Offline Mop-up round – PG Medical / PG Dental – 2022 (non-inservice)

For admission to PG Medical / Dental courses Offline Mop-up round will be conducted for eligible non-inservice candidates. As per the directions of the Government, after allotment of seats to in-service candidates in the second round, the unfilled in-service seats and other unfilled seats if any, have already been de-categorised as per roster system & Government norms and allotted to the eligible non-inservice candidates in the second round seat allotment itself.

After completion of the second round seat allotment, the seats which remained unfilled and seats cancelled by the candidates after second round is hosted on the KEA Website for the information of the candidates. The seats which may get cancelled before mop-up round will also be considered for mop-up round. Candidates to keep visiting KEA Website for updates.

The following types of candidates only are eligible to participate in the mop-up round.

Candidates who have not joined the college after allotment of seats in the PG Medical / PG Dental first round or second round or not allotted seat in mop-up round of All India Counselling including Counselling for Deemed Universities (subject to conditions if any, stipulated by GOI), and candidates who have not been allotted any Clinical seat* in second round of state counselling.

*Candidates allotted pre or para-clinical seat will be allowed to participate in counseling for Clinical seats only. However, in case if they have already joined the allotted college, they will not be allowed to participate in the mop-up round.

The candidates who have newly registered (Lowered percentile) and completed the document verification process (Lowered percentile & earlier eligible candidates) will also be eligible to participate in the mop-up round.

Counseling will be stopped once the seats are exhausted. Candidates are advised to check the KEA Website with regard to seats availability / vacant seats and to know about the college-wise and course-wise fee structure in different colleges. The fees has to be paid in the form of Demand Draft, hence the candidates should come prepared with the demand draft for the corresponding fee amount to which they are intending to select. (Cheques / Cash payment will not be accepted; further NEFT / RTGS will not be allowed.)

Demand draft has to be drawn in favour of "The Executive Director, KEA" payable at Bangalore. Candidates can bring multiple demand drafts for different denominations according to their willingness for selection of available seat.

IMPORTANT: Candidates are hereby informed to take the Demand Draft well in advance by keeping in mind regarding Bank Holidays or Bank functioning days. Candidates will not be allowed to select the seats without the demand drafts for the required fees. Online payment or Cheques or Cash payment is not allowed.

Eligible candidates and interested in participating in the mop-up round, download the entry pass for mop-up round and must produce the same at the venue on the day of mop-up counselling along with demand draft and all original documents.

The candidate's photo will be printed on the entry pass; the candidates have to be present personally for counselling process; Representative of the candidate will not be allowed on behalf of the candidate for the Mop-up round, under any circumstances.

Mop-up round may extend into late hours of the day. Candidates must come prepared; they may carry some food and medicines if required.

Documents to be brought for mop-up round

- a. PGET-2022 Application Printout, Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-7.
- b. Valid Identity Card with Photo.
- c. Entry Pass (Downloaded from KEA Website).
- d. Verification Slip (Pink).
- e. Yellow colour acknowledgement slip for having deposited the Original Documents at KEA.
- f. Demand Drafts-for different denomination. (Check the Website for fee structure)

 [One DD for "G" seat, another one for balance amount totaling to "P" seat, if interested DDs can be brought for NRI "N" seats or for "Q" Other seats if willing to select]
- g. Candidates have to appear as per the schedule according to PGNEET All India Rank.
