INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ All candidates have to register to participate in this counselling.
- ❖ Fresh choice filling and locking should be done by the candidates.
- ❖ **Candidates who wish to retain their seats in first phase of counselling need not participate in this counselling.**

- ❖ Candidates participating by ONLINE COUNSELLING for PG DEGREE/ DIPLOMA course will have to remit a non-refundable amount of Rs. 1000/- as processing fee through online by using a Debit Card /Net Banking or Credit Card. The candidates who have already paid processing fee need not pay again.
- ❖ Candidates who are not participated in 1st phase counselling can also participate in this counselling. They have to pay a non-refundable amount of Rs.1000/- through online as processing fee by using Debit card/ Net Banking or credit card.
- ❖ Candidates should be vigilant while choice filling.
- ❖ Vacancy position for the Courses will be available on official websites.
- ❖ Selection of candidates to PG DEGREE/ DIPLOMA course shall be made by the ONLINE COUNSELLING on the basis of rank by applying the rule of reservation/200 Point Roster method whichever is applicable.
- ❖ Candidates selected for admission should give a self-declaration form at the time of the reporting to the concerned Medical College that he / she is liable for forfeiture of selection / admission if suppression of facts mis-interpretation is found at any time during or after the admission to the course.
- ❖ Candidates should pay the tuition fee and then download their provisional allotment order and join the course in the concerned Medical Colleges on or before the date and time stipulated during this phase of ONLINE COUNSELING.
- ❖ Re-allotted candidates need not pay the tuition fee again.

For Reported candidates in 1st round of counselling

Those who are willing for Re-allotment, they have to Register. Then their allotted seat (allotted in 1st round of counselling) will be open for Choice filling in Re-counselling of 2nd round.

For Example,

- If the Candidate (who have registered) hold M.S. Orthopedics in Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu, the seat will be available for choice filling for others. If the candidate does not get seat in re-allotment, that M.S. Orthopedics in Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu, will be treated as “Retained”.

- If the candidate gets other MD/MS/DILPOMA seat in Re-allotment, then the MS seat allotted in 1st phase of counselling will be allotted to other candidates.
- Re-allotted candidates must get relieved from earlier institution and Join in allotted college.

For not reported candidates in 1st round of counselling:

- ❖ His/her seat (which was allotted in 1st round of counselling) treated as vacant.
- ❖ He/she cannot claim that seat (which was allotted in 1st round of counselling).
- ❖ The candidates should produce the following original certificates in person at the time of joining in their selected Medical College along with the scanned copy of original certificates to the concerned College.
 - a) NEET PG-2021-Score Card.
 - b) NEET PG-2021 Admit Card.
 - c) Aadhar Card
 - d) MBBS Degree Certificate or Provisional Pass Certificate and Diploma certificate.
 - e) CRRI Completion Certificate.
 - f) Permanent Medical Registration Certificate issued by the Medical Council of India / State Medical Council or Provisional Registration Certificate issued by the Medical Council of India / State Medical Council.
 - g) Community Certificate (if applicable)
 - h) TNPSC/MRB (through competitive written examination) Selection & Posting Order for service candidates.
 - i) Nativity Certificate (if applicable) with supportive documents.
 - j) Recent Regional Medical Board Certificate for Person with Disabilities.
 - k) Eligibility Certificate, if applicable.
 - l) Post Card size color photograph (4"x6") the same photo that has been uploaded in NEET PG-2021.
- ❖ Candidates are instructed to produce the above mentioned original Certificates/ Documents at the time of joining in the Medical College for certificate verification.
- ❖ Candidates while downloading their provisional allotment order should pay the non-refundable Tuition Fee via Debit Card /Net Banking or Credit Card.

- ❖ Candidates are advised to be in touch with our official websites (www.tnmedicalselection.org / www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in) for Schedule / latest updates / Results / Notices / News & Events pertaining to counselling as Selection Committee will not be individually contacting the candidates for the same.
