'RECOGNITION OF MEDICAL COLLEGES BY MCI IN RAJASTHAN'

282: Shri Rajendra Gehlot:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of medical colleges accorded recognition by the Medical Council of India (MCI) across the country during last three years State-wise;
- (b) the details of funds allocated to the recognized medical colleges in Rajasthan during last three years; and;
- (c) whether the allocated funds have been utilized for works like construction of building, improvement of teaching system, purchase of medical equipments etc, if so, the details thereof?

- (a) As informed by the National Medical Commission (NMC), the number of medical colleges accorded recognition during the last three years are at Annexure.
- (b) & (c) The Ministry administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for Establishment of New Medical colleges attached with existing district/referral Hospitals. Under the scheme, 23 new medical colleges in State of Rajasthan have been approved. One time grant is provided for infrastructure and equipments. During last three years, an amount of Rs.958.40 crores has been released to the State as Central share under the said scheme.
