MEMORANDUM

Subject: Guideline for sponsorship of in service Medical Officer of THS under Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Tripura for admission in Post Graduate courses in the State and out-side the State and requirement of execution of Bond by all in service candidates.

In supersession of this Department's Memorandum No.F.11(2940)ET/MS/98 dated 31st January, 2001 issued in this regard, the following guidelines have been laid down for selection / sponsoring of Medical Officers of THS, Government of Tripura for open / sponsored category and also the requirement of execution of Bond by all in service candidates for admission to Post Graduate courses at Medical Colleges in the State and out-side the State.

1. The Candidate should have to qualify in Common Entrance Test (CET)/ NEET- PG examination amended from time to time for selection.
2. In service Medical Officers having 3 (three) years of rural service as per **ANNEXURE-I** can apply for the course as a sponsored category subject to condition that, the candidate should be confirmed by T.P.S.C. and will be eligible for sponsorship. However study leave shall not be granted to a Medical Officer who has rendered less than 5(five) years' service under the Government as per T.S.C.S.(Leave) Rules, 1986.
3. A Medical Officer having Post Graduate Diploma will be eligible for sponsorship only in the post graduate degree course of **the same discipline** or its allied disciplines after 3(three) years of obtaining Post Graduate Diploma.
4. If a Medical Officer, who is sponsored for study in Post Graduate Degree/ Diploma course fails to join the course, he/she would be debarred for sponsorship for the next 3 (three) years.
5. All in service candidates of Post Graduate/Super Specialty courses shall execute a bond in favor of the State Government stating that he/ she shall serve under the Government of Tripura for at least 5 (five) years immediately after successful completion of the course in case of PG Degree/ Super specialty and 3(three) years in case of PG Diploma.

6. In case, such candidate fails to serve under the Government of Tripura as per bond he/she will have to pay Rs. 35. Lakhs (Rupees Thirty five lakhs) for Pre & Para Clinical subject (Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology, Forensic Medicine & Community Medicine etc.) ,Rs.50.00 lakhs (Rupees Fifty lakhs) for all clinical subjects (Medicine, Surgery, Orthopedics, ENT, Obst. & Gynaecology, Anesthesiology, Pediatrics, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, TB & Chest, Radio-diagnosis, Radiotherapy & Dermatology etc.) and Rs.70.00 lakhs (Rupees Seventy lakhs) for all Super Specialty course with interest accrued there on, subject to revision by the Government of Tripura from time to time.
7. All Post Graduate students (domicile or sponsored) should execute a bond stating that he/she will pay an amount of Rs.15.00 lakhs (Rupees Fifteen lakhs) for PG Diploma course, Rs.25.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty five lakhs) for PG Degree course and Rs.35.00 lakhs (Rupees Thirty five lakhs) for Super Specialty course , if he / she discontinues the course, subject to revision by the Government of Tripura from time to time.
8. In service **sponsored candidates** would be entitled to study leave , as per TSCS(Leave) Rules, 1986 and the remaining period shall be treated as training reserve during the period of PG study.
9. In-service candidate selected against open category having 3(three) years of Rural service will be treated as Training reserve during the total period of his / her study.


If Medical Officer sponsored for Super Specialty Course and do not have Study Leave in his/her credit, the total period of study shall be considered as Training Reserve.

10. Entrance for Post Graduate medical course recognized by MCI will come under these guidelines for sponsoring a candidate.
11. In the State quota PG seats the eligibility criteria for the sponsored/ open category shall be as follows:
 - i) Candidate should be of Tripura Health Services.
 - ii) The upper age limit shall be 45 (forty five) years.
 - iii) Sponsorship shall be sanctioned only in the MCI recognized post graduate courses as amended from time to time.


12. No. TA/DA etc. will be admissible to the sponsored / open category in service candidates during the period of the Postgraduate study.
13. Candidates selected for PG study will have to pay all expenses in connection with their Post Graduate Degree / Diploma studies and Govt. of Tripura will not bear the expenses incurred.
14. No-Objection Certificate, Sponsorship Certificate, Study Leave etc. for in service candidate of Tripura Health Services shall be dealt by the office of the Director of Health services.
15. Course fee for the whole 3(three) years course of PG/Super Specialty will be as per norms of the individual institute, both in the state & outside the state.

NOTIFICATION

It is for appraisal of all concerned, Under Graduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) Students of Medical Colleges of the State and outside the State, (domicile, sponsored and Central Government nominee) that a bond has to be executed and submitted in original in the office of the Director of Medical Education, Agartala, on being selected/admitted in the U.G and P.G. Courses as per the clauses as mentioned below:

1. All State candidates (domicile and sponsored) of Under Graduate and Post Graduate courses shall have to execute a Bond in favour of the State Government stating that he/she shall serve under Government of Tripura for a period of at least 5 (five) years immediately after successful completion of the course.
2. In case such candidates fail to serve under Government of Tripura as per Bond, he/she has to pay an amount of Rs.20,00,000.00(Rupees twenty lac) instead of existing amount of Rs.5,00,000.00 (Rupees Five lac) for Under Graduate course and Rs.35,00,000.00(Rupees Thirty five lac) instead of existing amount of Rs. 25,00,000.00 (Rupees twenty five lac) for Post Graduate in Pre & Para-clinical subjects (Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology, Forensic Medicine & Community Medicine) and Rs.50,00,000.00(Rupees Fifty lac) instead of existing amount of Rs. 35,00,000.00 (Rupees thirty five lacs) in Clinical subjects (Medicine, Surgery, Orthopaedics, ENT, Obstetrics. & Gynaecology, Anaesthesiology, Paediatrics, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, TB & Respiratory Diseases, Radio-diagnosis, Dermatology and Radiotherapy) to the Government of Tripura.
3. All Under Graduate and Post Graduate Students (domicile, sponsored and Central Government nominee) should execute a Bond stating that he/she will pay an amount of Rs. 20,00,000.00(Rupees twenty lacs) if he/she discontinues the course before completion.
4. The Bond obligations will not apply if the offer of appointment is not made by the Government within 1(one) year from the date of communication of the results specified in Sub-clause ix(a) of Clause-3 of the bond or the candidates accepts the offer of employment even after one year.

This is issued in cancellation of all previous Notifications issued in this regard and with the approval of the Government, vide U.O. No.F.1(23)- GA(CAB)/2007(1) dated 3rd August, 2016.

NOTIFICATION

It is for appraisal of all concerned that Under Graduate (UG) & Post Graduate (PG) Courses aspiring candidates that, the following clauses regarding execution of the Bond before admission to Medical Colleges shall come into force from the academic session 2020 and onwards as under :-

A. (Post Graduate Degree (PG) & Diploma Courses) :- PG Service Bond : In the event of failure to serve the stipulated period under Govt. of Tripura as per Bond, he/she has to pay an amount of **Rs. 35.00(Rupees thirty five) lakhs only for Post Graduate Pre & Para Clinical Subjects Courses** (Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, Community Medicine etc.) and **Rs. 50.00 (fifty lakhs) only for Clinical Subjects Courses** (General Medicine, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, Otorhinolaryngology (ENT), Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Anaesthesiology, Paediatrics, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, Respiratory Medicine, Radio Diagnosis, Dermatology, Radiotherapy etc.) and **Rs.15(fifteen) lakhs** for PG Diploma Courses to the Government of Tripura as under **Clause 1,2 & 3.**

B. PG/Diploma Discontinuation Bond:- Execution of a Bond by a Candidate stating that a Candidate will pay an amount of **Rs. 25.00 lakhs** in Pre-Clinical & Para Clinical PG Degree Courses and **Rs. 35.00 lakhs** in Clinical PG Degree Subjects Courses and **Rs. 10.00 lakhs** for all PG Diploma Courses to the Govt. of Tripura/Concerned Institution if he/she discontinues his/her PG Course as under Clause **1,2,3 & 4.**

Clause-1. All eligible Non Sponsored and State domicile candidates availing the State Quota seat shall have to execute a Service Bond in favour of the State Government stating that he/she shall serve under Govt. of Tripura for a period of 03 (three) years immediately after successful completion of PG Degree Courses & 02 (two) years immediately after successful completion of PG Diploma Courses.

Clause-2. All Domicile/Sponsored Candidates shall have to execute a Bond as per earlier Notification No.F.11(31)-DME/UG/BOND/2016 dated 6th September, 2016.

Clause-3. No Bond is applicable to All India Candidates for **50 % AIQ Seats** of PG Degree/Diploma Courses who could be studying in Institutions of Tripura and who does not opt for Stipend/Salary from Govt. of Tripura. All India Candidates for 50 % AIQ seats of PG Degree/Diploma Courses studying in Institutions of Tripura who opts to take stipend/salary form Govt. of Tripura during his/her study period in Institutions of Tripura shall have to execute the Service Bond as per **Clause 1 & 2.**

Clause-4. PG Discontinuation Bond will be applicable for all the PG Candidates as under **Clause 1,2 & 3.**

Under Graduate (UG) : UG Service Bond:

Clause-5. All Candidates of Under Graduate Courses selected for State

Quota seat (Domicile/Eligibility for State Quota/Sponsored) in Institutions of this State or Outside Tripura shall have to execute a Service Bond in favour of the State Govt. stating that he/she shall serve under Govt. of Tripura for a period of 05 (five) years immediately after successful completion of course failing which he/she will have to pay and amount of **Rs. 20.00 lakhs** to the Govt. of Tripura.

Clause-6. Candidates who would be selected for admission in Tripura Medical College and Dr. BRAM Teaching Hospital (Society run Medical College) in MBBS Course shall not have to execute the Service Bond.p

UG Discontinuation Bond:


Clause-7. UG Discontinuation Bond is a Bond to be executed by a Candidate to pay an amount of **Rs. 20.00 lakhs** to the Govt. of Tripura/Concerned Institution if he/she discontinues the course before completion of his/her MBBS/UG Course.

Clause-8. UG Discontinuation Bond will be applicable for all the above said UG Candidates as described under Clause **5,6 & 7.**

Clause -9. The Service Bond obligation will not apply on a candidate if the appointment is not made by the Govt. within 06(six) months from the date communication to the Government of his/her successful completion of the course & eligibility for service and the clause is applicable in all the above UG & PG Service Bond Clauses.

This is issued in partial modification of this Department earlier Notification vide No.F.11 (31)-DME/UG BOND/2016 Dated 6th September, 2016. The discontinuation Bond of UG Courses shall remain unchanged.


