1. INTRODUCTION

BRIEF HISTORY:

The University was established at Faridkot under an Act of Punjab State Legislature (Punjab Act No. 18 of 1998) in the name of great Sufi Saint Sheikh Farid Ganj-E-Shakar, (1173 1265 A.D.) in 1998 for purposes of affiliating, teaching and ensuring proper and systematic instruction, training and research in Modern Systems of Medicine and Indian Systems of Medicine. It is not only affiliating and examining body but also a teaching and research centre in health sciences. It is expected to play a vital role in improving the standards of medical and health education in the state and in conducting relevant research in all aspects of health sciences, basic as well as applied, which ultimately will ameliorate the health standards of the people of Punjab. It is believed that the university will be a trend setter in developing appropriate modes and models of health care to ensure quality health care to the people.

The University has been recognized by MCI vide letter no. V/11015/3/2000-ME (UG) dated 9th June, 2000. The UGC has also included the University in the list of recognized universities maintained by the University Grants Commission, under section 2(1) of the UGC Act. 1956 vide letter no. F.9-3/97 (CPP-I) dated 4 July, 2002. The Regional Director, World Health Organization, Regional Office for South-East Asia, World Health House, New Delhi has also forwarded the name of the University for inclusion in the World Directory of Medical Schools vide letter No. M12/6212 dated 6 May 2002. The University is also included in the list of Commonwealth Universities and their yearbook 2001 at page No. 692 (Vol. I).

Established with a mission to create an intellectual, academic and physical environment conducive to free flow of ideas and exchange of information between various faculties of the university, between this university and other universities of health sciences in the country and abroad, thereby opening a window to the world for the health professionals, health planners, health managers, biomedical and social scientists and educationalists in health sciences of the country. Efforts are on to establish contact with various institutions towards achieving this goal.

UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:

New buildings of the University and its constituent college, GGS Medical College & Hospital were completed in the year 2011. The university was shifted to its new building situated at Sadiq Road, Faridkot in July 2011. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab inaugurated two new University buildings (Senate Block and Academic Block) on 22-09-2011. Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated the Radiotherapy Unit, and other buildings of GGS Medical College & Hospital, on 23-09-2011. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University is also shifted to its new building.

The University Campus comprises of GGS Medical College along with Auditorium of 800 capacity, Senate Block, Academic Block, University College of Nursing, University College of Physiotherapy, University Institute of Para-Medical Sciences, University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dept. of Nuclear Medicine, Telemedicine, Edusat and a well equipped state-of-the-art 500 bedded hospital, Drug De-addiction & Treatment Centre at Faridkot. The State Institute of Nursing and Para-Medical Sciences, Village – Badal (Muktsar), Institute of Nursing (University Regional Centre) at Shri Goindwal Sahib and Advanced Cancer Diagnostic Treatment & Research Centre and Drug De-Addiction & Treatment Centre at Bathinda are also run by University.

Coveted projects to set up Trauma Centre, Regional Cancer Centre are in process. The University has added to its academic convoy University Library & Informatics Division, Department of Health Sciences Library & Information System, University Centre of Excellence in Research, Rose Garden and Herbal Garden.

The university has started number of employment-oriented diploma courses and certificate programs in health sciences and allied services.

Recently, Govt. of Punjab has transferred 100 bedded Civil Hospital, Badal to University for strengthening and expanding the connection between rural medical services and the education and research carried on by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University has 25 departments and 20 post graduate departments.

COLLEGES AFFILIATED WITH UNIVERSITY:

At present the University is having 160 affiliated colleges(10 Medical,14 Dental, 120 Nursing, 11 Physiotherapy, 1 Pharmacy, 1 Sports Medicine and 3 para medical) comprising 151 affiliated and 9 constituent Colleges.

University will soon endeavor to achieve excellence in health care delivery and medical education and research in the State. Admissions to various undergraduate and post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis through the conduct of Entrance Tests. The PPMET-2023 is being accordingly conducted to enroll suitable candidates in the Nursing Colleges of the State for the session 2023.

The university is now primarily focusing on strengthening postgraduate medical education and research and evolving as a centre of excellence in a rural backdrop.

Selection of the candidates to any institution shall be made on merit and in transparent manner as per Punjab Government Notification/s.

1. IMPORTANT PLEASE READ IN DETAIL

1. All necessary information regarding allocation of merit (Based on PMNET –2023) and seeking admission to M.Sc. Nursing courses in the various Nursing colleges of Punjab affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and all applicable rules and regulations, etc., are contained in this PROSPECTUS.
2. Candidates are advised to read both Part-I and Part-II of the prospectus carefully before filling and submitting the **ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM**.
3. This Prospectus is subject to alteration(s) or modification(s) at any time without notice. For updates please refer to University website i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in from time to time.
4. An error in filling of **Online Admission APPLICATION FORM** may result in rejection of such an Application Form. Corrections in the information given by the candidate in the **Online APPLICATION FORM** is not permitted after last date of submission of online form. Therefore applicants are advised to take care while they filled columns of admission application form such as category code, date of birth etc.
5. Candidates are advised to keep photocopies of the **Printout of online Admission APPLICATION FORM** till the admission process is not over.
6. The schedule of Counselling(s) shall be notified through Prospectus/ University, website. Changes, if any, in the schedule/time table of Counselling will be notified through website of the University i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in. **No separate intimation letters will be sent.**
7. Candidates must read instructions carefully and comply with all strictly.
8. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Part – II of the Prospectus. The Eligibility shall be determined by the Selection Committee at the time of counselling. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Government notification will not be considered for admission.
9. **Personal appearance of candidates is essential at the time of Counseling. He/she will have to produce all original documents/ testimonials, before the Selection Committee for verification.**
10. **The candidate should keep two more coloured photographs from the same negative and attested by same authority for future use.**
11. The list of the Colleges and availability of seats shown at various places in this prospectus may vary and **the final status shall be displayed at the time of counselling.**
12. The candidate should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just appearing in PMNET-2023 does not entitle him/her for admission. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Punjab Government Notification and Selection Committee shall be determined eligibility at the time of counselling. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Government Notification will not be considered for admission.
13. Fill category carefully in the online Admission Application Form. Category once claimed will not be changed in any case after submitting the form.

Those candidates, who do not fill/claim any category code as per prospectus or fill a wrong category code other than mentioned in prospectus, will be treated in Open merit. The candidate may select a category code from the codes given below and fill the category accordingly. More than one category may be filled by a candidate if it is considered applicable in the candidate's particular case. Category codes are exclusively for the purpose of facilitating the candidates to know and understand his/her respective merit placement at the time of counseling in various reserved categories as have been

filled by him/her. Reserve category selection on the part of the candidate shall not in any case be construed to give him/her any legitimacy or right or claim on the benefits for reserved seats during admission. Claims to admissions against reserved seats in M.Sc. Nursing courses will be on the basis of appropriate claims made in the Admission Application Form subject to rules and regulations contained in the Punjab Government Notifications printed in the Part-B of this prospectus and as per the decisions of the Selection Committee constituted for this purpose by the Punjab Government. No benefit of reservation whatsoever shall be given if the claim is not made in online Admission Application Form.

14. **This is for the information of all candidates that as per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.**
15. The candidates, who are getting admission and are in service with any institute, will submit the relieving certificate from the employer at the time of joining in the respective colleges. If later on it is found that he/she is doing service in any institute even after getting the admission, then he/she will be debarred for doing M.Sc. Nursing and action against the student as well as the college will be initiated as per rules of the University. The Principals of respective college will ensure and give undertaking that all the students are regularly attending the classes.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS:

Eligibility and qualifications will be as per Punjab Govt. Notification No. 5/7/2013-5HB-III/5416 dated 09.09.2020.

3. Fee Required with Admission Application Form:

- a) Rs. 5000/- +18% GST(5900/-)for General Category and SC candidates will deposit fee of Rs.2500+18% GST(Rs.2950/-) be deposited through online payment gateway available on University website i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in by due date and time.
- b) **Fee once deposited in University account will not be refunded/adjusted in any case.**

1. **The seats and eligibility criteria for NRI seats is as per Punjab Government notification for admission to M.Sc. Nursing courses.**
2. After qualifying Entrance test (PMNET-2023), candidate will apply to university for Eligibility certificate.
3. The Performa for getting eligibility certificate is available as University website. Fee for getting eligibility certificate is **Rs. 2500/-** towards the cost of this form.
4. After downloading the eligibility application form, candidates will have to submit the same in the University along with a bank draft of **US \$ 500** or its equivalent amount in Indian Rupees in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, payable at Faridkot
5. The following Original and photocopies of documents are required while submitting eligibility application form is as under:-
 - 1) Copy Admit card/ Result of Entrance Test(PMNET-2023).
 - 2) Copy of the certificate qualifying examination certificate.
 - 3) Date of Birth certificate/Matric Certificate
 - 4) Certificate that qualifying examination has been passed as a regular student from a recognized institution /university.

 - 6) Character/Conduct certificate from the institution last attended.

2. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. Submitting more than one application by a candidate is liable to be rejected.
3. At the time of submission online application, candidate should have to deposit requisite fee through online payment gateway available at University website i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in. Fee shall not be accepted in any other mode i.e. Cash, Cheque, Demand Draft etc.
4. **Fee should be deposited by specified date.**
5. Candidate insures that he/she has completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December 2023.
6. Date should be filled in the format of dd/mm/yyyy i.e. date/month/year.
7. If result of B.Sc. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing examination is not declared or candidate has reappear in this examination, he/she should have fill 0(zero) in the columns of marks.
8. After filling of online admission application form, you will receive a Registration number and Password at your given mobile no and E-mail address.
9. Registration number and Password is mandatory for further process, so keep it secret.
10. You have to login to upload Photograph, Edit Application, Application Status and to change your password options.

The candidates will have to submit Freeship Card alongwith admission application form. 8. SCHEME OF ENTRANCE TEST

- i. The Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot shall conduct Entrance test for admission to M.Sc.(Nursing) Courses. The centre of test shall be displayed on website of the University and Admit Cards.
- ii. The question paper PMNET-2023 (M.Sc. Nursing) will be of 3.00 hours duration consisting 200 multiple choice questions (MCQs) carrying 800 marks.

- iii. The syllabus for the course shall be the syllabus of B.Sc.(Nursing)/Post Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) Course prescribed by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- iv. **The test shall be conducted at the centers decided by the University. The city/cities, centre/centres shall be intimated by the University.**
- v. There shall be no negative marking. **However the candidates who do not darken the fifth oval in case of unattempted questions introduced for security shall be getting deduction of marks at the rate of one mark per question left in which all the five ovals have been left blank.**
- vi. The candidate will have to write his question booklet number and OMR response sheet number on the roll number counter slip as well as on the attendance sheet. The OMR response sheet number should be written on question booklet and question booklet number on the OMR response sheet.
- vii. The female candidates shall affix RTI (Right Thumb Impression) in case of male LTI (Left Thumb Impression) on the attendance sheets, roll number counter slip as well as on the OMR response sheet.

16. CONDUCT OF THE TEST

- i. The centre for test shall be intimated to the candidates by the University. The same shall be intimated to the candidates.
- ii. Candidates are required to reach the test centre at least 30 minutes before the start of the test. If the candidates do not report in time they are likely to miss some of the general instructions to be announced in the examination hall.
- iii. The candidates must show, on demand, the Admit Card for entry in the examination hall. A candidate who does not bring the Admit Card issued by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, will not be admitted to the examination hall under any circumstances by the Centre Superintendent.
- iv. A seat with the Roll Number will be allotted to each candidate.
- v. Candidates must find out and occupy their allotted seats after consulting the seating plan displayed at Examination Centre.
- vi. A candidate who comes after 15 minutes of the commencement of the Test shall not be permitted to take the test.
- vii. A candidate shall not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except the Admit Card inside the Examination Hall.
- viii. Calculators, Slide Rules, Log Tables, Electronic Watches with facilities of calculators, cellular phones, pagers or any other electronic devices the use/misuse of which would be adverse to the proper conduct of this test shall not be allowed inside the Examination Hall. Any candidate in possession of these may be expelled from this Test.
- ix. No candidate shall be allowed to go outside the Examination Hall till the completion of the entire duration of time.
- x. No candidate, without the special permission of the Centre Superintendent or the Invigilator concerned, will leave his/her seat or the Examination Room until the expiry of full time allotted for test. Candidates should not leave the Hall without handing over their Question Booklets and the OMR Response Sheets to the invigilator on duty.

- ii. No re-examination shall be held by the University under any circumstances, for those candidates who are unable to appear on the scheduled date and time of the entrance test for any reason whatsoever.

18. MODE OF THE TEST

- i) The test will be of objective type with multiple choice questions and candidates will be provided with a sealed Question Booklet and an OMR Response Sheet. In the Test/Question Booklet, there will be 200 items (questions) serially numbered from 1 to 200. Each item will be followed by four responses marked (A), (B), (C) and (D). Of these four responses only one will be the correct or the most appropriate response.

1. GENERAL:

- 1.1 The Governor of Punjab is pleased to authorize Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot to conduct Entrance Test for 2020 and onwards and corresponding years hereinafter, for selection of candidates for admission to M.Sc. Nursing courses in various institutions, in the State of Punjab, for the year 2020 and onwards.
- 1.2 All institutions affiliated with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot/Indian Nursing Council (INC)/Punjab Nurses Registration Council (PNRC) whether Government/Private /aided/unaided shall be covered by this notification.
- 1.3 The admission to the minority institutions in the State of Punjab shall be done as per the notification/instructions /guidelines/rules/executive orders passed from time to time by the Government of Punjab as per provisions of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 as amended upto date.
- 1.4 The Governor of Punjab is further pleased to notify that no institution shall select candidates out of any other source or in any other manner other than merit of the candidates in entrance examination conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot on the basis of syllabus of B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. (post basic nursing). There shall be no overlapping or bye-passing of entrance examination merit of candidates.
- 1.5 After the declaration of the result of the entrance examination the candidates will have to apply on the specific proforma for all seats except minority quota seats to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences (BFUHS), Faridkot. Admission will be made by the admission committee under the chairmanship of BFUHS, Faridkot through a centralized counselling purely on merit in an open, transparent manner on the basis of inter-se merit of entrance examination at the earliest possible and it shall be ensured that the final counseling by the University (BFUHS) shall be completed by 31st October of this year and thereafter, individual Institutions

would be at liberty to fill-up vacant seats in the presence of representatives of BFUHS.

- 1.6 For the admission in minority quota, the candidate shall have to apply to concerned institute. Seats shall be filled purely on merit, through institute level admission committee in an open, transparent manner on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate in entrance examination.
- 1.7 The reserve category candidate shall have the right to compete for admission in general category seats as per their merit on the day of counselling and candidates so selected will not be counted towards admission in the reserve category.

- 1.9 The entrance examination shall be conducted by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot by setting up of adequate number of centers, at such places as the University may deem fit.

- 2.3 Distribution of seats shall be as per provisions of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 as amended upto date.
- 2.4 The admission shall be made to all the institutions, which have got the permission from the concerned authority and are affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot by 31st October of the corresponding year.
- 2.5 The seats remaining vacant in government quota shall be transferred to management quota and vice versa.

- 2.6 The seats remaining vacant after exhausting the state list, will be filled from candidates who have passed qualifying examination from the recognized institutions situated outside the State of Punjab irrespective of place of residence, in an open, transparent manner on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination by the same committee.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Following candidates are eligible:-

- (a) Candidate should have obtained certificate in B.Sc. (Nursing)/ B.Sc. (Post Basic Nursing) from an institution recognized by the Punjab Nursing Registration Council/Indian Nursing Council and situated in the state of Punjab.(The Clause of Institute situated in state of Punjab is exempted for those exempted under clause 3 (b) and NRI Quota, or
- (b) The candidate was bonafide resident of Punjab. The resident status of Punjab state shall be taken in terms of Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP-II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3PP-II/9619 dated 6th June, 1996 and any further instructions issued by the Department of Personnel, if any, and the same shall be adhered to, or
- (c) In addition the following categories of candidates are also eligible for admission in M.Sc. Nursing course in Nursing institutes in Punjab:-
 - i) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.
 - ii) Candidates seeking admissions under NRI category.
 - iii) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
 - iv) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years preceding year of passing 10+2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependents have passed class XI and/or XII or equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However, those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.
 - v) Candidates under J & K migrant for J & K migrant quota seats only.

Note-1 The candidates should have passed B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Post Basic Nursing with minimum 55% marks from Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot or equivalent examination with requisite percentage of marks as prescribed above in this para, recognized by Indian Nursing Council, from a recognized University. In case candidate passed qualifying examination from IGNOU, New Delhi, study center must be recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi.

Note-2 Candidates should have at least one year of work experience at the time of joining of the course in Bed Side Nursing or Public Health Nursing or Nursing Educational Institute recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC) after Basic. B.Sc. Nursing or before/after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.

Note-3 In the first instance admission to the institutions having permission of affiliation from all the Statutory bodies, i.e., Punjab Nurses Registration Council (PNRC)/Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (BFUHS) and Indian Nursing Council (INC), shall be finalized purely on merit and in transparent manner. The institutions which secure these permissions up to 30th September of the corresponding year, shall also be considered.

Note-4 The dependency certificate in case of those candidates whose parents are not alive, shall have also to be taken from the Deputy Commissioner of the District where the candidate resides.

4. RESERVATION:

A. For Government/University College:

The reservation in the State quota seats in Government Institutions in various categories for admission to the under Graduate Para Medical Courses will be as under:

(i)	Schedule Caste	25%
(ii)	Backward Classes	10%
(iii)	Differently abled	5%

Note 1. The availability of seats for reservation shall be as per 100 point roster being maintained category wise / subject wise / institution wise.

Note 2. All the certificates shall be as per the latest instructions issued by the Govt. of Punjab.

B. For Private Institutes:

The reservation in private institutes (in Government/Management quota seats) will be as under:-

i.	Scheduled Caste -	25%
ii.	Backward Classes-	10%
iii.	Differently abled	5%

Note : Distribution of seats under Management/ Minority quota for the admission to Minority institutes shall be as fixed by the respective institutions in accordance with applicable laws.

C. Explanation: The following points shall be observed while granting above reservation both in government and in private colleges:

- (i) The reservation of physically challenged persons shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act – 2016.
- (ii) The above reservation will be made in each Course/ college separately subject to the availability of seats as per instructions issued by the Government of Punjab from time to time. The reservation in each institution shall not exceed 25 % in case of SC and 35% in case of SC and BC combined together.
- (iii) General category counselling shall be held on the first day. The reserved category candidate selected shall have the right to be selected in the General category as per her/his merit. The reserve category candidate selected in the general category shall not be counted towards reserve category.
- (iv) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve category shall be merged with the general category seats.

5. Non-Resident Indian (NRI) SEATS

15% seats in all Private Institutes and 7.5% of seats in Government / University institutes shall be earmarked for the Foreign Indian Students (NRI). The Foreign Indian Students (NRI) quota in Private Institute will be part of the Management Quota.

Category I: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the State of Punjab.

Category II: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State other than Punjab.

- (i) Under this policy non resident Indian means a person of Indian origin whether holding an Indian Passport or foreign passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case :
 - (i) for or on taking up employment outside India ; or
 - (ii) for carrying on a business or vacation outside India ; or
 - (iii) for any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intension to stay outside India for an uncertain period.

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant document including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency

of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI / PIO Card issued by the Govt. of India shall be taken into consideration.

- (ii) The eligibility of the candidates shall be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, who shall issue an eligibility certificate to each such candidate.
- (iii) The fee notified for NRI category shall be applicable to NRI candidates getting admission to Govt. Nursing Colleges also.
- (iv) The NRI students shall have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments as provided.
- (v) The Centralized Counselling of NRI quota seats shall be held before the Counselling for other categories. In case of any seat remaining vacant under NRI quota, during / after 2nd Centralized Counselling of NRI quota in State Colleges, it shall go to General category and in the Private Colleges/Minority colleges shall go to General Category of the Management/ Minority quota. The NRI left over seats shall be filled by the same Admission Committee from amongst the eligible candidates of Entrance Test.

6. ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- 6.1 The selection shall be strictly as per merit based upon the entrance examination.
- 6.2 Candidate should have secured at least 40% (35% for SC/BC) in the Entrance Test.
- 6.3 Counseling shall be compulsory and the centralized counseling shall be conducted by the committee consisting of the members as per clause 7(A) of this notification.
- 6.4 EQUAL MARKS: - In case of candidates securing equal marks their inter-merit will be determined as under:-
 - i) Firstly the candidate having higher percentage of aggregate marks calculated up to 3 decimal points.
 - ii) Candidate having higher percentage of aggregate marks calculated up to 3 decimal points in final year B.SC (NURSING)/ B.SC (POST BASIC NURSING).
 - iii) Then the candidate, older in age.

Note 1: The fee for Govt. /private Institutes shall be as fixed by the Government of Punjab as per provisions of The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 as amended from time to time.

Note 2: The fee structure subject to change as per requirements of the year of admission. Each and every student has to furnish and undertaking to the effect to deposit the enhance fee as per revised rates fixed by the Government from time to time keeping in view the year of admission.

2. Private Colleges:

(a) Fee

- (i) Fee for Indian nationals Rs. 1,75000/- P.A.
- (ii) Fee for Foreign Indian Students (NRIs) U.S. \$ 11000 (Full Course)

(b) Hostel fee and Security Advance (Annual and provisional)

- i. General Independent Room Rs.15,000 per year (Maximum) for single bedroom.
- ii. Special Room (Attached bathroom and AC) Rs. 24000/- per year Maximum.
- iii. Security Advance Rs. 25,000 or its equivalent (refundable in the shape of demand draft.)
- iv. Mess charges- Actual and to be managed by the students.
- v. These charges are exclusive of electricity/ water but inclusive of everything else.

Note 1 Successful candidates shall deposit the fee in form of Demand Draft in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences payable at Faridkot which will be deposited at the time of counseling.

Note 2 The above charges (include Tuition fee / Amalgamated Fund etc.) as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time. The clinical fee will be charged on monthly basis @ 700/- P.M. from the student. The transport and all other charges shall be optional and will be charged on actual user basis.

Note 3 The fee will be payable on six monthly basis and the colleges will not insist to deposit of fee of the entire course in advance. At the most students can be asked to submit a bank Guarantee / Bond that they will be liable to pay the balance fee for the whole courses even if they left in midstream.

Note 4 The fee shall be refunded / adjusted if candidate is shifted from one course / college to another in subsequent round of counseling / operation of waiting list. If the said fee is not refunded / adjusted within 15 days then said institute will be liable to pay Bank Interest as well as penal interest to the said student as laid by R.B.I.

9. (i) **Declaration by students-** Candidates and their parents will have to give a declaration if they (candidates) have already got admission in a course in any other State that they will leave that seat if they opt for admission through PUNJAB M.SC ENTERANCE EXAMINATION-2020 and corresponding years and will send a copy of the declaration to the concerned institute where they have already deposited fee/occupied a seat. They shall also give a declaration that they have not got admission in any other state on any other basis of any other qualifying examination except the one on the basis of which they have appeared in PUNJAB M.SC ENTERANCE EXAMINATION.
- (ii) **Students already admitted in previous years-**Any candidate who has taken admission in the previous sessions in M.Sc. Nursing courses shall be eligible for fresh admission in new M.Sc. Nursing Courses as a fresh candidate based on basis of result of Punjab M.Sc. Nursing Entrance examination. However, in case a candidate was admitted previously and drops out or leaves the M.Sc. Nursing Courses in between and seeks a fresh admission, the candidate shall have to deposit fee for full course.


10. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (a) The students shall pay the fees and other charges, for all types of seats, as per the rates of fees and other charges fixed by the Government of Punjab from time to time.
- (b) Managements/Minority Quota including Foreign Indian Students (NRI) seats will be filled up as per the notification/ instructions/ guidelines/ Executive orders by the State Government as per provisions of The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 or any directions or the orders of the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court/ Supreme Court of India.
- (c) The seats available for admission will be displayed on the notice board of the University and a List of corresponding year result shall be supplied by the University to all the Institutions on payment basis (at the price to be fixed by the University). The University will submit three sets of gazette to the Government free of cost.
- (d) If a candidate who has deposited his / her fee for six months opt to surrender his/her selection / seat, ten days before the last date fixed for the admission in the given course, the institute shall not be entitled to enforce bank guarantee / surety bond against that student for the recovery of the balance fee. However, the fee deposited for six months shall not be refunded.
- (e) The admissions shall be made to only those institutes, which are affiliated to the University on or before 31st October, 2020 and have obtained the permissions of affiliations from all the Statutory Bodies, i.e. Punjab Nurses Registration Council (PNRC)/ Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (BFUHS) and Indian Nurses Council (INC) and shall be finalized purely on merit and in a transparent manner.
- (f) The Medical Board to determine requisite disability at the time of admission will be constituted by the Chairman Selection Committee/ University. The candidate shall be admitted only if she/he has minimum of the requisite disability and with this disability is otherwise found fit medically to pursue the concerned course, by a duly constituted Medical Board.
- (g) In order to ensure completion of the prescribed course (s) and period of study as well as commencement of examination (s) in time, no admission(s), adjustments(s) shall be made after 30th November of the corresponding years, regardless of any vacancy(ies) that might exist or might arise thereafter for any reason whatsoever.
- (h) Government quota seats remaining vacant will be transferred to management quota and Vice versa filled up by the University as per provisions of this notification; strictly as per their merit, after obtaining a certificate from the Selection Committees that there are no candidates available with them and they are unable to fill up the government quota. If seats remain vacant after

exhausting all qualifying candidates the institutes may approach the government for relaxation in eligibility for admission through BFUHS.

- (i) No admissions shall be made after 30th November, 2020 of the corresponding years, including the left over seats without prior permission from the Punjab Government (Request should be routed through BFUHS, Faridkot).
- (j) Any notification/instructions issued earlier shall not be applicable to admission for the session 2020 and corresponding year.
- (k) For any dispute arising out of this notification or of the admissions under this notification, the jurisdiction shall be under section 8 of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006.

I am directed to invite your attention to the Punjab Government Circular Letter No.1/3/95-3PP II/2043, dated 29/1/1996 vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for purposes of admission to educational institutions (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain Vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-4121 wherein it was held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Residence' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:

**Affidavit/Certificate and the authorities

- (a) Citizen of India
- (b) Produce an affidavit to the effect that they or their Children/wards have not obtained the benefit of Residence in any other State

- i) Candidates who have studied for a period of 5 years in Punjab or have studied in Punjab for 2 years just preceding the qualifying examination for the admission. Certificate to be issued by the Headmaster/ Principal of the Govt. and recognized Schools/Colleges concerned.
- ii) Children wards of
- a) The employees of Punjab Govt. posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having atleast 3 years of service. Certificate to be issued by respective Head of the Department

- iii) **Children/wards of the pensioners of Punjab Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Punjab or he has settled after retirement in or outside Punjab.** PPO issued by the Accountant General, Punjab.
- iv) Children/wards of persons who have settled in Punjab or had resided in Punjab for a period of atleast 5 years at any time prior to the date of submission of the application either in pursuit of a profession or holding of a job. Certificate to be issued by the DC, ADC (R), ADC (D), SDM, GA to DC, DORG, DRO, EM, Tehsildar, Commissioners of Municipal Corporations of Amritsar, Jalandhar and Ludhiana.
- v) Children/wards of persons who have held immovable property in Punjab for a period of 5 years, the property should be in the name of the parents/guardians or the candidate himself. DC, ADC(R), ADC(D), SDM, GA to DC, EM, DORG, Tehsildar/DRO based on copies of Jamabandi, Revenue Record, Municipal Record, Registered deeds or any other documents to the full satisfaction of the DC.
- ii) Persons who were born in Punjab and produced a certificate to that effect

As per category (iv) above.

For the purposes of uniformity for issuing the certificate of Residence in the case of various categories to be issued by the Competent Authorities, proformae have been prescribed which are enclosed herewith. After careful consideration, it has also been decided to delete the D.T.O. included among the certifying authorities against category (iv) & (vi) of the policy instructions dated 29.01.1996.

From: Chief Secretary to Government of Punjab to all the Heads of the department etc.
Subject: Issuance of certificate for the purpose of seeking admission to various educational/technical/professional institutions in the state and also for employment.

Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of Government that educational authorities and institutions prescribe various certificates regarding residence, SC/BC category and backward area etc. to be furnished by the students/candidates with the applications forms for entrance examinations or employment in the formats and by the authorities different from those prescribed by the Government departments. Cases have also been reported where the authorities concerned insist on retaining original certificates and refuse to accept the attested photo copies of the certificates. All this results in harassment and panic among the students/candidates and their parents/guardian, since they have to apply with such certificates to more than one authorities simultaneously and within a limited period. The lists of certificates required at the time of applying for CET/PMET/PMT and PAU are enclosed by way of illustration.

2. In order to overcome the difficulty mentioned above, it has been decided by the Government that following procedure has been decided by the Government that the following procedure shall be followed meticulously by all the educational and other authorities concerned:-

- i) Certificates issued in the format and by the authorities prescribed by the Government Departments shall be accepted as valid by all educational institutions and other authorities.
- ii) Where a number of authorities have been authorized to issue the certificates there shall be no insistence on issue of a certificate by any particular authority or by the highest authority indicated in the format.
- iii)(a) In case of entrance examinations, no certificate should be called for in the first instance alongwith the application form. It will be sufficient for the candidate seeking admission or other facility to indicate in the application form whether he/she belongs to any particular category entitling him/her to certain concessions or facility. Requisite certificates may be obtained only from the selected/wait listed candidates.
- iii)(b) To further simplify the procedure attested copies of the certificates only shall be retained and original certificates if required to be produced at the time of interview shall be returned immediately, thereafter.
- iv) Parents/guardian or candidates can also obtain SC certificates from the Head of the institution where the candidates has studied if the proof is available in the school records.
- v) The persons who are employed in Government of India or any other State Government are to be treated at par with the employees of the Government of Punjab in the matter of issue of Scheduled Caste certificate provided relevant Scheduled Caste certificate exists in their service record. The Scheduled Caste certificate in such will be issued by the respective Heads of Departments in the Proforma below:-

These instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for meticulous compliance.
