially owned either by the Central Government or by the Puducherry Administration posted and serving in U.T. of Puducherry for at least a minimum continuous period of **three** years immediately prior to the last date of submission of application.

(AND)

b) Children of the above said employees should have studied HSC of two years in any of the schools in the U.T. of Puducherry and should have passed the qualifying examinations (HSC) from the same school. {G.O. Ms. No. 04, Puducherry dated 09.02.2016 of the Chief Secretariat (Hr. & Tech. Edn.)}, Puducherry.

(OR)

5. Children of Defence Personnel who were killed or disabled in action and children of Central Government Servants / U.T. of Puducherry Government Servants / Defence Personnel / Employees of Public Sector Undertakings wholly or substantially run either by the Central Government or by the U.T. of Puducherry Administration who died while in service in the U.T. of Puducherry.

(OR)

6. French Nationals residing in the U.T. of Puducherry and covered by the terms of the “Treaty of Cession” shall be treated on par with the candidates who produce the prescribed U.T. of Puducherry Residence Certificate. Such French Nationals will not be required to produce Residence Certificate; instead, they should produce a “Certificate of Registration” issued for this purpose by the French Consulate at Puducherry. Children of these French Nationals shall not be considered for admission under the Non-Resident quota.

B) OTHER STATES

"Other States" refers to students who are Indian Nationals and not Residents of the Union Territory of Puducherry.

8.1.2 DUAL NATIVITY CLAIM

Candidates seeking admission to NEET-based Undergraduate (UG) or Postgraduate (PG) Medical and Dental courses through CENTAC are required to submit a sworn affidavit. This affidavit, to be signed by the candidate's parent or guardian, must affirm that the candidate has not availed or

claimed the benefit of residence for admission under the State Quota in any State or Union Territory (UT) other than the Union Territory of Puducherry.

Certain States extend the benefit of reservation under the Government Quota to students who, while not residents of that State, qualify as natives or persons of origin from the State. The Union Territory of Puducherry permits admission under its Government Quota to such candidates, provided they have not opted for or claimed Government Quota seats in any other State or U.T.

Accordingly, a candidate who satisfies the residence or native eligibility criteria in both the Union Territory of Puducherry and any other State / U.T. must exercise a choice. Such candidates are entitled to seek Government Quota admission either in the U.T. of Puducherry or in the other State / U.T. where they hold eligibility, but not in both.

This scenario, wherein a candidate qualifies as a resident or native of more than one State or U.T. in India, typically due to birth, prolonged residence, or ancestral origin, is referred to as “**dual nativity.**” Candidates possessing dual nativity who have opted for Government Quota admission in any State or U.T. other than the U.T. of Puducherry is precluded from applying to Government Quota seats in the U.T. of Puducherry.

Consequences of Dual Nativity:

Candidates who are found to possess dual nativity and who have applied for Government Quota seats in a State or Union Territory (U.T.) in addition to the Union Territory of Puducherry will be, in violation of the stipulated guidelines, shall face consequences, such as cancellation of admission and potential legal action. The candidate would be liable to face the following repercussions: -

- **Cancellation of Admission:** Any admission secured on the basis of misrepresented nativity status will be deemed invalid and cancelled forthwith.
- **Legal Action:** Candidates shall face legal proceedings, including potential criminal charges, for willful misrepresentation or submission of false information.
- **Disqualification:** Such candidates will be debarred from participating in the ongoing and future counselling processes conducted by CENTAC.

Preventive Measures Against Dual Nativity

To avoid disqualification and related consequences, candidates are advised to strictly adhere to the following preventive measures:

- **Exclusive Application:** Apply for Government Quota seats *only in one* jurisdiction—either in the Union Territory of Puducherry or in any other State / U.T. where the candidate qualifies under the respective nativity / residency policy.
- **Authentic Documentation:** Submit only genuine and verifiable documents in support of nativity and residency claims.
- **Honest Disclosure:** Ensure that all information provided, particularly related to nativity, is accurate, current, and free from discrepancies.

- Continuous Monitoring: Regularly check official notifications, updates, and clarifications issued by CENTAC or other relevant admission authorities.

Importance of Accuracy:

Candidates must ensure their nativity claims are accurate to avoid jeopardizing their admission prospects and facing legal consequences

Instructions to Candidate: Candidates should submit an Affidavit for Claiming Residence of U.T. of Puducherry as per **Annexure 2**. The Affidavit should be submitted by the Parent / Guardian of the candidate claiming residence of U.T. of Puducherry. The Affidavit should be typed in Rs.20 /- e-Stamp paper, duly attested by the Executive Magistrate / Notary Public and addressed to The Convenor, CENTAC.

1. Out of 50% Unreserved seats, 10% EWS seats reservation will be applicable only in such institutions that have met the criteria of increase of seats.
2. Reservation under All India Category and Other State Quota will be subject to regulations / guidelines prescribed by the respective authority of the college / institution.

3. Residence / Special allocation once claimed in the application will not be changed under any circumstance.
4. All the claims for Residence / Special allocation should be made in the proper format and should be signed by the specified competent authorities.

10. RESERVATION ALGORITHM FOR GOVERNMENT QUOTA SEATS

10.1 MODE OF RESERVATION

The Mode of Reservation while allotting the seats will be as follows:

- All the candidates should be Indian Nationals and Residents of Puducherry.
- **Vertical Reservation** on Regional basis will be made in the first instance (UR, EWS, OBC, MBC, EBC, BCM, SC, ST, BT) as per the Seat Matrix.
- **Horizontal Reservation** (FF/ ESM / PwD / MSP) will be done if adequate seats are not filled after fixing vertical and regional reservation, i.e., if the requisite seats are not filled while doing vertical reservation, the last candidates in the respective categories will be replaced as per merit.

An Example for Filling Horizontal Reservation:

If 5 seats need to be filled under the Persons with Disabilities (PwD) quota, and if 4 PwD candidates are already accommodated in the Vertical Reservation as per merit, then only 1 PwD candidate will be accommodated into the list by replacing the last candidate as per reservation. If the 5th PwD candidate belongs to the BCM category, then the last candidate in the BCM category will be replaced by this candidate.

10.2 CONVERSION OF SEATS

10.2.1 Conversion of Minority Management Quota Seats

- a) In Round 1 and Round 2, the Minority Management Quota seats in SVMCH&RC (M.D. / M.S. – MQT) will be available only for Residents of U.T. of Puducherry candidates who are in the Telugu Minority Merit List. Accordingly, the course preferences will be enabled for the Minority candidates only.
- b) In Round 3, after exhausting the entire Telugu Minority Merit List of candidates, the unfilled Minority Management Quota seats will be converted to All India Management Quota Seats in Round 3 itself. Hence, both the Minority Management Quota course preferences (MQT) and All India Management Quota course preferences (MQ) in SVMCH&RC will be enabled.

10.3 De-RESERVATION OF SEATS

With respect to Government Quota seats, if any seat in the RESERVED category (OBC / MBC / EBC / BCM / SC / ST / BT) remains vacant, the same will be de-reserved and converted into the UNRESERVED category as per the **Seats Conversion Algorithm** in **Annexure – 10** and offered for counselling in Round 3.

10.4 CRITERIA FOR RESERVATION

10.4.1 U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY - VERTICAL RESERVATION

1) Unreserved (UR)

The seats under the UNRESERVED (UR) category are open to candidates irrespective of their caste or category status. Further, all SC / ST / BT / EBC / MBC / BCM / OBC candidates are also eligible for selection under the Unreserved (UR) category in addition to the reservations made to them.

2) Other Backward Classes (OBC), Most Backward Classes (MBC), Extreme Backward Classes (EBC), Backward Classes Muslims (BCM) and Backward Tribes (BT)

Candidates claiming admission under these categories should enclose OBC / MBC / EBC / BCM / BT certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

3) Scheduled Castes (SC)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as Scheduled Caste under “**The Constitution (Pondicherry) Scheduled Castes Order 1964**” dated 05.03.1964, read with “The Constitution (Scheduled Caste) orders (Second Amendment) Act 2002 (Central Act 61 of 2002) and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

4) Scheduled Tribes (ST)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as Scheduled Tribe under “**The Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Tribes Order, 2016**” dated 22.12.2016 and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

10.4.2 U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY - HORIZONTAL RESERVATION

1) Freedom Fighter (FF)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should be Children / Grand Children of Freedom Fighters and they should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Officer-in-charge, Freedom Fighters Cell, Government of Puducherry.

2) Wards of Ex-servicemen (ESM)

Those who are registered as Ex-servicemen in the Department of Sainik Welfare (DSW), Government of Puducherry and have got an Ex-servicemen / Widow of Ex-servicemen identity card from the DSW should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Director, DSW, Puducherry.

3) Persons with Disabilities (PwD)

NATIONAL MEDICAL COMMISSION NOTIFICATION, New Delhi, the 29th December, 2023

F. No. CDN-19012/5/2023-Coord-NMC:

- a) The “Certificate of Disability” shall be issued in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities on 15th June 2017).
- b) The extent of “specified disability” in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016) notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on 4th January 2018.
- c) The minimum degree of disability should be 40% (Benchmark Disability) in order to be eligible for availing reservation for persons with specified disability. (As per MCI Gazette Notification No. MCI-18(1)/2018-Med./187262 dated 5th Feb, 2019/14th May, 2019).

Further: Candidates seeking admission to PG Medical courses under this category will be required to undergo a second medical examination by a Medical Board constituted for the purpose by the Directorate of Health and Family Welfare Services, Government of Puducherry, to ascertain and confirm the nature and extent of the physical disability. The decision of the Directorate of Health and Family Welfare Services, Government of Puducherry, in this regard, will be final.

4) Meritorious Sports Person Category (MSP)

- The highest achievement of the candidates in only one annual tournament under the listed sports disciplines in a year will be considered for awarding marks. The List of Sports Disciplines Eligible for Sports Quota is given in **Annexure 9**.
- Selection of candidates will be based on the marks obtained by the candidates following the guidelines given by the Government of Puducherry vide G.O. Ms.53 dated 24th May 2012 and G.O. Ms. No. 6 dated 14th March 2018 of the Chief Secretariat (Higher & Technical Education), Puducherry.

General Conditions for Sports Quota:

- a) Candidates seeking admission under the category of Sports Person, should enclose attested photocopies of participation certificates and the certificate in the prescribed forms issued by the relevant sports authorities.
- b) The participation / achievements of candidates who represented the U. T. of Puducherry alone are eligible for marks under the National Category. Only Union Territory of Puducherry candidates are eligible to apply for admission under Sports Quota.
- c) Participation / Achievements in sports / games, immediately preceding **five** years to the year for which admission is sought will be taken into account. National / State Level Championships / Tournaments conducted by Organizations / Federations recognized by the Indian Olympic Association / Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, New Delhi, alone will be considered for award of marks (Recognition by the Indian Olympic Association / Ministry of Youth and Sports, New Delhi, should be relevant to the years concerned). Open / Invitational Tournaments of any kind will not be considered.
- d) For Tennis Achievements of Top 3 players by his / her position in the ranking list published by AITA based on the ranking rules and the final rankings of the previous 4 years will be awarded marks for achievements and participation (Necessary forms from Associations are to be enclosed).
- e) For Cricket, the Annual Official Championship / Tournaments conducted within the country under the auspices of the BCCI at the District / State National Level alone will be taken into consideration for that year.
- f) All the achievement certificates are to be supported necessarily by the relevant participation certificates and appropriate forms / certificates. The relevant attested copies of the certificates issued by the appropriate authorities as detailed in the G.O Ms.53 dt.24.05.2012 are to be submitted along with the application.
- g) No further enclosures of certificates will be entertained after the last date for submission of the completed application.
- h) A candidate can utilize the sports quota only once for these admissions.
- i) A committee will be constituted to scrutinize the applications received under this category and will rank the candidates based on the marks assigned to the certificate enclosed along with the application, and the sports merit list will be published on the CENTAC website.

NOTE: SUBMISSION OF SPORTS CERTIFICATES – To be submitted as self-attested xerox copies at the designated center in the respective regions. Information in this regard will be published in the CENTAC website.

SECTION – III: FILLING UP OF APPLICATION

11. STEPS FOR FILLING UP THE APPLICATION

All the candidates seeking admission to the PG Medical courses are required to apply online on the website www.centacpuducherry.in. Candidates are advised to read and familiarize themselves with all the foregoing information pertaining to PG Medical counselling 2025-2026 before filling in the application.

Filling up of Application comprises the following:

1. Registration for First Time Users
2. Filling of Application (Personal Information → Academic Details → Attachments → Payment of Fees) should be completed and submitted before the last date for submission of application.
3. Filling of Course Preference (College → Courses) should be completed and submitted before the last date for submission of course preferences.

a) Registration for First Time User:

- On the “New Registration” page, the candidate has to enter a valid Mobile Number and email. The candidate should take utmost care in providing the Mobile Number and email ID.
- Candidate shall then create a new password (of maximum six characters) for online registration purpose.
- **Important:** An OTP (One Time Password) will be sent to the candidate's registered mobile number each time the candidate logs in to his / her dashboard.

b) Filling of Application:

- After successful registration, the applicant shall login using his / her “Registered email-id” and “Password” to fill details in the online application form.
- The candidate can change the details in the application form and uploaded files using the “Back Button” before making payment.
- The candidate can then proceed with “Make Payment” and complete application submission.
- CENTAC disclaims any liability that may arise to a candidate due to incorrect information provided by him / her in his / her online Application Form.

The candidate shall upload scanned copies of recently renewed self-attested documents obtained from the respective competent authorities (wherever necessary). Original certificates must be produced only at the time of admission in the respective colleges.

a) Candidates applying for Management Quota, should submit All India OBC / SC /

ST certificate, if applicable, **obtained on or after 1st January 2025.**

b) **OCI candidates** - OCI Card of the candidate (Only those holding OCI card granted before 04.03.2021)

REGISTRATION FEE

In addition to the Application Fee for NEET PG Courses, candidates need to pay the **Registration Fee as per Clause 13.1**, to participate in counselling for ROUND 2, ROUND 3 and STRAY ROUND. The candidate should transfer the Registration Fee as per instructions for each round, into the CENTAC account through the Mode of Payment given in Clause 13.3 using dashboard login credentials. Read the HELP Instructions in the dashboard carefully before proceeding for payment. Only those candidates who pay the Registration Fee / Tuition Fee will be considered for the respective rounds of counselling.

13.2 TUITION FEE

The Tuition Fee as prescribed by the “Fee Committee”, vide order No. 225 / H5 / Health-II / 2024-2025, of the Government of Puducherry, Chief Secretariat (Health), for the year 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 is available on the CENTAC website. Candidates are advised to go through the details of Tuition Fee. Candidates should pay the prescribed TUITION FEE to CENTAC using the payment link in their login dashboard.

13.3 MODE OF PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEE / TUITION FEE

Payment of Registration Fee / Tuition Fee is ONLINE ONLY. The following modes of payment will be available to candidates:

1. NEFT / RTGS by generating challan from the candidate’s dashboard
2. Net Banking
3. Debit Card
4. Credit Card
5. UPI (Unified Payment Interface)
6. BQR (Bharat Quick Response)

14. CONDITIONS FOR FORFEITURE

- a) If a candidate who has been allotted a seat in Round 2 or subsequent rounds does not join the allotted seat, the amount liable for forfeiture as mentioned in Clause 13.1 will be forfeited.
- b) The amount liable for forfeiture will also be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason. Eg: If candidate gives wrong information at the time of application on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission.

14.1 Forfeiture in Round 2:

A candidate who does not join the seat allotted in Round 2 (Transfer or Fresh) shall forfeit the amount applicable for Round 2 as specified in Clause 13.1.

A candidate who has joined in Round 1 or Round 2 and resigns before Round 3 registration, shall forfeit the amount applicable for Round 2 as specified in Clause 13.1.

14.2 Forfeiture in Round 3:

A candidate who does not join the seat allotted in Round 3 (Transfer or Fresh) shall forfeit the amount applicable for Round 3 as specified in Clause 13.1.

14.3 Forfeiture in Stray Round:

A candidate who does not join the seat allotted in the Stray Round shall forfeit the amount specified for the Stray Round in Clause 13.1. In addition:

- The candidate will be debarred from participating in any further rounds of counselling in the same year as well as in the following year.
- The candidate will also be barred from appearing in the NEET PG examination in the subsequent year.

Note: Candidates are advised to exercise utmost care and consideration before submitting course preferences in all the rounds of counselling.

15. CONDITIONS FOR REFUND

- a) Refund will be initiated only after completion of the entire admission process. The refund process may take approximately three months to complete.
- b) Refund will be done to the same account of the candidate from which payment was made. The candidates should keep their bank accounts active until the refund process is completed. The candidates are advised NOT to use unrelated bank accounts for remitting Registration Fee / Tuition fee amount.

16. SUBMISSION OF COURSE PREFERENCES

- a) While filling the ONLINE application, after payment of Application Fee, the candidate will be allowed to enter course preferences. The list of colleges and courses for admission is available in Part II of the NEET PG - MEDICAL Information Brochure.

b) Steps for Filling Course Preferences:

- **First** - Choose the colleges.
- **Second** – Select courses available under each college. The candidate should arrange the courses according to his / her priority for allotment.

Filling of Course Preference (College → Course) should be completed and submitted before the specified last date.

c) Candidates are advised to give as many choices of courses for which he / she is eligible. If choices of courses are not made, it will be deemed that he / she is not interested in those particular courses / colleges. **The candidate should give his / her prioritization of course preferences, as allotment will be done based on the order of the courses given by the candidate.**

d) WITHOUT COURSE PREFERENCES, no course will be allotted to the candidate. It is therefore, the responsibility of the candidate to submit his / her course preference to remain in the counselling process. The candidate will not be permitted to edit his / her course preference after the last date for submission of course preferences for each round. Course preferences once given are final.

e) The allotment of seats will be made based on the course preferences submitted by the candidate and subject to the availability of seats, as per merit and reservation. Candidates are advised to refer to the Seat Matrix for details about the various courses, number of seats, reservations, etc.

f) Candidates are advised to confirm the Tuition Fee structure from the CENTAC website, **and any other additional fee from the colleges, especially the Private Colleges before filling up the course preferences.**

g) **Entry of Course Preferences for Subsequent Rounds of Counselling** - Candidates willing to participate in subsequent rounds of counselling are required to enter new course preferences for each round. The course preference given in the previous round will be null and void.

17. VERIFICATION STATUS OF APPLICATION

17.1 Verification of Academic Claims

The academic credentials of the candidate will be verified for correctness of name and date of birth entered by the candidate. The candidate's NEET PG - 2025 score card details will also be verified against the details entered by the candidate in his / her CENTAC application. The candidate should upload only the NEET PG – 2025 score card.

17.2 Verification of Residence / Community / Special Category Claims

a) All certificates submitted in support of Residence, Community and Special Category claims should be obtained **ON or AFTER 1st January 2025.**

b) The certificates submitted by the candidates will be verified, and the verification status will be updated in the candidate's dashboard along with appropriate remarks indicating any documents that need to be submitted or re-submitted further to rectify deficiencies in the application

c) The verification status of candidates whose certificates are found correct in all respects shall be displayed as 'SUCCESS' in the candidate's dashboard. Candidates with a 'SUCCESS' status will be deemed 'Eligible' and included in the Final Merit List.

d) However, if any deficiency is found with regard to certificates furnished by a candidate, the verification status shall be displayed as 'FAILED' in the candidate's dashboard. Candidates with a '**FAILED**' verification status shall not be included in the Merit List. However, such candidates shall be provided adequate time, after the publication of the Draft Merit List and the Revised Draft Merit List, to submit renewed or corrected certificates in order to rectify the deficiencies, if any, in the certificates submitted.

e) In case, a candidate fails to submit the renewed certificates within the specified time frame, he / she shall be deemed '**Not Eligible**' and will not be included in the Final Merit List. Candidates not listed in the **FINAL MERIT LIST** will not be allotted any course, irrespective of the course preferences filled. The Application Fee of such candidates will not be refunded.

f) It is the responsibility of the candidate to furnish all required documents within the timelines specified by CENTAC. Any late claims relating to non-receipt or delayed receipt of documents from the concerned authorities shall not be entertained once the FINAL MERIT LIST has been published. No additions or deletions shall be made to the FINAL MERIT LIST once published.

SECTION – IV – COUNSELLING PROCESS

18. MERIT LIST

a) The Merit List of the CENTAC applied candidates will be prepared based on the NEET – PG - 2025 Rank. The cut-off marks for the different categories fixed by the MCC / MoHFW only will be considered.

The following Merit Lists will be published for allotment:

1. Government Quota
2. Management Quota
3. Telugu Minority Management Quota

Candidates should refer to the CENTAC website www.centaipuducherry.in for the merit lists of all the categories of seats.

b) Upon verification of the candidate's credentials, the First List, termed as the **Draft Merit List**, will be published. This shall be followed by the Second List, referred to as the **Revised Draft Merit List**, and subsequently the Final List, termed as the **Final Merit List**. Adequate time shall be provided between each publication of Merit Lists, for candidates to raise objections and to submit the requisite documents, if any. Claims relating to Residence, Community, or Special Category on verification of the submitted documents, shall not be altered once the **FINAL MERIT LIST** is published.

LOWERING OF CUT-OFF

In case, the cut-off marks for NEET PG - 2025 is lowered by the MCC / MoHFW, then fresh applications will be invited.

19. NUMBER OF ROUNDS OF ONLINE COUNSELLING

Counselling will be done as per the guidelines received from the MCC. Allotment to M.D. / M.S. is based on the NEET PG – 2025 Rank. There are FOUR Rounds of ONLINE counselling:

1. Round 1
2. Round 2
3. Round 3
4. Stray Round

Each round of counselling is a separate round and the rules of each round are different. Once any round commences, the rules of that round will apply to all the candidates even if they were allotted / admitted in the previous round(s) of counselling.

19.1 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE COUNSELLING

- The counselling schedule for each Round will be available in the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in
- Allotment will be done through online (computer-based) counselling based on merit and rule of reservation.
- Each candidate will be allotted only one seat in each round.
- Sliding will be allowed in Round 2 and Round 3 only.
- For a candidate who opts for sliding in Round 2 or Round 3 and is allotted a new seat, the earlier admitted seat will be automatically cancelled. Under no circumstances will he / she be permitted to retain the earlier admitted seat of the previous round.
- If a candidate fails to join the allotted / admitted seat (Fresh / Transfer) within the stipulated time, the seat will be automatically cancelled.
- Mutual transfer / Individual request for transfer of college will NOT be permitted under any circumstances.
- Provisionally selected candidates can download the Provisional Allotment Order and proceed for admission to the college allotted.
- **Conversion of Seats** – Conversion of Telugu Minority Quota Management seats in SVMCH&RI into All India General Management Quota seats will be done in Round 3 only.
- **De-reservation** - De-reservation of vacant seats will be done in Round 3 only.

19.2 COUNSELLING PROCESS FOR EACH ROUND

- Publishing of Seat Matrix / Actual Vacancy.
- Submitting willingness to participate in the Round.
- Paying Registration Fee for Round 2, Round 3 and Stray Round as per Clause 13.1.
- Submitting Fresh Course Preferences for Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 and Stray Round.
Course Preferences given in the previous Rounds will be null & void.
- Publishing Allotment List
- Downloading of Allotment Order
- Paying balance Tuition Fee to CENTAC, if any.
- Physical reporting to the allotted college for certificate verification and admission.

Options Available to Allotted / Not Allotted Candidates:

Case 1: Candidate is allotted a course. He / She joins the allotted course and college.

Case 2: Candidate is allotted a course. He / She does not join the allotted course and college.

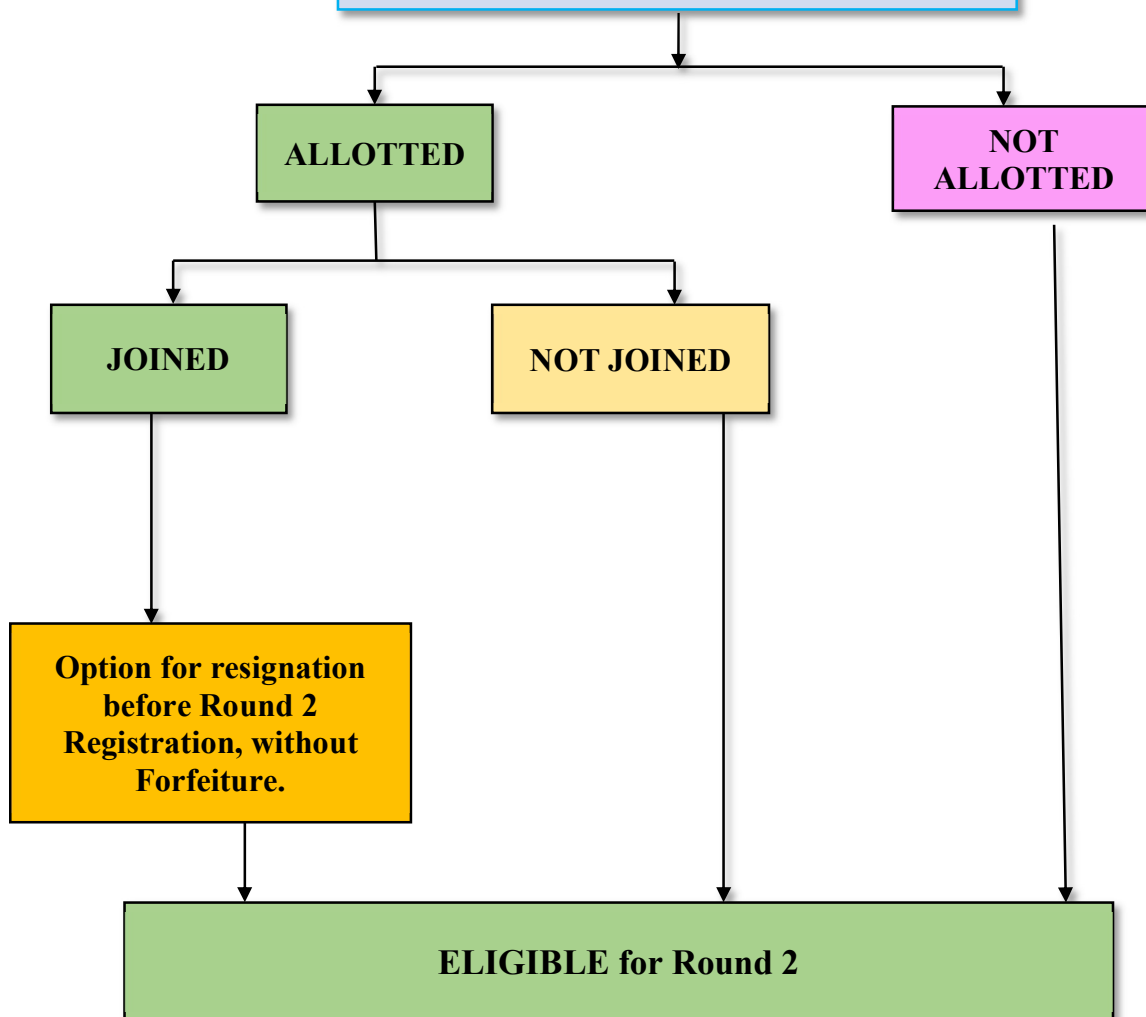

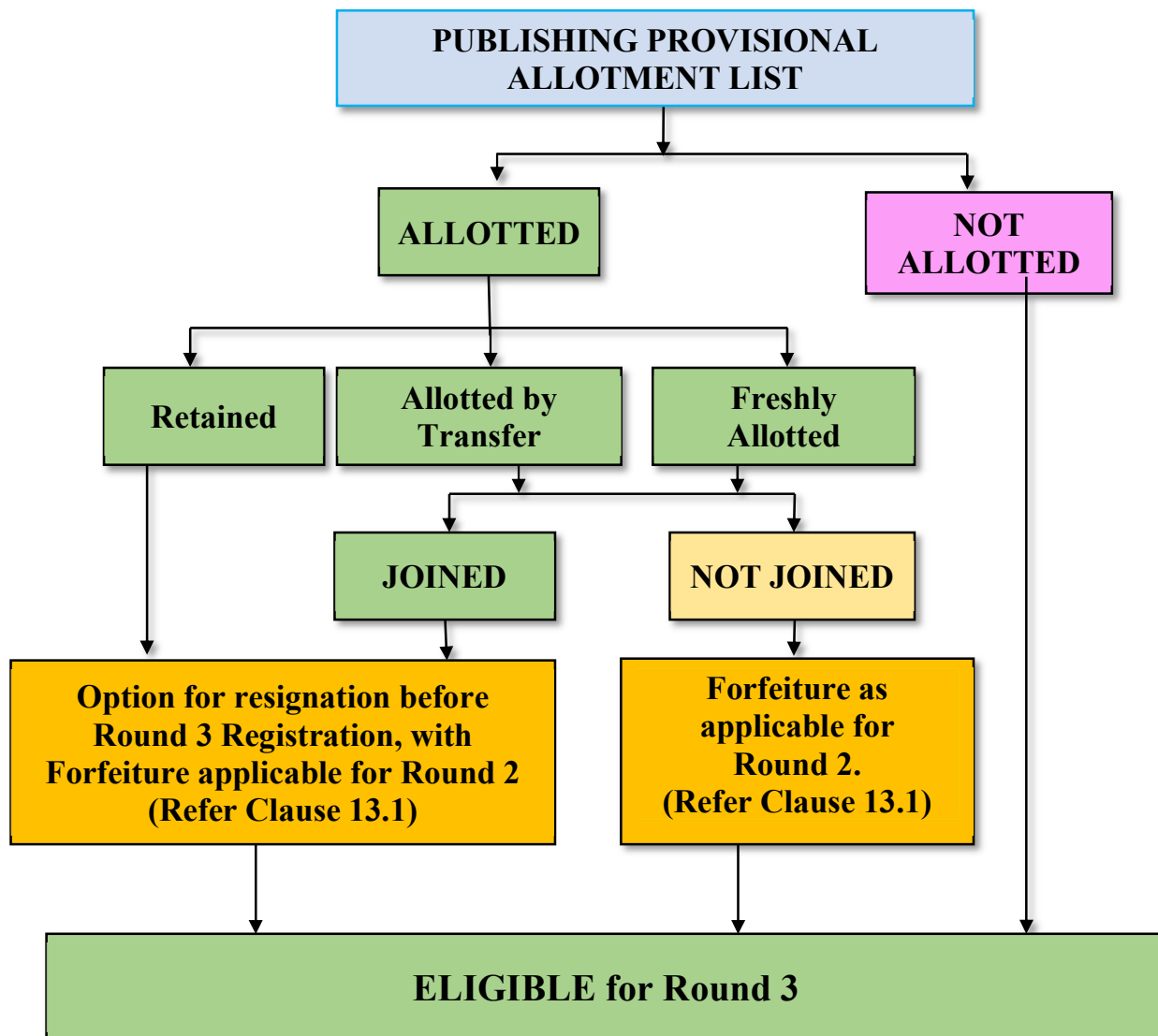

ROUND 2 - ONLINE COUNSELLING PROCESS

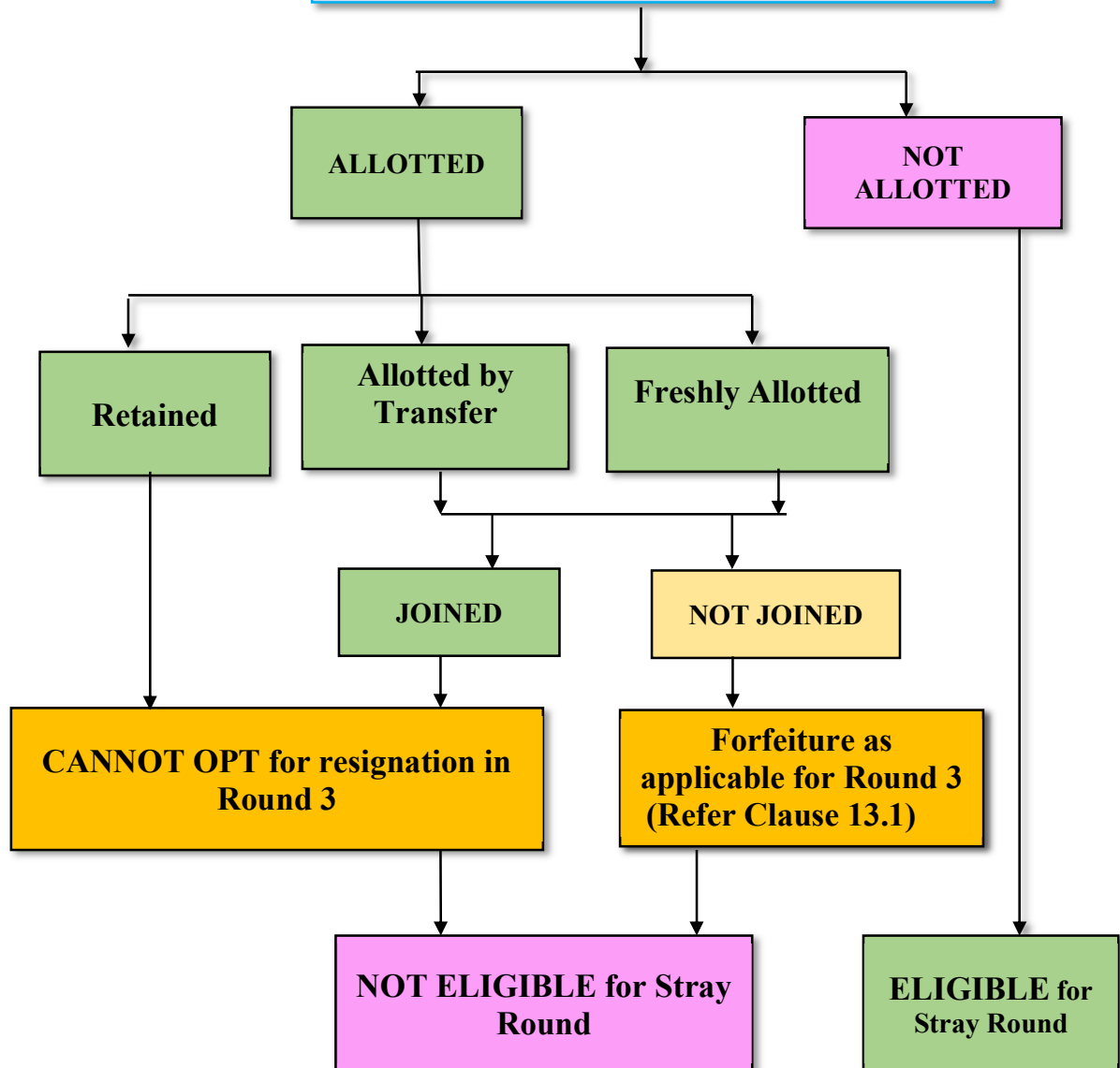

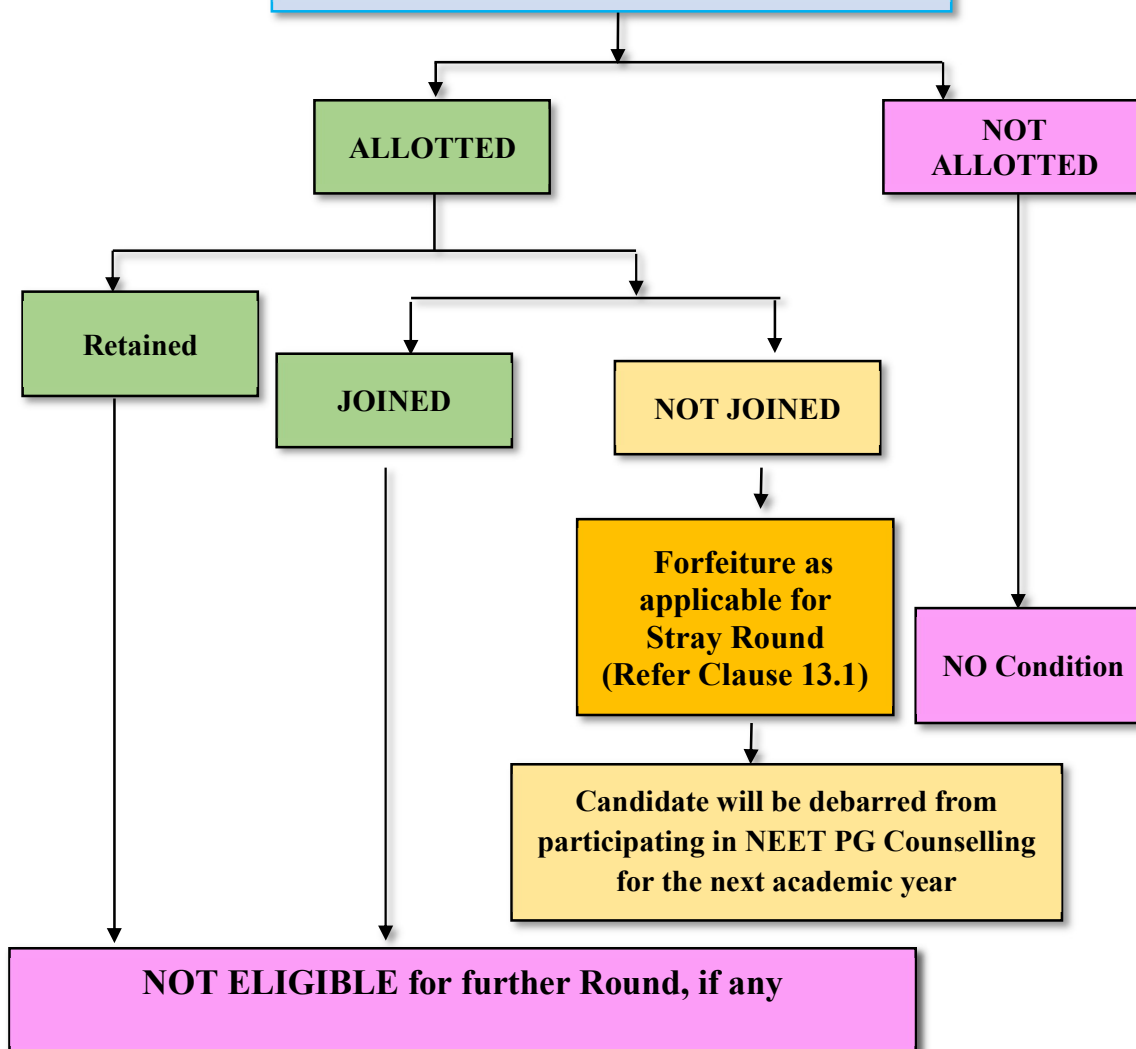

19.3 ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN ONLINE COUNSELLING

19.3.1 ROUND-1

- a) All NEET – PG -2025 qualified candidates who have applied to CENTAC.

19.3.2 ROUND-2

- a) **Not Allotted Candidates** – Candidates who were not allotted any seat in Round 1.
- b) **Joined Candidates** - Those who were admitted in Round 1 and want sliding in Round 2.
- c) **Not Joined Candidates** - Candidates who did not join the Round 1 allotted seat and have opted for free exit and want to participate in Round 2.
- d) **Not Participated Candidates** – CENTAC applied candidates who did not participate in Round 1 and want to participate in Round 2.

19.3.3 ROUND-3

- a) **Not Allotted Candidates** – Candidates who were not allotted any seat in Round 1 and Round 2.
- b) **Joined Candidates**
- Those who were admitted in Round 1 or Round 2 and want sliding in Round 3.
 - Those who were admitted in Round 1; but did not participate in Round 2 and want sliding in Round 3.
 - Candidates who resigned from the admitted seat of Round 1 or Round 2 with forfeiture, before the commencement of Round 3.
- c) **Not Joined Candidates** – Those who did not join the Round 1 or Round 2 allotted seat and want to participate in Round 3.
- d) **Not Participated Candidates** – CENTAC applied candidates who did not participate in Round 1 and Round 2 and want to participate in Round 3.

19.3.4 STRAY ROUND

NOTE: The seats that remain vacant after Round 3 will be filled ONLINE in the Stray Round. Sliding will not be allowed from Round 1 or Round 2 or Round 3 to the Stray Round.

ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE

- a) **Not Allotted Candidates** - Candidates not allotted any seat in Round 1 or Round 2 or Round 3.
- b) **Not Joined Candidates** – Those who did not join the Round 1 or Round 2 allotted seat and want to participate in the Stray Round.
- c) **Resigned Candidates**- Candidate who has resigned from the Round 1 or Round 2 **admitted** seat.
- d) **Not Participated Candidates** – CENTAC applied candidates who did not participate in Round 1 or Round 2 or Round 3 and who were not allotted any seat in MCC or any other State Counselling Authority and want to participate in the Stray Round.

NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE

a) Allotted Candidates – Candidates who were allotted a seat in Round 3 in CENTAC are NOT ELIGIBLE to participate.

b) Joined Candidates – All candidates who have joined in M.D. / M.S. in Round 1 or Round 2 or Round 3 of CENTAC or All India MCC Counselling or any other State / U.T. Counselling Authority are NOT ELIGIBLE to participate.

SUBMISSION OF UNDERTAKING FOR STRAY ROUND: Candidates must submit an undertaking that they are not holding any M.D. / M.S. seats allotted through CENTAC or All India MCC Counselling or any other State / U.T. Counselling Authority as per **Annexure 8**.

19.4 RESIGNING FROM ADMITTED SEAT

Case 1: Resigning Before Round 2 Registration:

A candidate admitted in Round 1 can resign from the seat before Round 2 registration without forfeiture.

Case 2: Resigning Before Round 3 Registration:

A candidate admitted in Round 1 or Round 2 can resign from the seat before Round 3 registration after which time, the candidate will not be allowed to vacate the admitted seat.

LETTER FOR SEAT RESIGNATION:

a) A candidate who wants to resign his / her admitted seat as per Case 1 and Case 2, should submit his / her request for resignation in the Online Mode only. The format of the Letter for Resignation is available in **Annexure 11**. After due approval from the Counselling Authority, the Letter of Resignation should be countersigned by the Coordinator / Convenor. The same should be submitted to the concerned college after which the candidate can collect the “No Objection Certificate (NOC)” from the concerned college.

Candidate should also upload the countersigned Letter of Resignation through the link available in the candidate’s dashboard.

b) No college has the authority to permit the resignation of the candidate and issue “No Objection Certificate (NOC)”. Only the counselling authority CENTAC, after due permission from the competent authority can permit the resignation of the candidate.

20. PROVISIONAL ALLOTMENT

Upon completion of the allotment process, the Provisional Allotment List will be published on the CENTAC website. All seat allotments are provisional in nature. CENTAC reserves the right to withdraw any allotment at any stage if it is found that the candidate does not fulfill the eligibility criteria or other regulations prescribed by the competent authority from time to time.

“Eligibility, admissions, and allotments made to and by the colleges shall be subject to the approval of the regulatory bodies, such as NMC / MCC / Pondicherry University / Apex Bodies, etc. CENTAC and the Government of Puducherry reserve the right to conduct verification, at any stage, into the originality and authenticity of the certificates submitted by any candidate in support of his / her qualifying or eligibility claims. If, upon such verification, it is found that a candidate has produced fake or fraudulent certificates, or has obtained certificates by suppressing facts, he / she shall be liable to criminal prosecution, immediate cancellation of the allotted seat without notice, forfeiture of all fees paid, and imposition of penalty as prescribed by the competent authority. Further, such candidates may be debarred from all future examinations and counselling processes, and the concerned authorities may also recommend blacklisting to the NMC / MCC / Pondicherry University / Apex Bodies, as well as cancellation of medical license.”

21. JOINING THE COLLEGE

Once the Provisional Allotment is done, the candidate must download the **Provisional Allotment Order** and report to the allotted college within the specified time. If the candidate does not report within the given time, the provisional allotment will be automatically cancelled. The similar procedure will be followed for all the rounds of counselling.

The candidate is required to submit a printout of the CENTAC Application Form, Provisional Allotment Letter and Original Certificates along with self-attested photocopies of all the required documents at the time of admission with the prescribed fee for payment.

Important Note to Candidates:

- a) If CENTAC / College or other Authorities find that admission has been offered based on NOT fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements / false or incorrect information / documents and suppression of relevant fact, education qualification or quota, the allotment / admission offered will be summarily cancelled, irrespective of the stage of study of that course and the fees paid shall not be refunded in any case. Further, legal proceedings will also be initiated against such candidates for such actions. Hence, candidates are warned against indulging in such practices, in their own interest.
- b) The original documents (except Transfer Certificate) submitted by the candidates to be admitted in the respective colleges will be returned only after obtaining recognition from the respective

affiliating bodies, and hence, the candidates are advised to take enough numbers of photo copies of the documents before submitting the originals for verification.

22. SAVING CLAUSE

- a. CENTAC reserves the right to issue additional guidelines, or modify or delete the guidelines already issued as may be necessary from time to time.
- b. The Chairman, CENTAC shall be the final authority to settle disputes, if any, that may arise.

23. STIPEND TO PG (CLINICAL AND NON-CLINICAL) STUDENTS

Disbursement of Stipend to PG (Clinical and Non-Clinical) students by the Private Medical Colleges in the U.T. of Puducherry will be on par with the Indira Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Puducherry as per National Medical Commission (NMC) norms (Refer G.O.Ms. No.28, dated 21.06.2024 of the Chief Secretariat (Health), Puducherry).

c) Should have completed one year of internship on or before 31st July 2025.

and

d) Must obtain a minimum required score in **NEET PG - 2025**, as prescribed by the regulatory authorities, such as the National Board of Examination (NBE), National Medical Commission (NMC), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, etc. as the case may be.

26.2. FOREIGN MEDICAL GRADUATES: Candidates who have completed their MBBS from a country outside India:

a) Indian citizens or Overseas Citizens of India who have obtained their Primary Medical Qualifications from Medical Colleges outside India should have qualified the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) as per Screening Test Regulations, 2002 which is conducted by National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences

and

b) Further, they should have been registered with the NMC / the erstwhile Medical Council of India or State Medical Council.

and

c) Should have completed their internship on or before 31st July 2025.

and

d) Must obtain a minimum required score in **NEET PG - 2025**, as prescribed by the regulatory authorities, such as the National Board of Examination (NBE), National Medical Commission (NMC), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, etc. as the case may be.

NOT ELIGIBLE (Refer NBE Website)

a) A candidate who does not join the seat allotted to them in the Stray Vacancy Round will be debarred from participating in NEET-PG Counselling for the next academic year i.e., 2026. Also, their security deposit will be forfeited.

b) A candidate who is undergoing a PG Degree course is not eligible to apply for any other PG Degree course parallelly.

c) A candidate with a PG Degree is not eligible to apply for admission to any other PG Degree Course. However, a candidate who is a Diploma holder is eligible to apply for a PG Degree Course.
